RFP for Tolling, Operation, Maintenance & Transfer of Asanpur- Forbesganj- Purnea section of NH-27 in the state of Bihar (TOT Bundle-21).

The Government of India had entrusted to the Authority the Tolling, Operation and Maintenance of the National Highway sections given in the table below (the "Project Bundle"). The Authority had resolved to undertake the Tolling, Operation and Maintenance of the existing roads as given in the table below on Toll Operate Transfer (TOT) basis and has decided to carry out the Bidding Process for selection of a private entity as the Bidder to whom all the projects in the bundle may be awarded. Bids received online shall be opened on **01.10.2025 (at 1130 hours IST)**.

Bid through any other mode shall not be entertained. However, Bid Security, proof of online payment of cost of bid document, Power of Attorney and joint bidding agreement etc. as specified in Clause 2.11.2 of the RFP shall be submitted physically by the Bidder after declaration of bid evaluation result by Authority. Bidders (including all of its Consortium Members) failing to submit the original documents shall be unconditionally debarred from bidding in NHAI projects for a period of 5 years from the date of issue of debarment notice. Please note that the Authority reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the Bids without assigning any reason whatsoever.
