The registered bidders outside of Odisha State can also participate in this on-line tender process after necessary portal enrolment but shall have to subsequently undergo registration with appropriate authority of the State Govt. within a month of acceptance of the bid.

1. Bid document consisting of qualification, information, eligibility criteria of bidders and tender schedule of the works are available in web-site www.tendersodisha.gov.in and the set of terms and conditions of contract and other necessary documents can be seen in the web-site till last date of availability and receipt of bid documents online.
- 2 The tenders will be available online for bidding **from 10.00 Hrs of 19.05.2026 to 17.30 Hrs of 28.05.2026** in the website www.tendersodisha.gov.in. The technical bids will be opened online **at 11.30 Hours of 29.05.2026**.
3. The bidders shall transfer the required amount of E.M.D/ Bid security and cost of bid documents as mentioned for the specified work in col. 5 & 8 respectively of the table above by online through a process as mentioned in the DTCN.
4. No Engineer of Gazetted rank or other Gazetted officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering department of the State Government is allowed to work as a contractor after a period of two years of retirement from Government service, without Government permission.
5. Exemption of EMD to the Engineer Contractor will be allowed for a maximum of three (3) works in a financial year and the fact of awarding a work with exemption of EMD should be entered in the original registration certificate of the Engineer contractor. **Engineer Contractor desirous to avail the exemption of EMD is required to submit an affidavit to the effect that he/she has not yet availed the facility for more than two works during the current financial year.**
6. The original affidavit should be retained by the bidder. The bidder has to furnish the original documents to the Superintending Engineer, Mahanadi North Division-I, Jagatpur as and when required for verification of tender. The successful bidder has to submit the original affidavit to the Superintending Engineer, Mahanadi North Division-I, Jagatpur before drawl of agreement.
7. After careful observation, Government has been pleased to abolish the extant provisions of threshold negative bid caps (14.99%) introduced in Appendix-IX, Clause 36 of OPWD Code Volume-II in the procurement of works undertaken by the Govt of Odisha and its agencies to ensure the procurement process results in a viable and successful manner with adoption of following incremental Additional Performance Security (APS) system **(Communicated vide OM No-07764600022025-173/W Dated 03.01.2026 of the Works Department, Govt. of Odisha.)**

Additional performance security shall be taken on an incremental basis from the selected bidder for low bid prices in the project works as under:

- a) **where the bid price is below 0% but not below 10% of the project cost put to bid**
no additional performance guarantee/security percentage is required.
 - b) **where the bid price is below 10% but not below 20% of the project cost put to bid**
the additional performance guarantee/security percentage shall be incremented by 0.1% for every percentage of bid price below 10% of the project cost put to bid starting at 11% with the additional bid performance guarantee being 0.1% and this additional performance guarantee percentage shall be applied on the bid price.
 - c) **where the bid price is 20% or more below of the project cost put to bid**
the additional performance guarantee percentage shall be incremented by 0.2% for every percentage of bid price below 20% of the project cost put to bid in addition to 1% of the bid price and this additional performance guarantee percentage shall be applied on the bid price.
 - d) The additional performance guarantee percentage shall be rounded off to the next lower percentage based on whether the decimal point of the percentage of bid price is below 0.5% or next higher percentage based on whether the decimal point of the percentage of bid price is 0.5% or more.
 - e) The additional performance security shall be treated as part of the performance security.
 - f) Justification for abnormally low bids shall be scrutinized by the Departmental Technical Committee and recommended to the competent authority of the Administrative Department for the approval of the Additional Performance Security (APS). An abnormally low bid is one in which the Bid price, in combination with other elements of the Bid, appears so low that it raises material concerns as to the capability of the Bidder to perform the contract at the offered price. Procuring Entity may, in such cases, seek written clarifications from the Bidder, including detailed price analyses of its Bid price in relation to scope, schedule, resource mobilization, allocation of risks and responsibilities, and any other requirements of the bid document. If, after evaluating the price analyses, the procuring entity determines that the Bidder has substantially failed to demonstrate its capability to deliver the contract at the offered price, the Procuring Entity may reject the Bid/ Proposal. However, it would not be advisable to fix a normative percentage below the estimated cost, which would automatically be considered as an abnormally low bid.
 - g) If more than one bid are found to be lowest, the tender accepting authority will finalize the tender through a transparent lottery system.
8. The applicable Additional performance security (APS) in shape of **N.S.C./ Post Office Savings Bank Account/ Post Office Time Deposit Account/ Kisan Vikas Patra/ Bank Guarantee** in favour of the Divisional Officer from any Nationalized Scheduled Bank in India counter guaranteed by its local branch at Bhubaneswar/ **e- Bank Guarantee executed on the National e- Governance Services Limited (NeSL) Digital Document Execution Portal** within seven days of issue of Letter of Acceptance (LoA) by the Divisional Officer by (e-mail) to the successful bidder otherwise the bid of the successful bidder shall be cancelled and the Earnest money Deposit / Bid security deposit shall be forfeited. Further proceeding for blacklisting shall be initiated against the bidder. (As per Works Department office Memorandum No.14459/W dated 20.09.2018) & 1499/W dated 01.02.2023.
9. The Schedule Caste / Schedule Tribe Contractors desirous to avail the facility of preference as per Govt. rule should have to submit the original affidavit for availing such preference, failing which no preference will be given.

10. Bid validity period of the tender is for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of Bid. Conditional bid is subject to forfeiture of EMD. If any bidder withdraws his bid/tender before the said period or makes any modification in the terms and condition of the bid, the E.M.D deposited at the time of submission of bid/tender shall stand forfeited.
11. The Single Tender received in the first call shall be cancelled without opening of the bid. The acceptance of a single tender received even after re-tendering should have prior approval of the next higher authority.
12. The contractors are required to pay the Royalty, DMF, EMF & additional charges of minor minerals as fixed by the Govt. and amended if any from time to time.
13. Other details and conditions can be seen in the bidding documents, which is available in web-site www.tendersorissa.gov.in.
14. **The MSME registered contractors are required to deposit the EMD while tendering for any work. Without EMD their bid will be treated as INVALID.**
15. The authority reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons thereof.
