COMPOSITE PERCENTAGE RATE NIT FOR e-TENDERING

The Executive Engineer, Postal Civil Division, **Bhopal (MP)** on behalf of the President of India invites online percentage rate composite bids from approved and eligible contractors from the appropriate list of **CPWD, MES, Archeological Survey of India, BSNL, Railways or Building & Road wing of respective State PWDs and firms/contractors of repute, meeting the eligibility conditions for the work in two bid system for the following work:**

“Preservation/Restoration of Lashkar Head Post Office Heritage Building in Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh.”

The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of bids. In case the last date of submission of bid is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of bids.

- 1.1 The work is estimated to costs **Rs. 10,81,32,486/- (Civil: 8,39,70,432/- + Electrical: Rs.2,41,62,054/-)**. This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.
- 1.2 Intending bidders is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below:-

Criteria of eligibility for submission of bid documents

1.2.1 Criteria for eligibility for all contractors.

The Contractors, who fulfill the following requirements, shall be eligible to apply. Joint Ventures are not accepted.

- (i) Should have satisfactorily completed the works within time or in the extended period without levy of compensation as mentioned below during the last Seven years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited:
Three **similar** completed works each costing not less than **Rs.4.33 Crore**. OR
Two **similar** completed works each costing not less than **Rs.6.49 Crore** OR
One **similar** completed work each costing not less than **Rs.8.651 Crore**.
Similar work shall mean works of **“Building work including internal water supply, sanitary installations work and Electrical work executed under one agreement in India carried out with some Central/state government departments, Central/State Autonomous bodies/City Development Authority/ Municipal Corporation of city formed under any Act by Central/State Government published in any Central/State Gazette.**
The value of all above executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum calculated from the date of completion to previous day of last date of submission of bids.
The bidder’s performance for qualifying works completed in the last Seven years should be certified by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent.
- (ii) To become eligible for bid, all the firms/ contractors shall have to furnish affidavit as under:-
“I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for bidding in Department of Posts (Civil Wing) in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer-in-Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee.”**(Scanned copy to be uploaded at the time of submission of bid).**
- (iii) The bidder shall submit a Notarised affidavit that he/she will execute the Electrical components of work and other specialized works as per sub NIT conditions given in the relevant part of this NIT by engaging eligible contractor if he/she does not have the desired eligibility.
- (iv) **Average annual financial turnover** - Bidder should have an average annual financial turnover (gross) equals to 30% of the Estimated costput to tenderon Civil/ Electrical construction work during the last three consecutive financial years ending **31st March, 2026 i.e. (2023-24, 2024-25 & 2025-26)** (Scanned copy of Certificate from CA with Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) to be uploaded).The value of annualturnover figures shall be brought to the current value by enhancing the actual turnover figures at simple rate of 7% per annum. In case the bidder who is not able to provide

audited balance sheet for last financial year ending 31st March, 2026, they can provide turnover based upon audited balance sheet for 3 consecutive financial years ending 31st March, 2025 i.e. (2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25). The Balance sheets should be duly audited by Chartered Accountant. Year in which no turnover is shown would also be considered for working out the average.

