RFP for Construction of STRR (West side) NH948A Obalapura (Nelamangala Taluk)) to Kunigal (Ramanagara Taluk) from Km 0.00 to km 79.00 (Design Chainage) Phase-I in Karnataka on Hybrid Annuity Mode (Project Length – 79.00 kms)

The Government of India had entrusted to the Authority the development, maintenance and management of National Highway No. 948A including the section from design km 0.00 to km 79.00 (approx. design length 79.00 km). The Authority had resolved Construction of STRR (West side) NH948A Obalapura (Nelamangala Taluk)) to Kunigal (Ramanagara Taluk) from Km 0.00 to km 79.00 (Design Chainage) Phase-I in Karnataka thereof (the “**Project**”) on design, build, operate and transfer (the “DBOT Annuity” or “Hybrid Annuity”) basis, and has decided to carry out the bidding process for selection of a private entity as the Bidder to whom the Project may be awarded. Technical submissions of the Bids received online shall be opened on 28.02.2025 (at 1130 hours IST).

Bid submitted through any other mode shall not be entertained. However, Bid Security, Power of Attorney for signing of Bid, Power of Attorney for lead member of Consortium, if any, Joint Bidding Agreement for Consortium, if any, Integrity Pact, and experience certificates apostile at foreign origin, if any, and other documents required as per clause 2.11.2 of RFP shall be submitted physically in original by the Lowest Bidder before issuance of Letter of Award (LOA) by the Authority. However, while submitting Bid Security via Account Payee demand draft or Banker’s cheque or Fixed Deposit Receipt, it is to be ensured by the Bidder that Account Payee demand draft or Banker’s cheque or Fixed Deposit Receipt are submitted physically latest within 5-working days of the Bid Due Date (upto 11:00 hours). Please note that the Authority reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the BIDs without assigning any reason whatsoever.
