The Superintending Engineer, Nayagarh Irrigation Division, Nayagarh on behalf of Hon'ble Governor of Odisha invites on-line percentage rate tenders through e-procurement for execution of the works noted below. The bid should be submitted by eligible class of contractors as mentioned below registered with State Government & contractors of equivalent grade / class registered with Central Government / MES / Railway to be eventually drawn in P-1 form through On-line in the Govt. web site www.tenderodisha.gov.in. The availability of on-line bidding is from **15.00** hours of **13.05.2026** to **17.00** hours of **25.05. 2026**. The tenderers must submit their EMD and paper cost by on line through a process as mentioned in DTCN. Affidavit (Single work name should be mentioned in each affidavit) and attested copies of PAN, GSTIN, CDMS registered registration certificate & no relation certificate must be submitted through online otherwise the tender will be rejected. The technical bids will be opened on **26.05.2026** at **11.00 hours** in the office of the undersigned. The bidders should have necessary portal enrollment (with own digital signature certificate). The registered bidders outside Odisha state can also participate in this on-line tender process after necessary portal enrolment but shall have to subsequently undergo registration with appropriate authority of the state government within a month of acceptance of bid.

1. Bid document consisting of qualification, information and eligibility criteria of bidders, plans, specification and schedule of quantities of the works available in web-site www.tendersorissa.gov.in and the set of terms and conditions of contract and other necessary documents can be seen in the web-site till last date of submission of Bid.
2. The bidder shall transfer the required amount of E.M.D. and Cost of Bid Document as mentioned for the specified work in Col. - 5 & 6 respectively of above Table by online through a process as mentioned in DTCN.
3. Every tenderer is expected before quoting his rates to inspect the site of the proposed work. He should also inspect the quarries and approach road to quarries and locality of the work and satisfy himself about the quality and availability of materials including the medical aids, labour and foodstuff etc. In every case the materials must comply with the relevant specifications. The contractors would, however, be responsible for procurement of materials from authorized sources and voluntarily disclose the source of procurement for the purpose of billing. Besides, the bidder would be required to submit the details of quarry for procurement while submitting the bids.
4. The tenderer will be deemed to have satisfied himself that the rates quoted by him in the tender will be adequate to complete the work according to the specifications and conditions attached to and that he has taken into account all conditions, difficulties that may be encountered during its progress and to have quoted labour rates and materials, leads, lifts, loading and unloading and freight for materials and all other charges necessary for the completion of the work to the entire satisfaction of the Engineer-in-charge of the work and his authorized subordinates. In the course of awarding a work, the Department may desire the analysis of the rate arrived for against any item(s) of work. The estimated cost is excluding GST. The rate of item basing on which estimate cost has been derived are excluding GST or different components to arrive such rates.
5. The bid for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of bids. If any bidder withdraws his/her bid before the said period or makes any modification in the terms and condition of the bid, the EMD deposit at the time of submission of tender shall stand forfeited.
6. Engineering contractor desires of availing EMD & ISD exemption shall submit an affidavit to the effect that he/she has not availed these facilities for more than two works during the current financial year.
7. The original Affidavit should be retained by the bidders. The bidders have to furnish the original documents to the S.E, Nayagarh Irrigation Division, Nayagarh as and when required for verification of tender. The successful bidder has to submit the original Affidavit (Single work name should be mentioned in each affidavit) to the Superintending Engineer, Nayagarh Irrigation Division, Nayagarh before drawl of the Agreement. The bidder should upload their Contact details (e-Mail or Mobile No) in a separate sheet for further correspondence.
8. Each tenderer must quote a definite percentage upto two decimal points. Tenders containing indefinite terms such as 'as estimated rates or schedule of rates or percentage basis will not be considered.
9. All royalties, payable Income taxes & Surcharges as applicable will be borne by the contractor as admissible. It is implied that the quoted rates are inclusive of such elements.
10. Labour Welfare Cess @ 1% will be deducted from the work bill of the contractor as per resolution No. 12653 dt. 15.12.2008 of Labour & Employment Department, Government of ODISHA.

11. 1. Additional performance security shall be taken on an incremental basis from the selected bidder for low bid prices in the project works as under:(As per Works Department OM No.173 dt.03.01.2026)
 - I. where the bid price is below 0% but not below 10% of the project cost put to bid, no additional performance guarantee/security percentage is required.
 - II. where the bid price is below 10% but not below 20% of the project cost put to bid, the additional performance guarantee/security percentage shall be incremented by 0.1% for every percentage of bid price below 10% of the project cost put to bid starting at 11% with the additional bid performance guarantee being 0.1% and this additional performance guarantee percentage shall be applied on the bid price;
 - III. where the bid price is 20% or more below of the project cost put to bid. the additional performance guarantee percentage shall be incremented by 0.2% for every percentage of bid price below 20% of the project cost put to bid in addition to 1% of the bid price and this additional performance guarantee percentage shall be applied on the bid price;
 - IV. The additional performance guarantee percentage shall be rounded off to the next lower percentage based on whether the decimal point of the percentage of bid price is below 0.5% or next higher percentage based on whether the decimal point of the percentage of bid price is 0.5% or more.