- (v) **Profit & Loss** - Bidder should not have incurred any loss (profit after tax should be positive) in more than two years during available last five consecutive balance sheets of financial years ending 31st March, 2026 i.e. 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24, 2024-2025, 2025-26 or last five consecutive balance sheets of financial years ending 31st March, 2025 i.e. 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24, 2024-25 as the case may be duly certified and audited by the Chartered Accountant. (The balance sheet in case of pvt./ Public Ltd. Company means its standalone finance statement and consolidated finance statement both.)
- (vi) **Solvency certificate from a commercial bank or Net worth certificate** - Bidder should produce a **Solvency certificate from a commercial bank amount equal to 40 % of the estimated cost put to tender (ECPT) as per Form 'B' or Net worth certificate from certified CA with Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) of minimum 10 % amount of Estimate Cost put to tender (ECPT) as per Form 'B-1'.**
- (vii) The bidder should be financially sound and should not have applied or be under Debt restructuring as on date.
- (viii) The bidding capacity of the bidder should be equal to or more than the estimated cost of the work put to tender. The bidding capacity shall be worked out by the following formula :
- Bidding Capacity = ((A x N x 1.5) - B) Where,**
- A = Maximum turnover in construction works executed in any one year during the last five years taking into account the completed as well as works in progress. The value of completed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing at a simple rate of 7% per annum.
- N = Number of Years prescribed for completion of work for which bid has been invited. When the value of N is less than 0.5 year then for calculation purpose minimum value of N shall be taken as 0.5.
- B = Value of existing commitments and ongoing works to be completed during the period of completion of work for which bids have been invited less amount of works which are stuck up due to local body clearance, environmental clearance, court decisions etc. shall not be considered for calculation of B. NIT approving authority may take a final decision on other justified reasons. The bidder should have sufficient number of Technical and Administrative employees for the proper execution of the contract. The bidder should submit a list of these employees stating clearly how these would be involved in this work.
- (ix) The bidder's performance for qualifying works completed in the last Seven years should be certified by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent.
2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed **Form No. CPWD 7** (or other Standard Form as mentioned) which is available as a Govt. of India Publication with up to date correction slip. Bidders shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.
3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **330 Days** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.
4. (i) The site for the work is available.
(ii) **The architectural and structural drawings shall be made available in phased manner, as per requirement of the same as per approved programme of completion to be submitted by the contractor after award of work.**
5. The bid documents consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of works to be done and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with the contractor whose bid may be accepted and other necessary documents can be seen in the office of the Executive Engineer (C), Postal Civil Division, Bhopal (MP) between hours of 11:00 AM and 4:00 PM from 27.04.2026 to 11.05.2026 every day except on Saturday & Sunday and public holidays or can be seen on website <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.
6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
7. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the percentage any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.
8. (a) **Earnest Money of Rs. 20,81,400/-** in the form of Treasury Challan or Demand Draft or Pay order or Banker's Cheque or Deposit at Call Receipt or Fixed Deposit Receipt (drawn in favour of **Accounts Officer O/o Executive Engineer (C), Postal Civil Division, Bhopal (MP)** payable at **Bhopal (MP)** shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-tendering website within the period of bid submission. **The original EMD should be deposited either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer (Civil/Electrical) Postal Civil/Electrical Division within the period of bid submission. The EMD receiving Executive Engineer (including NIT issuing EE) shall issue a receipt of deposition of earnest money deposit to the bidder in a prescribed format (enclosed) uploaded by tender inviting EE in the NIT. This**

receipt shall also be uploaded to the e-tendering website by the intending bidder up to the specified bid submission date and time.

EMD shall be made /issued only from the account of the bidder/tenderer submitting the bid/tender/ EMD made/issued from the account other than that of the bidder/tenderer submitting the bid, shall not be accepted.

But the bid can only be submitted after deposition of original EMD either in the office of Executive Engineer inviting bids or division office of any Executive Engineer(Civil/Electrical) Department of Posts within the period of bid submission and uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as demand draft or pay order or banker's cheque or deposit at call receipt or fixed deposit receipt and bank guarantee of any scheduled bank towards EMD in favour of Accounts Officer O/o Executive Engineer as mentioned in NIT, receipt for deposition of original EMD to division office of any Executive Engineer(Civil/Electrical)(including NIT issuing EE) Postal (Civil/Electrical) Division and other documents as specified. **OR Earnest Money can also be deposited through RTGS/NEFT in the account of Accounts Officer Postal Civil Division , Bhopal (MP) having account no. 30084180810 with State Bank of India, Main Branch TT Nagar, Bhopal (IFSC Code SBIN0001308).** The unique transaction reference (UTR) of RTGS/NEFT shall have to be uploaded by the bidder in the e-tendering system by the prescribed date. The Executive Engineer concerned will get tender cost/earnest money verified from the Bank based on the unique transaction reference number against each RTGS/NEFT payment before the tenders are opened.

