1. The Superintending Engineer, Mahanadi South Division, No.I Cuttack on behalf of the Governor of Odisha invites On-line Percentage rate tenders through e-procurement for execution of works. The bid should be submitted by eligible class of contractors through On-line in the Govt. website [www.tenderodisha.gov.in](http://www.tenderodisha.gov.in). The bidders should have necessary portal enrolment (with own digital signature certificate). The registered bidders outside of Odisha State can also participate in this On-line tender process after necessary portal enrolment but shall have to subsequently undergo registration with appropriate authority of the State Govt. within a month of acceptance of bid.

- Availability of Tender for On-line bidding from 12.05.2026 at 11.00 A.M. to 22.05.2026 up to 5.00 P.M. from Govt. web site [www.tenderodisha.gov.in](http://www.tenderodisha.gov.in).
- The bidder shall submit the required **Earnest money deposit (EMD) col. 04 of the work list table and cost of bid document as mentioned in Col 04 of the said table, as part of its bid vide works Department OM No OM No. 3785/W Dated 09.05.2017 and 6785/W Dated 09.05.2017** through online process as mentioned in DTCN.

5. After careful observation, Government has been pleased to abolish the extant provisions of threshold negative bid caps (14.99%) introduced in Appendix-IX, Clause 36 of OPWD Code Volume-II in the procurement of works undertaken by the Govt of Odisha and its agencies to ensure the procurement process results in a viable and successful manner with adoption of following incremental Additional Performance Security (APS) system **(Communicated vide OM No-07764600022025-173/W Dated 03.01.2026 of the Works Department, Govt. of Odisha.)**

Additional performance security shall be taken on an incremental basis from the selected bidder for low bid prices in the project works as under:

- a) **where the bid price is below 0% but not below 10% of the project cost put to bid**  
no additional performance guarantee/security percentage is required.
- b) **where the bid price is below 10% but not below 20% of the project cost put to bid**  
the additional performance guarantee/security percentage shall be incremented by 0.1% for every percentage of bid price below 10% of the project cost put to bid starting at 11% with the additional bid performance guarantee being 0.1% and this additional performance guarantee percentage shall be applied on the bid price.
- c) **where the bid price is 20% or more below of the project cost put to bid**  
the additional performance guarantee percentage shall be incremented by 0.2% for every percentage of bid price below 20% of the project cost put to bid in addition to 1% of the bid price and this additional performance guarantee percentage shall be applied on the bid price.
- d) The additional performance guarantee percentage shall be rounded off to the next lower percentage based on whether the decimal point of the percentage of bid price is below 0.5% or next higher percentage based on whether the decimal point of the percentage of bid price is 0.5% or more.
- e) The additional performance security shall be treated as part of the performance security.
- f) Justification for abnormally low bids shall be scrutinized by the Departmental Technical Committee and recommended to the competent authority of the Administrative Department for the approval of the Additional Performance Security (APS). An abnormally low bid is one in which the Bid price, in combination with other elements of the Bid, appears so low that it raises material concerns as to the capability of the Bidder to perform the contract at the offered price. Procuring Entity may, in such cases, seek written clarifications from the Bidder, including detailed price analyses of its Bid price in relation to scope, schedule, resource mobilization, allocation of risks and responsibilities, and any other requirements of the bid document. If, after evaluating the price analyses, the procuring entity determines that the Bidder has substantially failed to demonstrate its capability to deliver the contract at the offered price, the Procuring Entity may reject the Bid/ Proposal. However, it would not be advisable to fix a normative percentage below the estimated cost, which would automatically be considered as an abnormally low bid.
- g) If more than one bid are found to be lowest, the tender accepting authority will finalize the tender through a transparent lottery system.

