RFP for Balance work for construction of Four Laning of the project Highway from End of Pinjore bypass – Baddi - Nalagarh Section (Km. 4+200 to 35+395) on NH-21A (New NH-105) in the State of Haryana and Himachal Pradesh on EPC Mode.

The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways through National Highways Authority of India is engaged in the development of National Highways and as part of this endeavour, it has been decided to undertake Balance work for construction of Four Laning of the project Highway from End of Pinjore bypass – Baddi - Nalagarh Section (Km. 4+200 to 35+395) on NH-21A (New NH-105) in the State of Haryana and Himachal Pradesh (Approx. length-30.30 Km) (Total length = 30.30 Km.) in the state of Haryana and Himachal Pradesh through an Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) Contract.

However, Bid Security, POA for signing the Bid, POA for lead member of JV, if any, JBA for JV, if any, Integrity Pact, and experience certificates apostile at foreign origin, if any and other documents specified in clause 2.11.2 of RFP shall be submitted physically in original by the Lowest Bidder before issuance of Letter of Acceptance (LOA) by the Authority. **However, while**

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submitting Bid Security via Account Payee demand draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque, it is to be ensured by the bidder that Account Payee demand draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque are submitted physically latest within 5 working days of the Bid Due Date (upto 11:00 hours). Please note that the National Highways Authority of India reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the BIDs without assigning any reason whatsoever.
