RFP for Construction of 4L + PS Sri Muktsar Sahib bypass from existing Km 269.960 of NH-354 to existing km 39.280 of NH 754 on EPC mode in the state of Punjab. The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Govt. of India through Superintending Engineer – cum – Regional Officer, MoRT&H is engaged in the development of National Highways and as part of this endeavor, it has been decided to undertake "Construction of 4L + PS Sri Muktsar Sahib bypass from existing Km 269.960 of NH-354 to existing km 39.280 of NH 754 on EPC mode in the state of Punjab" through an Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) Contract.

The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways represented Superintending Engineer – cum – Regional Officer, MoRT&H now invites bids from eligible contractors for the following project:

IST). Bidder must submit its Financial bid at <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> on or before **29.01.2026** (upto 1500 hours IST). Bids received online shall be opened on **30.01.2026** (after 1500 hours IST).

It is mandatory for all the Bidders to have Digital Signature Certificate (in the Name of Person who will sign the Bid document) from any of the license certifying agency (Applicants can see the list of license CA's from the link <http://www.nicca.gov.in>) to participate in e tendering portal of MoRT&H. To participate in e-tendering, it is mandatory for the Bidder to get registered their firm / Joint Venture with the e-tendering portal of MoRT&H <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> to have user ID & Password.

Bid through any other mode shall not be entertained. Bid Security, document fee, Power of Attorney and Joint Bidding Agreement etc. shall be submitted online by the Bidder on or before 29.01.2026 (upto 15.00 hours IST). However, the successful bidders has to submit the original documents such as Document Fee, Power of Attorney and Joint Bidding Agreement along with Original Bank Guarantee towards Bid Security physically before issue of LoA. Please note that the Ministry reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the BIDs without assigning any reason whatsoever.

The Bidders have to Submit their Bids including scanned copy of Bid Security only at e-tendering portal of MoRT&H <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> in electronic format with Digital Signature. GST will be paid separately on claim supported with authenticated records on account of GST paid to concerned Authority.

Any Bidder from a country which shares land border with India will be eligible to bid only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority in Department for Promotion of Industry and Inland Trade (DPIIT), Govt of India. However, requirement of registration of bidders from a country sharing a land border with India will not apply to bidders from those countries to which Government of India is engaged in development projects.
