(k) Bidding Capacity of Bidders:

Bidding capacity of bidders will be calculated during the technical evaluation of each bid as per the given below formula/procedure: -

Bidding Capacity = [A x N x 2] – B

Where,

A = Maximum value of consultancy works executed in any one year during the last **05 (Five) years** taking into account the completed as well as works in progress.

N = Number of years prescribed for completion of work for which this bid has been invited.

B = Value of existing commitments and ongoing works to be completed during the period of completion of work for which this bid has been invited.

Note: -

1. **(The bidding capacity of the contractor obtained from above formulae should be equal to or more than the estimated cost of the work put to tender.**
2. **In case the tenderer is lowest, the tendered amount will be considered as his work load for the purpose of calculating the bidding capacity in subsequent tenders issued by CCEs. The subsequent tenders will be considered if he meets the bidding capacity criteria.**
3. **The Bidder shall submit the Bidding Capacity as per the formula above along with supporting documents i.e., copies of LOI / Work Order for all work specified in formula for bidding capacity.**

- (i) Please note that Cover No. 2 (Financial bid) will be opened only in respect of qualified and eligible firms who fulfils the PQ documents submitted in Cover No. 1 (Technical Bid) as per Para – 9 of this NIT and any other documents mentioned at this NIT & enquiry documents. Financial bid (Cover No. 2) without uploading of EMD in Cover No. 1, **will not be opened**.
- (ii) The earnest money of unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them without any interest after opening of Financial Bid (Cover No. 2).
- (iii) Uploading of bid doesn't constitute any guarantee for opening of financial bid of Tenderer. Opening of quoted financial bid will be decided based on PQ criteria given in NIT. The Bidders, if desires, may appeal to next higher Engineer Authority viz DCW&E, New Delhi with copy to the Accepting officers within 07(seven) days from the date of opening of Cover No. 1. The decision of the next higher Engineer Authority shall be final and binding. Bidder shall not be entitled for any compensation whatsoever for rejection of his financial bid. In order to participate in E-Tendering Bidders have to registered with www.eprocure.gov.in. the facilities provided for the bidders in the site may be utilized for quoting and uploading etc.
- (iv) The Accepting officers shall receive bids (Cover No. 1 & Cover No. 2) upto due date & time of the bid submission / extended date of bid submission, as applicable.
- (v) **Scanned copy of Eligibility Documents, EMD/MSME, EPF & ESI Registration, GST registration and Enquiry Documents are to be uploaded by the bidders in Cover No. 1.**
- (vi) All revision, clarifications, corrigenda, addendum etc. to the tenders (if required) shall also be uploaded in CPP Portal. Hence the bidders are advised to regularly visit the said and keep themselves updated.
- (vii) For submission of E-Tender, Bidders are requested to get themselves registered with eprocure.gov.in website along with Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) issued by authorized issuing authority under IT Act 2003. DSC used by the tenderer shall be on behalf of the applicant firm.
- (viii) In case any documents (from the list of documents mentioned at NIT and or Enquiry Documents) are found deficient after opening of Cover – 1 (Technical Bid), the tender shall be liable for rejection and Cover – 2 (Financial Bid) will be not be opened.

- (x) Any change / modification in the Tender Enquiry will be intimated through above mentioned website only.