Note:-The bidder will use one UTR for one work only. In case it is found that he has used one UTR number for different tenders, all the tenders submitted by him will be rejected and he debarred from further tendering in the department for one year.

A part of earnest money is acceptable in the form of bank guarantee also. In such case, minimum 50% of earnest money or Rs. 20 Lac, whichever is less, shall have to be deposited in shape prescribed above, and balance may be deposited in shape of Bank Guarantee of any scheduled bank having validity for **180 days or more** from the last date of submission of tender, which is to be scanned and uploaded by the intending bidders.

(b) Copy of Enlistment Order and certificate of work experience and other documents as specified in the tender form shall be scanned and uploaded to the e-tendering website with-in the period of bid submission. **However, originals of all the scanned and uploaded documents as specified in press notice shall have to be submitted by the lowest bidder within a week of opening of financial bid physically in the office of tender opening authority.**

(c) The bid submitted shall be opened at 03:30 PM on 13.05.2026

9. The bid submitted shall become invalid if:

(i) The bidder is found ineligible.

(ii) The bidder does not upload all the documents (including GST registration) as stipulated in the bid document-

(iii) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest bidder in the office of tender opening authority.

(iv) If a tenderer quotes NIL rate against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the the total amount of the tender or any section/subhead in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

10. The eligibility/technical bid Cover '1' on <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> shall be opened first on due date and time as specified herein above. The time and date of opening of financial bid envelope of contractors qualifying the eligibility bid shall be communicated to them at a later date.

11. Addendum / Corrigendum shall be uploaded by the Engineer-in-Charge, if felt necessary by him, which shall form part of tender document.

12. The contractor, whose bid is accepted, will be required to furnish performance guarantee of 5% (Five Percent) of the bid amount within the period specified in Schedule F. This guarantee shall be in the form of cash (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs. 10,000/-) or Deposit at Call receipt of any scheduled bank/Banker's cheque of any scheduled bank/Demand Draft of any scheduled bank/Pay order of any Scheduled Bank of any scheduled bank (in case guarantee amount is less than Rs. 1,00,000/-) or Government Securities or Fixed Deposit Receipts or Guarantee Bonds of any Scheduled Bank or the State Bank of India in accordance with the prescribed form. The earnest money deposited along with bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F' including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money Deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. **The contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable licenses/ registrations or proof of applying for obtaining labour licenses, registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW Welfare board including Provident Fund Code No. if applicable and also ensure the compliance of aforesaid provisions by the sub-contractor for the said work and Programme Chart (Time and progress) within the period specified in Schedule F.**

13. The description of the work is as follows:

Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidders shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by bidders implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

14. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidders shall be summarily rejected.
15. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
16. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidders shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.
17. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in the Postal Civil Circle responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted a Divisional Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any Gazetted officer in the Department of Posts- Civil Wing. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be debarred from tendering in the Department.
18. No Engineer of Gazetted rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the previous permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.
19. **The bid for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 75 (Seventy five) days from the date of opening of Eligibility bid, further**
 - (i) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms and condition of the tender which is not acceptable to the Department within 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.
 - (ii) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms and conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the Department after expiry of 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 100% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.
 - (iii) In case of forfeiture of earnest money as prescribed in para (i) and (ii) above, the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the rebidding process of the same work.
20. This notice inviting Bid shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidders/contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of:-
 - a) The Notice Inviting Bid, all the documents including additional conditions, specifications and drawings, if any, forming part of the bid as uploaded at the time of invitation of bid and the rates quoted online at the time of submission of bid and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence leading thereto.
 - b) Standard C.P.W.D. Form 7 or other Standard C.P.W.D. Form as mentioned.
21. **For Composite Bids**