6. The applicable Additional performance security (APS) in shape of **N.S.C./ Post Office Savings Bank Account/ Post Office Time Deposit Account/ Kisan Vikas Patra/ Bank Guarantee** in favour of the Divisional Officer from any Nationalized Scheduled Bank in India counter guaranteed by its local branch at Bhubaneswar/ e- Bank Guarantee executed on the National e- Governance Services Limited (NeSL) Digital Document Execution Portal/Insurance Surety Bond issued by an insurance company authorized by the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) within seven days of issue of Letter of Acceptance (LoA) by the Divisional Officer by (e-mail) to the successful bidder otherwise the bid of the successful bidder shall be cancelled and the Earnest money Deposit / Bid security deposit shall be forfeited. Further proceeding for blacklisting shall be initiated against the bidder. (As per Works Department office Memorandum No.14459/W dated 20.09.2018) & 1499/W dated 01.02.2023.
7. Bid validity period of the Tender is for a period of 90 days from the last date of submission of Bid. Conditional bid is subject to forfeiture of EMD. If any bidder withdraws his Bid/Tender before the said period or makes any modification in the terms and condition of the bid, the E.M.D. deposited at the time of submission of tender / bid shall stand forfeited.
8. Exemption of EMD to the Engineer contractor will be allowed for a maximum of three works in a financial year and the fact of awarding a work with Exemption of EMD should be entered in the Original Registration Certificate of the Engineer Contractor and accordingly updated in the CDMS portal. Engineer contractor desirous to avail the exemption of E.M.D. is required to submit an affidavit to the effect that he/she has not yet availed the facility for more than two works during the current financial year otherwise, the bid will be liable for rejection.
9. The bidder should upload all the document as per clauses of DTCN in the pdf format. Non-submission of Affidavit and No Relation Certificate is liable for rejection of the Tender.
10. The original Affidavit should be retained by the bidder with him. The bidders have to furnish the original documents to the Superintending Engineer, Mahanadi South Division-I, Cuttack as & when required for verification of tender. The successful bidder have to submit the original Affidavit to the Superintending Engineer, Mahanadi South Division-I, Cuttack before drawal of the Agreement.
11. Date of opening of tender for technical & financial bid for the works are scheduled on dated **as mentioned in the column 6 in the above table** in the office of the Superintending Engineer, Mahanadi South Division-I, Cuttack. If the office happens to be closed on the aforesaid date, the date of opening will be extended to next working day at same time and venue.
12. ***The bidder shall pay / transfer the required EMD / Bid Security by online as mentioned in the Tender details through payment gateway of designated banks and in no other form. A bidder shall make electronic payment using his / her Internet Banking enabled account with designated banks or their aggregator banks. A bidder having account in other banks can make payment using NEFT / RTGS facility of designated banks. The bidder should ensure that EMD / Bid Security is paid through payment gateway online mode only.***
13. **THE CONTRACTOR HAS TO MENTION PERCENTAGE EXCESS OR LESS OVER THE ESTIMATED COST (IN FIGURE UPTO TWO DECIMAL POINT AND WORDS)**

14. In percentage rate of tender, only percentage quoted shall be considered. Percentage quoted by the contractor shall be accurately filled in figure & words, so that there is no discrepancy, If any discrepancy is found in the percentage quoted in words and figures then percentage quoted by the contractor in words shall be taken as correct. If excess / less is not mentioned, then the rate will be treated as percentage excess.
15. The contractor will write percentage Excess or less upto two decimal point only if he writes the percentage excess or less up to more than two decimal point, the two decimal point shall only be considered without rounding up.
16. A bidder can submit only one tender paper for a particular work, submission of more than one tender paper by a bidder for a particular tender will be liable for rejection of all such tender tender papers as per works Department letter No. 4985/WE dated 28.03.2007.
17. The tender accepting authority will verify the originals of all the scanned documents of the lowest successful bidder only within 5 days of opening of the tender. In the eventuality of failure on the part of the lowest bidder to produce the original documents, he will be debarred in future from participating in tender for 3 years and will be black listed by the competent authority. In such a situation, successful L-2 bidder will be required to produce his original documents for consideration of his tender at the negotiated rate equal to L1 bidder.
18. The scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe / Contractors desirous to avail the facility of preference as per Govt. rule should have to furnish the required affidavit to avail price preference and enclose the copy of their registration certificate stating the fact of caste by their registration authority with the bid, failing which they will not get price preference as per above rule.
19. The technical and financial bid will be opened online on **the date and venue as mentioned as above table**, in the office of the undersigned in the presence of the bid or their authorized agents, who wish to attend. If the office happens to be closed on the last date of receipt and the date of opening of the bids as specified, the bids will be received and opened on the corresponding next working day at the same time and venue. For finalization of the tender, a transparent lottery system will be adopted (if required) in the office of the Superintending Engineer, Mahanadi South Division No.1 Cuttack.
20. Authority reserves the right to reject any or all of the tenders without assigning any reasons thereof.
