For and on behalf of the President of India, the Director General of Lighthouses and Lightships (DGLL), Noida, invites online bids under two cover system (Part I-Technical Bid, Part II Commercial Bid) from eligible bidders having experience and expertise for the following work:

2	Estimated Cost of Work	Rs. 22.00 Crores (Rupees Twenty Two Crores Only) for 03 years.(Exclusive of GST)
3	Period of Contract	Initially for a period of 01 year and shall be extended for further 02 years on yearly basis subject to satisfactory performance.
4	Earnest Money Deposit	Rs. 44,00,000/- (Rupees Forty-Four Lakhs Only) in the form of Demand Draft/Fixed Deposit receipt (FDR) or Bank Guarantee issued by any scheduled Bank drawn in favor of Pay and Account Officer, Lighthouses and Lightships, Noida payable at Noida.

11	Initial eligibility criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Bidder should have a valid registration certificate issued by DG shipping under Recruitment and Placement of Seafarer Rules, 2016, as amended. 2. The bidder should have minimum 5 years of manning experience of trading vessels under Recruitment and Placement of Seafarer Rules, 2016, as amended. 3. The bidder shall have minimum 5 years of management experience of trading vessel under ISM - DOC issued by Director General Shipping. Note: - For the purpose of 2 & 3 above, trading vessels shall mean all sea going vessels of capacity not less than 2400 GRT registered under applicable Act for trading purposes excluding fishing trawlers and non-self-propelled floating vessels. 4. The bidder should have similar experience and satisfactorily executed as below works in any central /state government organization or reputed private organizations during last Seven years ending on the last day of the month previous to the one in which, the tenders are invited, and should produce documentary evidence with monitory value:- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least three similar works, each of value not less than Rs. 8.8 Crores (40% of the estimated cost put to tender). (or) • At least two similar works, each of value not less than Rs. 11.0 Crores (50% of the estimated cost put to tender). (or) • At least one similar work of value not less than Rs. 17.60 Crores (80% of the estimated cost put to tender). <p>Similar work shall mean "Manning and Management of sea going Vessels of capacity not less than 2400 GRT". Fishing trawlers and non-self-propelled floating vessels shall not be considered.</p>
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1.1 The details of work are available in the tender document which can be downloaded from Central Public Procurement (CPP) Portal <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> and <http://dgll.gov.in/>. The bid should be submitted online only on <http://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> up to last date and time of submission of tender.

- 1.2 The EMD shall be submitted in original to the Tender Inviting Authority, on or before the last date and time of bid submission, failing which the tender shall be liable to be rejected. DGLL shall not be responsible for any delay or loss, due to postal/Courier Services.
- 1.3 Bidders who are Micro and Small enterprises (MSEs), registered with Micro Small Medium Enterprises (MSME) or National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) or any other body specified by Ministry of MSME for similar nature of Works shall be eligible for exemption from payment of EMD as per the prevailing guidelines issued by the Government of India. They are required to submit documentary proof of such registration along with duly filled "Bid Security Declaration Form" as per Annexure-I. The NSIC / MSME certificate and Bid Declaration Form shall be submitted along with the technical bid for claiming the exemptions.
- a. If the Registration Certificate or certificate issued for the works does not pertain to "Similar Works" and / or non-submission of Bid Security Declaration Form, such exemption shall not be granted and their Bid will be liable to be rejected.
 - b. MSMEs, which are specified by the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises under MSME Act 2006 and Public Procurement Policy, 2012 as Manufacturing / Service Enterprises should have registered with NSIC under its Single Point Registration Scheme (SPRS).
 - c. The items of works / Services mentioned under MSME / NSIC certificate should be the same or similar work of tender.
- 1.4 The Technical Bids will be scrutinized by a Tender Evaluation Committee. The bids, which do not meet the tender requirements, are liable to be rejected. The commercial bids of technically qualified bidders meeting with the pre-qualification requirements shall only be opened. The decision of the Director General of Lighthouses & Lightships, Noida in deciding the successful bidder shall be final and binding on the bidders.
- 1.5 The Bidder shall carefully read Eligibility Criteria & instructions to Bidders, Technical requirement & Scope of work, General & Special conditions of contract, and all other documents in connection with the Bid. The Bidder shall quote his rates, keeping all above points in mind.
- 1.6 The bid comprises of Running, Maintenance and Management of Lighthouse Tender vessels namely M.V. Sagardeep II (GRT-2466), M.V Indira Point (GRT-2477). The Director General, Directorate General of Lighthouses & Lightships, Noida, reserves to himself the right of accepting the bid. Bidder shall be bound to perform the same at the quoted rates.
- 1.7 Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with Bid is strictly prohibited. The Bids submitted by the Bidders, who resort to canvassing, shall be summarily rejected.
- 1.8 Those Bidders whose near relatives are posted as accountant or as a gazetted Officer in any capacity in the Directorate General of Lighthouses & Lightships shall not be permitted to Bid. The prospective Bidder shall also intimate the names of persons who are working in the office of Director General of Lighthouses and Lightships, Noida in

any capacity or subsequently employed, who are near relative to any gazetted officer in the DGLL or in the Ministry of Shipping. Any breach of this condition by the bidder shall render him ineligible. By the term 'near relative' is meant wife, husband, parents & grand parents, children & grandchildren, brothers & sisters, uncles, aunts & corresponding in laws.

1.9 No Gazetted Officer of Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor without prior permission of the Govt. of India in writing for a period of two years after his retirement from government service. The contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found at any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of Govt. of India as aforesaid, before submission of the Bid or engagement in the contractor's service.

1.10 The Notice Inviting Bids shall form the part of contract document.