- 21.1.1 The Executive Engineer in charge of the major component will call bids for the composite work. The Earnest Money will be fixed with respect to the combined estimated cost put to bid for the composite bid.
- 21.1.2 The bid document will include following four parts:
- Part A. CPWD-6, CPWD-7 including schedule A to F for the major component of the work, Standard General Conditions of Contract for **GCC Construction Works – 2023** as applicable with all amendments/ modifications upto last date of submission of bids.
- Part B. General/ specific conditions, specifications etc.
- Part C. Schedule A to F for minor component of the work. (SE/EE in charge of major component shall also be competent authority under clause 2 and clause 5 as mentioned in schedule A to F for major components) General/ specific conditions, specifications etc.
- Part D. Schedule of quantities applicable to major and minor component of the work.
- i. The eligible bidder shall quote percentage below/above/at par on the total amount (Civil+ Electrical) of tender.
 - ii. After acceptance of the bid by competent authority, the EE in charge of major component of the work shall issue letter of award on behalf of the President of India. After the work is awarded, the main contractor will have to enter into one agreement with EE in charge of major component and has also to sign two or more copies of agreement depending upon number of EE's in charge of minor components. One such signed set of agreement shall be handed over to EE in charge of minor component. EE of major component will operate part A, part B and part D of the agreement. EE in charge of minor component(s) shall operate Part C & Part D along with Part A of the agreement.
 - iii. Entire work under the scope of composite bid including major and all minor components shall be executed under one agreement.
 - iv. Security Deposit will be worked out separately for each component corresponding to the estimated cost of the respective component of works.
 - v. The main contractor, if not registered in composite category and the work not covered in the scope of composite contractor, has to associate agency(s) for minor component (s) and specialized works conforming to eligibility criteria as defined in the bid document and has to submit detail of such agency(s) to Engineer-in-charge of relevant component(s) within prescribed time. Name of the agency (s) to be associated shall be approved by Engineer-in-charge of relevant component(s).
 - vi. In case the main contractor intends to change any of the above agency/ agencies during the operation of the contract, he shall obtain prior approval of Engineer-in-charge of relevant component. The new agency / agencies shall also have to satisfy the laid down eligibility criteria. In case Engineer-in-charge is not satisfied with the performance of any agency, he can direct the contractor to change the agency executing such items of work and this shall be binding on the contractor.
 - vii. A) The bidder will either obtain valid electrical license at the time of execution of electrical work or associate contractors having valid electrical license of eligible class should have valid Electrical contractor's license as per IE rule/Central Electrical Authority (Measures relating to safety and electric supply) Regulations 2010. The associated agency should be of the appropriate class eligible to bid for each of the minor component individually.
B) The main contractor has to enter into agreement with contractor(s) associated by him for execution of minor component(s) and for specialized works. Copy of such agreement shall be submitted to EE of relevant component in charge of minor component as well as to EE in charge of major component. In case of change of associate contractor, the main contractor has to enter into agreement with the new contractor associated by him.
- 21.1.3 Running payment for the major component shall be made by EE of major discipline to the main contractor. Running payment for minor components shall be made by the Engineer-in-charge of the discipline of minor component directly to the main contractor.
- 21.1.4 ***The composite work shall be treated as complete when all the components of the work are complete. The completion certificate of the composite work shall be recorded by Engineer-in-Charge of major component after record of completion certificate of all other components.***
- 21.1.5 (A) Final bill of whole work shall be finalized and paid by the EE of major component. Engineer(s) in charge of minor component(s) will prepare and pass the final bill for their component of work and pass on the same to the EE of major component for including in the final bill for composite contract
(B) It will be obligatory on the part of bidder to sign the contract document for all components before the first payment is released.

