1. The complete bidding process will be online (e-tendering) All the notifications regarding this tender notice hereafter will be published online on website <http://mahatenders.gov.in>.
2. Bidding document can be seen and downloaded from the website "<http://mahatenders.gov.in>." from 10.00 hours on / /2025 to / /2025 upto 17.00 hours.
3. The bid can be submitted in electronic format on the website from 10.00 hours on / /2025. The deadline of submission of bid is up to 17.00 hours on Dt. / /2025.
4. The tender fees and Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) 1% must be deposited through online payment or SBI Net Banking according to online procedure.
5. Bids must be accompanied with the copy of receipt of the tender fees and 1% Earnest Money Deposit (EMD).
6. Technical Bids will be opened online on / /2025 at 10.00 hours on website "<http://mahatenders.gov.in> in the office of the District Water Conservation Officer Z.P.M.I. Beed on address Z.P. Administrative Building, Beed Pincode-431122.
7. As per Rural Development Department Government Resolution No. **Sankirn 2016/PR No.148/YO-9 dated 02 December 2016**, only contractors registered with the Zilla Parishad are eligible to submit tenders for works under the Zilla Parishad.
8. **"While submitting the tender, the contractor's registration certificate must be valid for at least three months from the date of tender submission."**
9. As per Rural Development Department Government Resolution No. **Sankirn 2016/PR No.148/YO-9 dated 02 December 2016**, contractors are eligible to bid only for tenders **within the monetary limit specified for their registered class**, as mentioned in **Annexure 1**. If a contractor submits a tender for an amount **exceeding their registered class limit**, they will be declared **ineligible**.
10. Bids shall be treated as "Invalid" if scanned copies as mentioned in (4) above are not submitted online along with bid documents.
11. The Tenderer shall submit the Tender documents by uploading online in two envelopes.
12. Certain specific condition, such as owned machinery, technical staff etc. can be seen in the detailed tender notice.
13. The amount of earnest money will be forfeited in case of successful tenderer dose not pay the amount of initial security deposited within the time specified as stipulated by the Executive Engineer and complete the contract documents.
14. Tenders, which do not full fill all or any of the conditions or incomplete in any respect are liable to summary rejection.
15. Regarding Bituminous Road construction tender, scanned copy of sketch (in case of already installed plant) of plant location from farthest point of work signed by bidder should be submitted. This distance should be within 60 kilometres so as to maintain the temperature of bituminous materials as per specification before laying on site. This sketch has to be uploaded through online. After opening the Envelope No.1 it will be verified by the department that the distance of the plant to the farthest point of work is within 60 kilometres. If the distance found to be more than 60 kilometres then Envelope No. 2 of the bidder will not be opened, i.e. bidder will be disqualified.
16. All Disputes are in the Jurisdiction of Beed District Court.

**Terms and conditions:-**

1. The tender will not be accepted unless all required documents are submitted online through the e-Tendering system by the Zilla Parishad Beed, Construction Department.
2. Contractors must upload all self attested documents in Envelope No. 1 only. Only the documents as per the terms and conditions of the tender must be uploaded in the prescribed envelope.
3. A declaration affidavit must be submitted on a stamp paper of ₹500/- in the specified PDF format. The declaration format is provided in the Standard Bidding Document (SBD). Contractors must mention their email ID and contact number on the affidavit.
4. As per Government Resolution GR No. GRASYO-2020/PR No.70/Construction-2 dated 05 April 2023, educated unemployed engineers registered under Rural Water Supply, Minor Irrigation, and Construction Department of Zilla Parishad Beed can be allotted works up to ₹100 lakh. As per GR dated 30 June 2020, labour co-operative societies can also be allotted works up to ₹100 lakh in one financial year. However, such engineers or societies cannot hold more than three works at a time. No work shall be allotted beyond the prescribed financial limit. A photocopy of the first page and the transaction page of the passbook is mandatory.
5. As per Public Works Department GR dated 12 April 2017, if the tender is quoted at a rate more than 10% below the estimated cost, the contractor must submit a detailed item-wise rate justification table explaining how quality work will be executed at such low rates. This must be submitted within the stipulated period.
6. As per the Finance Department Circulars:
  - Circular No. GST/1017/PR.34.81/Taxation-1 dated 19 August 2017
  - Circular No. GST/2017/PR.155/Taxation-1 dated 11 September 2017

From 1 July 2017, Goods and Services Tax (GST) will be applicable on all government contracts. The contractor must quote rates inclusive of applicable GST. Deductions under GST laws will be made from the bills as per government guidelines.

