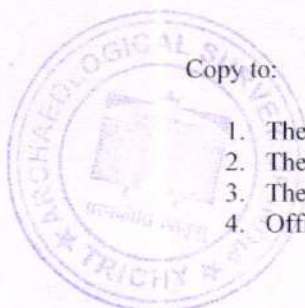

2. THE TENDER DOCUMENT

- 2.1 Bidders must read the complete "Tender Document": This NIT is an integral part of the Tender Document and serves a limited purpose of invitation, and does not purport to contain all relevant details for submission of bids. „Tender Information Summary" (TIS) appended to this notice gives a salient summary of the tender information. Any generic reference to NIT shall also imply a reference to TIS as well. Bidders must go through the Tender Document for details before submission of their Bids. However, Bidders must go through the complete Tender Document for details before submission of their Bids.
- 2.2 **Availability of the Tender Document:** The Tender Document shall be published on the CPPP web site: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> and also available on www.asi.nic.in web site and which may be downloaded and uploaded after duly filled in and signed documents *as per the clause no. Section-II 1.5 & 1.6* in CPP Portal along with the copy of the DD for EMD. The tender bids not accompanied with EMD of requisite amount will be rejected at the initial stage itself. The document will be available for download from the specified start date and time, as outlined in the Tender Information Sheet (TIS), and will remain accessible until the designated deadline. This time frame allows interested parties to access and review the document within the allotted period. Unless otherwise specified in the Tender Information Sheet (TIS), the downloaded Tender Document is provided free of cost. If the Superintending Archaeologist, Archaeological Survey of India, Trichy Circle happens to be closed on the deadline for submitting the bids as specified above, this deadline shall not be extended. If the date of opening of the tender happens to be holiday, the tenders will be opened on the next working day.
- 2.3 **Clarifications:** A Bidder requiring any clarification regarding the Tender Document may ask questions in writing / electronically from Office / Contact Person as mentioned in TIS, provided the questions are raised before the clarification end date mentioned in TIS. This deadline shall not be extended in case of any intervening holidays.
3. **Eligibility and Qualification Criteria for participation in this Tender:** Subject to provisions in the Tender Document, participation in this Tender Process is open to all bidders who fulfill the "Eligibility" and "Qualification" criteria. Bidder should meet the following eligibility criteria as of the date of his bid submission and should continue to meet these till the award of the contract. Bidder shall be required to declare fulfillment Eligibility Criteria in Form 2 (Eligibility Declarations).
- 3.1 must:
- 3.1.1 be a Contractors / Companies should be registered in ASI /CPWD / PWD / MES / Local Bodies with the appropriate Authority. Further, if the bidder is a Limited / Private Limited Company should also registered Under the Companies Act, 1956 / Proprietorship Company registered with the appropriate Authority. JV Consortium is not permitted
- 3.2 must:
- 3.2.1 not be insolvent, bankrupt or being wound up, not have its affairs administered by a court or a judicial officer, not have its business activities suspended and must not be the subject of legal proceedings for any of these reasons;



- 3.2.2 Not stand declared ineligible/ blacklisted/ banned/ debarred by the Archaeological Survey of India or its Ministry/ Department from participation in its Tender Processes; and/or
- 3.2.3 Not be convicted (within three years preceding the last date of bid submission) or stand declared ineligible/ suspended/ blacklisted/ banned/ debarred by appropriate agencies of Government of India from participation in Tender Processes of all of its entities, for:
- (1) offences involving moral turpitude in business dealings under the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 or any other law; and/or
 - (2) Offences under the Indian Penal Code or any other law for causing any loss of life/ limbs/ property or endangering Public Health during the execution of a public procurement contract and/ or
 - (3) Suspected to be or of doubtful loyalty to the Country or a National Security risk as determined by appropriate agencies of the Government of India
- 3.2.4 Not have changed its name or created a new business entity as covered by the definition of "Allied Firm", consequent to having been declared ineligible/ suspended/ blacklisted/ banned/ debarred as above;
- 3.2.5 Not have an association (as a bidder/ partner/ director/ employee in any capacity)
- (1) of retired Manager (of Gazetted Rank) or a retired Gazetted Officer of the Central or State Government or its Public Sector Undertakings if such a retired person has not completed the cooling-off period of one year after his retirement. However, this shall not apply if such managers/ officers have obtained a waiver of the cooling-off period from their erstwhile organization.
 - (2) of the near relations of executives of Archaeological Survey of India involved in this Tender Process
- 3.2.6 Not have a conflict of interest, which substantially affects fair competition. The prices quoted should be competitive and without adopting any unfair/ unethical/ anti-competitive means. No attempt should be made to induce any other bidder to submit or not to submit an offer for restricting competition
- 3.3 must fulfill other additional eligibility condition, as may be prescribed, in TIS or elsewhere in Tender Document.
- 3.4 Must provide such evidence of their continued eligibility to the Archaeological Survey of India if so requested.
- 3.5 If TIS/ ITB declares this to be a procurement process for two-stage, then only the bidders shortlisted/ qualified in the first stage shall be eligible to participate.
4. **Purchase Preference Policies of the Government:** As detailed in the Tender Document, the Archaeological Survey of India reserves its right to grant preferences to eligible Bidders under various Government Policies/ directives (policies relating to make in India; MSME; etc.).
5. **Pre-bid Conference:** If so indicated in TIS, Bidders are requested to attend a Pre-bid conference for clarification on the Tenders' technical specifications and commercial conditions, on the time, date, and place mentioned therein. Participation in such a Pre-bid Conference is not mandatory. If a bidder does not participate or submit any query, then no subsequent representations from them regarding the Technical/ commercial specifications/ conditions shall be entertained.
6. **Submission of Bids:**
- 6.1 Applicant/intending or interested Bidder/contractors are invited to submit their online proposal after site inspection and carefully reading the Request for Proposal (RFP) by providing (a) Technical Bid, and (b) Financial Bid separately, clearly mentioning (i) Technical proposal and (ii) Financial proposal respectively. Such proposals are to be submitted online within the stipulated date and time as mentioned in the TIS. Bids shall be submitted online only at CPPP website: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.
- 6.2 Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document. Bids must be uploaded till the deadline for submission mentioned in TIS. If the office happens to be closed on the deadline to submit the bids as specified above, this deadline shall not be extended.
- 6.3 Unless otherwise specified, in TIS, originals (or self-attested copies of originals – as