22. In case of reduction in scope of work no claim on account of reduction in value of work, loss of expected profit, consequential overheads etc. shall be entertained.
23. For Bid document:
- 23.1.1 The Executive Engineer, PCD Bhopal, Engineer in charge of the work, will call bids for the work. The Earnest Money has been fixed with respect to the combined estimated cost put to tender of all components i.e. Civil and E&M.
- 23.1.2 The bid document will include following 04 components:
- Part A: - Eligibility conditions- CPWD-6, CPWD-7/8 including schedule A to F of the work, Standard General Conditions of Contract for GCC Construction Work 2023 for as amended/ modified up to last date of submission of bid.**
- Part B: - Civil component.**
- Part C: - Electrical component.**
- Part D: - Work Schedule**
- 23.1.3 The bidders must associate with himself, other agencies as per NIT conditions.
- 23.1.4 The eligible bidders shall quote rates for all items of work.
- 23.1.5 After acceptance of the bid by competent authority, the EE in charge of the work shall issue letter of award on behalf of the President of India. After the work is awarded, the main contractor will have to enter into the agreement with EE in charge of the work and has also to sign 2 copies of agreement.
- 23.1.6 Entire work under the scope of the bid shall be executed under one agreement.
- 23.1.7 Security Deposit will be worked out as per condition of NIT.
- 23.1.8 The main contractor has to associate contractor(s) for specialized component(s) conforming to eligibility criteria as defined in the bid document and has to submit detail of such contractor(s) to Engineer-in-charge of relevant component(s) within prescribed time. Name of the contractor(s) to be associated shall be approved by Engineer-in-charge of the work.
- 23.1.9 In case the main contractor intends to change any of the above contractor/agencies during the operation of the contract, he shall obtain prior approval of Engineer-in-charge of relevant specialized component(s). The new contractor/agencies shall also have to satisfy the laid down eligibility criteria. In case Engineer-in-charge is not satisfied with the performance of any contractor, he can also direct the contractor to change the contractor executing such items of work and this shall be binding on the contractor.
- 23.1.10 The main contractor has to enter into agreement/MOU with agencies contractor(s) associated by him for execution of component(s). Copy of such agreement/MOU (**Annexure-X**) shall be submitted to Engineer in charge of the work. In case of change of associate contractor, the main contractor has to enter into agreement with the new contractor associated by him.
- 23.1.11 Running payment for the work done by the contractor shall be made by Engineer in charge to the main contractor.
- 23.1.12 The work shall be treated as complete when all the components of the work are complete. The completion certificate of the work shall be recorded by Engineer- in- Charge of the work.
- 23.1.13 Final bill of the work shall be finalized and paid by the Engineer In Charge of the work.
24. The e-Tenders invited under TWO COVER system on <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> , the 1ST (first) ELECTRONIC COVER will be named as ELIGIBILITY BID/QUALIFYING DOCUMENTS & will contain documents of bidder's satisfying the eligibility conditions and 2nd (SECOND) ELECTRONIC COVER will be named as Financial Bid Cover containing TENDER DOCUMENT and WORK SCHEDULE and Performa for quoting the percentage. The bidder shall submit both the covers simultaneously. The TECHNICAL BID/QUALIFYING DOCUMENTS (1stcover) will be evaluated first and thereafter FINANCIAL BID (2ndcover) of eligible bidders shall only be opened. The time and date of opening of financial bid of contractors qualifying the eligibility/technical bid shall be communicated to them later. These envelopes shall contain one set of the following documents: -

(a) COVER 1 (ELIGIBILITY BID/QUALIFYING DOCUMENTS) shall contain the documents as below:

i.	Letter of transmittal
ii.	Scanned copy of Treasury Challan/ Demand Draft / Pay Order or Banker's Cheque / Fixed Deposit Receipts/ Deposit at Call Receipt / Bank Guarantee of any scheduled bank against EMD as prescribed/ Scanned copy of unique transaction reference (UTR) of RTGS/NEFT in case the earnest money has been deposited through RTGS/NEFT in the Account of tender inviting division.
iii.	Copy of receipt for deposition of original EMD to division office of any Executive Engineer(Civil/Electrical) [including NIT issuing EE] Postal Civil Division. OR an Undertaking that 'this document is not required' if earnest money has been deposited through RTGS/NEFT in Account of tender inviting division.
iv.	Financial information – Form 'A'
v.	Solvency Certificate or Networth Certificate as per provision of clause 1 (vi) - Form 'B'/'B-1'

vi.	Copy of Enlistment Order.
vii.	Details of eligible similar nature works class completed during the last Seven years ending last day of month previous to the one in which tenders are invited – Form ‘C’.