- GST registration certificate must be submitted before the release of the first payment.
  - A written undertaking for GST compliance under the GST Act, 2017 must be submitted along with the bid.
  - Details of previous year's GST returns must also be attached.
7. The format for the GST Undertaking is provided in the SBD.
  8. Instructions regarding the required machinery are provided in the SBD. A Fitness Certificate for the machinery to be used in the year 2025-26 must be obtained from the Superintending Engineer (Mechanical) and submitted.
  9. If the required machinery is on rental, the rental agreement must be registered either with the Sub-Registrar's Office or notarized by an advocate. The agreement must mention:
    - RTO registration numbers of the machines (if applicable)
    - Full description of the machinery
    - If machinery is not registered with RTO, purchase invoices and technical details must be provided.
  11. As per Rural Development Department circular dated 05/10/2018, the contractor must insure all labourers and skilled workers involved in the work.
    - If not insured, an amount equal to double the required insurance premium will be deducted from the first running bill.
    - The contractor will be fully responsible for any accidents at the site if insurance is not done.
  12. The contractor must get the RCC design (structural drawings) and quality test reports certified from the technical department of the higher office from time to time.

13. This tender is issued subject to future government guidelines, decisions, or instructions. Any such future instruction will automatically apply to this tender, and no objections shall be entertained from the contractor in this regard.
14. As per GR dated 05/04/2023, every educated unemployed engineer must submit a surety bond while participating in each tender process.
15. All the terms and conditions of this tender are included in the SBD. Contractors must read and understand them thoroughly before submitting the tender.
16. If at any stage of the tender process or during execution, any objection arises regarding the legality of submitted documents, and if such objections are found valid upon inquiry or if the registration certificate is found cancelled, the tender will be terminated immediately.
  - Legal action will be taken.
  - Any expenses incurred by the government for legal proceedings will be recovered from the contractor.
17. Right to reject or cancel any or all the tenders without assigning any reason thereof whatever may be is reserved by the undersigned.
18. Copy of Valid Income Tax Return of Last 3 Financial Years ( 2022-2023, 2023-2024 & 2024-2025) should be submitted along with Bid.
19. Copy of Professional Tax Registration Certificate should be submitted along with Bid.
20. Copy of GST Certificate should be submitted along with Bid.
21. Turnover certificate of Chartered Accountant for Years ( 2022-2023, 2023-2024 & 2024-2025) should be submitted along with Bid.
22. "As per Government Resolution No. Sankirna 2010/275/Pr. No. 172/Para 7, dated 19/10/2011, once a Labour Co-operative Society or an Educated Unemployed Engineer has reached the limit of ₹100.00 lakhs (₹10 million) in a financial year, they shall not submit any further tenders during the same financial year."
23. Time and Date of opening of financial bids will be informed by email to responsive bidder as per online system procedure.
24. Security Deposit to be submitted at the time of agreement is 2.5 % of Contract price and balance 2.5 % amount will be deducted from the running bill.
25. The guideline to download the tender document and online submission of bids and procedure of tender opening can be downloaded from website <http://mahatenders.gov.in>
26. Certain specific conditions, such as owned or hired required machinery, technical staff etc. can be seen in the detailed tender notice.
27. The rates of Tenders are as per DSR 2022-2023.
28. The work completion certificate and certificate for work in hand must be **duly signed by the concerned Head of Department.**
29. A newly registered educated unemployed engineer can participate in e-tenders exceeding ₹3.00 lakh **only after successfully completing a project up to ₹3.00 lakh.** In such cases, submission of the **work completion certificate** is mandatory. However, for such engineers participating as a **registered contractor**, submission of both the **work completion certificate** and **work in hand certificate** is mandatory.
30. While submitting the tender, the **Work Done Certificate** and **Work in Hand Certificate** must correspond to works **for which the Work Order has been issued at the Zilla Parishad level only** and must be signed by the **Executive Engineer.** Certificates issued by **Gram Panchayat, Municipal Council, or Nagar Panchayat** will **not** be accepted. With the work done certificate mandatory to submit a work compilation certificate (Form no. 65)
31. If a contractor is **registered under the same name** with both the **Zilla Parishad (Construction Department)** and the **Public Works Department (PWD), Maharashtra,** and the **Proprietor/Partner/Director** is the same in both, then:
  - Work Done and Work in Hand Certificates issued by PWD will be accepted during the Zilla Parishad tender process or registration.

