

Joint director and Superintendent Hamidia Hospital Bhopal invites tender from the interested firms duly authorized from Madhya Pradesh Pollution Control Board (MPPCB) for collection, Transportation, Treatment, Disposal of Biomedical waste generated at Hamidia Hospital and TB Hospital Bhopal.

The scope of services includes collection, transportation, treatment, disposal of Biomedical waste generated at Hamidia Hospital and TB Hospital Bhopal.

Supply of material for disposal of biomedical waste also will be included in the scope of work.


### GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

Hamidia Hospital, Bhopal intends to outsource services related to collection, transportation, treatment, disposal of biomedical waste and supply of general used in biomedical waste collection for Hamidia Hospital and TB Hospital Bhopal as per norms of MPPCB and thereby invites online tender from firms having valid authorization from Madhya Pradesh Pollution Control Board (MPPCB) to operate in Bhopal district.


This is the engaging eligible Bio medical Waste Management services provide agency for a period of 3 years from the date of Notification of award of work and until up to next tender is issued.

1 The contractor should have valid authorization from Madhya Pradesh Pollution control Board (MPPCB) authorities to carry out the handling, collection, storage, transportation, treatment, supply of material of bio-medical waste in Bhopal, throughout the period of contract.

2 The selected firm (contractor) shall be responsible for the handling, collection, transportation, disposal and supply of material of bio-medical waste disposal Hamidia Hospital and TB Hospital Bhopal. It shall be the legal duty of the firm to ensure that bio-medical waste is collected, transported and disposed in such a manner that they do not cause any adverse impact on human health or environment, as per the provision of bio-medical waste (Management and handling) rule 2016.



- 3 All the legal responsibility of bio medical waste shall be of the contractor immediately after it being picked up from the storage rooms (collection points) of Hamidia hospital and TB hospital, Bhopal
- 4 If any mishap happens during transportation all responsibility shall be that of contractor, if the bio medical waste is been seen selling outside the premises it will be sole responsibility of contractor.
- 5 Irrespective of shut down/break down of the plant/incinerator/CTF of the contractor, it will be responsibility of the contractor to collect bio-medical waste from Hamidia hospital and TB hospital Bhopal, Collection process should not hamper if the vehicle broke down. Facility should have alternative back up arrangement.
- 6 The contractor shall be responsible for any punitive legal action imposed by the legal authorities arising out of non-lifting/non-collection and non disposal of bio medical waste from Hamidia hospital and TB hospital, Bhopal
- 7 In case of breakdown of system it will be sole responsibility of contractor to transport the bio-medical waste from hospital. Fine of Rs 2000 per day will be imposed if the facility fails to transport the waste.
- 8 Collection of bio-medical waste will be undertaken twice a day. In case of default no payment shall be made for that particular day/days. There would be an additional penalty amounting to 5% of the monthly payment if bio-medical waste is not picked up from Hamidia hospital and TB hospital, Bhopal for the duration of within 24hrs. one person per shift should be available for the collection of bio-medical waste in hospital premises.
- 9 The firm shall transport the bio-medical waste in a dedicated covered vehicle as per rules and according to the instruction given by MPPCB to an authorized waste treatment facility center. Vehicle should have GPS tracking system including bar coding system.

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10 Collection of bio-medical waste from the wards must be done under supervision of the facility worker, it is mandatory to mention the various color code or category waste in the software which is available in each wards, failing to do so fine will be imposed.

11 It would be the inescapable duty of the firm to ensure that the instrument and practices for the treatment and disposal of the waste is duly compiled with the standards prescribed in bio-medical waste (management and handling) rule 2016. Also firm should have his own incinerator.

12 The firm (contractor) would be submit daily assessment annual report ward wise to MPPCB and all record which is asked from the MPPCB.

13 The contract shall not be transferable to any other contractor or any one if in case contractor breach the contract in this regards hospital administration have right to cancel the contract any point of time.


14 The hospital management have right to withhold the payment, terminate the contract or make the recovery from agency in respect of any losses or damage caused or occasioned due to violation of statutory obligation or unsatisfactory performance.

15 It has been mutually agreed between the parties that all differences and disputes, arising during the contract period regarding interpretation of the contract shall be solved by mutual discussion. In the event of difference to the Dean Gandhi Medical College, Bhopal.

16 This contact shall be deemed to have been concluded at Bhopal for all purpose and therefore only courts of Bhopal shall be having jurisdiction for the purpose of any adjudication where some dispute/obligation remain unsolved despite arbitration.

17 Payment will be on monthly bases within one month form the date of submission of invoice by M/S agency after completion of work done during calendar month duly certified by the certifying officer/authorized person of Hamidia hospital and TB hospital, Bhopal













18 EMD the agency willing to participate in tender may submit EMD of Rs. 2 lack online.

19 Performance guarantee the selected agency have to submit performance bank guarantee of 5 lac amount value in the form of FDR/Bank guarantee issued from any commercial bank valid for the period of 3 years at the time of agreement.

20 Supply of the waste collection material must be as per guideline of mp pollution control board is mandatory, if materials are not as per their guideline than no payment of that material will be paid by administration.

21 Waste collection Material to be supplied as per hospital need till the contract.

22 Delayed or insufficient supply leads to penalty of Rupees 1000 per day.


23 Billing of the supply of waste collection material to be done after having quality check from the competent authority of Hamidia hospital, Bhopal. If the material is not as per the norms than material will not be accepted.

24 Certificate from the side of MPPCB for supply of material is required.

**25 Tender should submit an affidavit on Rs 1000 stamp to state that-**

- No case is pending in NGT, MPPCB and CPCB.
- Bidder and bidder agency never black listed from any govt. or Semi govt. institute in past and present and also by the courts of India.
- MPPCB/COCB has never closed the unit for gross irregularities.
- Agency waste management unit fulfils all mandatory norms of CPCB
- Agency should have work experience in govt. sector compulsorily.

26 GST registration of bidder firm/agency should be submitted online compulsorily.
