RFP for Upgradation to 2 Lane with Paved Shoulders from Design km 0+000 to km 48+742 and km 61+732 to km 102+284 of Bagasara-Una Section of NH-351K in the State of Gujarat on Hybrid Annuity Mode

The Government of India had entrusted to the Authority the development, maintenance and management of National Highway No. 351K including the section from km 0+000 to km 48+742 and km 61+732 to km 102+284 (approx. 89.294 km). The Authority had resolved **Upgradation to 2 Lane with Paved Shoulders from Design km 0+000 to km 48+742 and km 61+732 to km 102+284 of Bagasara-Una Section of NH-351K in the State of Gujarat** (the “Project”) on design, build, operate and transfer (the “DBOT Annuity” or “Hybrid Annuity”) basis, and has decided to carry out the bidding process for selection of a private entity as the Bidder to whom the Project may be awarded. Technical submissions of the Bids received online shall be opened on 31.10.2025 (at 1130 hours IST).

Bid submitted through any other mode shall not be entertained. However, Bid Security, Power of Attorney for signing of Bid, Power of Attorney for lead member of Consortium, if any, Joint Bidding Agreement for Consortium, if any, Integrity Pact, and experience certificates apostile at foreign origin, if any, and other documents required as per clause 2.11.2 of RFP shall be submitted physically in original by the Lowest Bidder before issuance of Letter of Award (LOA) by the Authority. However, while submitting Bid Security via Account Payee demand draft or Banker's

cheque or Fixed Deposit Receipt, it is to be ensured by the Bidder that Account Payee demand draft or Banker's cheque or Fixed Deposit Receipt are submitted physically latest within 5-working days of the Bid Due Date (upto 11:00 hours). Please note that the Authority reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the BIDs without assigning any reason whatsoever.