 - V. The additional performance security shall be treated as part of the performance security.
 - VI. The applicable Additional Performance Security (APS) shall have to be furnished by the successful bidder in shape of Term Deposit Receipt pledged in favour of Superintending Engineer, Nayagarh Irrigation Division, Nayagarh / Bank Guarantee in favour of the Superintending Engineer, Nayagarh Irrigation Division, Nayagarh from any Nationalised / Scheduled Bank in India counter guaranteed by its local branch at Nayagarh within seven days of issue of Letter of Acceptance (LoA) by the Superintending Engineer, Nayagarh Irrigation Division, Nayagarh. (by e-mail) to the successful bidder otherwise the bid of the successful bidder shall be cancelled. Further, proceeding for blacklisting shall be initiated against the bidder. (Vide Office Memorandum No -14459/W dated 20.09.2018 of Works Department, Govt. of Odisha).
 - VII. The security will be refunded after one year on completion of the work in all respect provided the final bill is passed and will not carry any interest. Any defect noticed during the period of one year after the actual date of completion shall be rectified by the contractor at his own cost. Failure to comply such rectification the cost involved to carry out the defective work shall be met from his dues available with Department. (Ref. works Dept order No. 17823/WE dt. 11.10.2006. The e-procurement portal system shall generate the award of the contract letter and intimate the bidder in his e-mail after acceptance of the tender.
 - VIII. Justification for abnormally low bids shall be scrutinized by the Departmental Technical Committee and recommended to the competent authority of the Administrative Department for the approval of the Additional Performance Security (APS). An abnormally low bid is one in which the Bid price, in combination with other elements of the Bid, appears so low that it raises material concerns as to the capability of the Bidder to perform the contract at the offered price. Procuring Entity may, in such cases, seek written clarifications from the Bidder. Including detailed price analyses of its Bid price in relation to scope, schedule, resource mobilization, allocation of risks and responsibilities, and any other requirements of the bid document, if after evaluating the price analyses, the procuring entity determines that the Bidder has substantially failed to demonstrate its capability to deliver the contract at the offered price, the Procuring Entity may reject the Bid/Proposal. However, it would not be advisable to fix a normative percentage below the estimated cost, which would automatically be considered as an abnormally low bid.
 - IX. If more than one bid is quoted (decimal upto two numbers will be taken for all practical purposes), either at the estimated cost put to tender or less than the estimated cost put to tender, the tender accepting authority will finalize the tender through a transparent lottery system, where all the concerned bidders / their authorized representatives, the concerned SE and EE of the concerned Division and DAO will remain present.
 - X. If the rate quoted by the SC & ST category contractor comes to the rate quoted by the L1 Bidder (decimal upto two numbers will be taken for all practical purposes) after availing 10% price preference as per Para.II of Works Dept. Resolution No.27748/Dtd.11.10.1977. The tender shall be finalized by the tender accepting authority through a transparent lottery system along with other categories of contractor.
12. **THE CONTRACTOR HAS TO MENTION PERCENTAGE EXCESS OR LESS OVER THE AMOUNT PUT TO TENDER.**
13. The contractor will write percentage excess or less upto two decimal point only if he writes the percentage excess or less upto more than two decimal point, the two decimal point shall only be considered without rounding up.
14. A bidder can submit only one tender paper for a particular work, submission of more than one tender paper by a bidder for a particular tender will liable for rejection of all such tender papers as per Works Department Letter No.4985/W dt.28.03.2007.
15. The single tender received in the first call shall be cancelled without opening of the bid. The acceptance of a single tender received, even after retendering should have prior approval of the next higher authority as per Works Department Memorandum No.16 dt.01.01.2015.
16. If the first lowest bidder does not turn up for agreement after finalization of tender than the shall be debarred from participation in bidding for 3 years and action will be taken to black list the contractor as per Codal provision in Annexure-II of Amendment to Para-3,4,14 Note-I of OPWD code Vol-I.
17. In case of SC/ST bidders who want to avail price preference, may avail price preference as per the Resolution File No.16262/ W Dtd.30.10.2018 of Works Dept, Govt of Odisha. He/She must have to furnish the required affidavit online along with the tender document to avail the price preference otherwise they will not be entitled to avail the facilities.
18. The bidder must be provided his/her active Mobile number and e-Mail ID with the tender documents for any type of future correspondences required if any (This office will not be held responsible for non-intimate to Bidder due to Non-Submission of his/her valid Mobile No/e-Mail ID or any system failure).
19. Any addendum/corrigendum/cancellation of above tender will be published in the web-site www.tenderorissa.gov.in, and in the notice board. The system shall generate a mail to those bidders who have already uploaded their tenders and those bidders if they wish, can modify their tenders.
20. The Authority reserves the right to reject/cancel any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons thereof.
