Item rate bids are invited on behalf of President of India from approved and eligible electrical contractors of CPWD and those of appropriate list of M.E.S, BSNL, Railway and Assam State PWDs (Electrical) for the work of **“Repair and Maintenance of 100 KVA DG set BOP Rajai and Nokariyanala of 153 BN BSF under SHQ BSF Shillong.”**

The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of bids. In case the last date of submission of bid is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of bids.

1.1 The work is estimated to cost **Rs. 98,892/- (Rupees Ninety eight thousand eight hundred ninety two)** only. This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.

1.2 Intending bidders are eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below:-

Criteria of eligibility for submission of bid documents

1.2.1 Conditions for CPWD/Non-CPWD registered electrical contractors of departments/Specialized firms/ experience of similar nature of works above mentioned in tender notice, if bids are also open to CPWD/non-CPWD contractors.

Three similar works each of value not less than **Rs. 90,976/-** or two similar work each of value not less than **Rs. 1,36,464/-** or one similar work of value not less than **Rs. 1,81,952/-** (all figures rounded to nearest convenient figure) in last 7 years ending previous day of last date of submission of bids.

1.2.2 Criteria of eligibility for CPWD as well as non-CPWD contractors,

For works estimated to cost above the tendering limit of class -1 composite category Contractor (However for Horticulture and Furniture discipline, it may be modified as per bidding limit of CPWD class I contractors of respective discipline as the case may be.

Three similar works each of value not less than **Rs. 90,976/-** or two similar work each of value not less than **Rs. 1,36,464/-** or one similar work of value not less than **Rs. 1,81,952/-** (all figures rounded to nearest convenient figure) in last 7 years ending previous day of last date of submission of bids.

The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum, calculated from the date of completion to the last-date of submission of bid. This is applicable for 1.2.1 as well as 1.2.2 .

To become eligible for issue of bid, the bidders shall have to furnish an affidavit as under:-

I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for bidding in **BSF** in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer-in-Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee.

- 1.2.3 When bids are invited from non CPWD contractors and CPWD contractors as per provisions of **clause 1.2.1** above, it will be mandatory for non CPWD contractors and CPWD contractors to upload the work experience certificate(s) and the affidavit as per the provisions of **clause 1.2.2**.
- 2 Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form No. **CPWD-8** (or other Standard Form as mentioned) which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website www.eprocure.gov.in. or www.bsf.gov.in. Bidders shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
- 3 The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **30 Days** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.
- 4 The site for the work is available.
- 5 The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except Standard General Conditions of Contract Form can be seen and downloaded from website www.eprocure.gov.in. or www.bsf.gov.in free of cost.

- 9 Earnest Money amounting to Rupees **1,998/-** in the form of Demand Draft Cheque or Fixed Deposit Receipt (drawn in favour of **DIG SHQ BSF SHILLONG** shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. - (i) The bidder does not upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the bid document.
- (ii) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest bidder in the office of bid opening authority.
- (iii) If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

11 The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee of 5% (Five Percent) of the bid amount within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of Demand Draft of any scheduled bank/ (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs. 1,00,000/-) or Government Securities or Fixed Deposit Receipts the State Bank of India in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F', including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor.

The earnest money deposited along with bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee. A bidders shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. - 13 The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.
- 14 Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
- 15 The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
- 16 The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the BSF responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any gazetted officer in the BSF Department or in the **Ministry of Home Affairs**. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would renders him liable to be removed from the approved list of contractors of this Department.
- 17 No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.
- 18 The bids for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **seventy five (75)** days from the date of opening of bids.
- (i) ~~If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modifications in the terms & condition of the tender which is not acceptable to the department within 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.~~

1. The work shall be carried out as per CPWD/OEM specification amended upto date and as per instruction of Engineer-in Charge.
2. Approval of the Engineer-in Charge shall be taken well in advance for all the material to be supplied and used in all the works by the contractor.
3. The contractor has to make own arrangement for stores and watch and ward and no extra claim for this will be entertained.
4. The contractor shall make his own arrangement at his own cost for electrical/general tools and plant required for the work.
5. The connections interconnections earthing and loop earthing shall be done by the contractor whenever required to be done for energisation of the installation and nothing extra shall be paid on this account.
6. The contractor must be able to work on concrete slabs /wall as and when required and in complete coordination with the civil works. Cutting of chases in the plastered wall shall in no case be allowed. The contractor shall fix conduits and boxes in the walls soon after the brick work is completed and finish the cases to rough surface with proper cement sand mixture. Only in exceptional cases e.g. where cutting of plastered surface cannot be avoided it will be contractor's responsibility to ensure that plastering is done to match the original finish at no extra cost.
7. The contractor shall remove all the debris due to the electrical works from the site as soon as the work is completed.
8. The copper wire to be used on this work shall be FRLS type and ISI marked.
9. The electrical works shall be carried out by the contractor, side by side with the progress of civil work.