- A copy of the registration certificate with the PWD must be submitted along with the bid.
  - This certificate copy will be accepted **only for verifying** the Work Done and Work in Hand Certificates.
  - However, the contractor **must still be registered with the Zilla Parishad** to be eligible to submit the tender.
32. Only those **Work Done** and **Work in Hand Certificates** which are **signed by the Executive Engineer** will be accepted.
33. The **Work Done Certificate**, **Work in Hand Certificate**, and **verification certificates** must **clearly mention the date** of issue.
34. **Single Work OF Similar type Work done Certificate** of last two years (year 2023-24 and 2024-2025) **The of Valuation which must be 35% of Tender Amount**
35. If the contractor does **not own the required machinery**, then a **rent agreement** on a **stamp paper of ₹500/-** must be executed between the contractor and the machinery owner.
36. As per Public Works Department Circular dated **26.11.2018**, the condition to submit the **Additional Performance Security Deposit (APSD)** in **Envelope No. 2** for tenders quoted at less than 1% below the estimated cost **has been cancelled**. Instead, after opening Envelope No. 1 and No. 2, the **L-1 (lowest) bidder** must submit the APSD in the form of a **Demand Draft (DD)** to the **concerned Officer** within **8 days**. This 8-day period **will not be extended** under any circumstances. Failure to submit the APSD within the stipulated time will result in:
- Automatic disqualification of the bidder,
  - Forfeiture of the 1% bid security,
  - Blacklisting of the bidder,
  - Allotment of work to the L-2 bidder.
- All bidders are expected to take **due note** of this.
37. As per the same GR dated **26.11.2018**, the **Additional Performance Security Deposit (APSD)** must be submitted to the concerned **concernedOfficer** within **8 days**, as per the mentioned terms.

38. If the **L-1 (lowest bidder)** fails to deposit the APSD within the stipulated period (i.e., within **8 days** from the date of opening Envelope No. 1 and 2), then a **written request** shall be made to

the **L-2 (second lowest bidder)**. If L-2 is willing to execute the work **at the rate quoted by L-1**, they must submit a **written consent letter** along with the required **APSD (Demand Draft)** to the **concerned Officer** within **8 days** from the date of issuance of the letter. If L-2 fails to submit both the written consent and the APSD within the prescribed 8-day period, the **L-3 (third lowest bidder)** will be approached under the same conditions. If L-3 also fails to submit the DD within 8 days, the work shall be **retendered**.

39. As per the letter dated **08/02/2017** from the **Hon'ble Commissioner, Employees' Provident Fund Organization, Solapur**, it is **mandatory** for all contractors to deposit PF (Provident Fund) contributions of the workers engaged by them. Accordingly, contractors must submit their **EPF Registration Certificate** along with the tender.
40. As per Government Resolution **No. 2020/PR No. 70/Bandh-2 dated 05/04/2023**, educated unemployed engineers registered under the **Rural Water Supply, Minor Irrigation and Construction Department, Zilla Parishad Beed** are eligible for work up to **₹100 lakhs** within a **10-year period**. Similarly, as per GR **No. GRASYO-2019/PR No. 112/Bandh-2 dated 30/06/2020**, labour co-operative societies are eligible to receive work up to **₹100 lakhs in one financial year**.
- While allocating work through a committee, such engineers/societies must not hold more than **three works at a time**.
  - No work shall be allotted beyond the **specified financial capacity**.
  - A **photocopy of the first page** and the **pages containing entries** of the **passbook** issued to the Educated Unemployed Engineer (EUE) or Labour Co-operative Society (LCS) must be enclosed.
41. Eligible contractors who are awarded the tender must submit a **Demand Draft (DD) equivalent to 2% of the contract value** as a **Security Deposit** to the concerned office **within 8 days** from the date of issuance of the allotment letter. Failure to do so will result in **forfeiture of their Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)** and **blacklisting of the contractor**.
42. All Government Resolutions issued from time to time by the Government shall be **applicable and binding**.
43. In case of any **difficulty, dispute, or ambiguity** during the tender process or approval stage, the **final decision-making authority** shall rest with the **Committee Head**, i.e., the **Hon'ble Additional Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad, Beed**.
