1. Online bids on item rate basis are invited by the Executive Engineer, Jal Shakti Division, Reckong Peo, Distt. Kinnaur Himachal Pradesh on the behalf of Governor of Himachal Pradesh, in electronic tendering system in two covers for the under mentioned work from contractors/firms of appropriate class enlisted with HP Jal Shakti Vibhag. or any other Govt. /Semi-Govt. Departments/Autonomous bodies as per his/ her class of enlistment.

**NAME OF WORK:-** Remodeling of FIS Boktu in Tehsil Kalpa Distt. Kinnaur (H.P.)(SH:-C/O Trench Wier with Intake Chamber at Node-1, C/O 2 Nos of Disilting Chambers with Hopper Bottom at Node-2A and 2B, Providing Laying Jointing and Testing of Gravity Main of GMERWPipe 450mm Dia at RD 00/00 to RD 5825, C/O Anchor Blocks at Various RD's, C/O Cut Covers at Various RD's, C/O Collection Chamber at Junction of Pipe and open channel at Node-3, C/OP.C.C. #### **AVAILABILITY OF FORMS:-**

2. Tenders are to be submitted only on PWA forms/BOQ as prescribed against 1 (xi) above and can be downloaded from <https:hptenders.gov.in>. As the bids are to be submitted online and the same are required encrypted and digitally signed, the bidders are advised to obtain Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) from suitable vendors or from any authorized agency at the earliest.
3. The documents consisting of the detailed specification, schedule of quantities of various items of work, and the set of conditions to be complied with can be downloaded or viewed online from the portal <https://hptenders.gov.in> on the date(s) & time given against 1 (ix) above by the firms/individual registered on the website which is free of cost.

#### **FILLING, SUBMISSION & OPENING OF TENDER DOCUMENTS:-**

4. Tenders will be uploaded on the portal <http://hptenders.gov.in> the concerned Executive Engineer, of Jal Shakti Division Reckong Peo upto the date shown/ given at 1 (ix) and opened on the date & time shown 1 (ix) above).
5. Canvassing/compartmentalization are strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resorts to same shall be liable for rejection.
6. The contractor must quote the rates in figures as well as in words. The amount for each item should be worked out and the requisite totals be given.
7. When a contractor signs a tender in any Indian language, the total amount tendered in the case of PWA form No. 6 and 8 shall also be written in the same language. In case of illiterate contractors, the rate or the amount tendered should be attested by a witness. Such tender shall not be witnessed by the contractors who himself/themselves has/have tendered for the same work. Failure to observe this

condition would render tenders of the contractors tendering as well as witnessing the tender, liable for rejection.

8. Special care should be taken to write the rates in figures as well as in words and the amount in figures only, in such a way that interpolation is not possible. The total amount should also be written both in figures and in words. In case of figures, the word 'Rs' should be written before the figure and words 'P' after the decimal. i.e Rs 2.15 P and in case word, the word Rupee should precede and the words "paise" should be written at the end. Unless the rate is in whole rupees and followed by the word "only", it should invariably be up to two decimal places. While quoting the rate in schedule of quantities, the word only should be written closely following the amount and not in the next line.
9. Any item rate tender containing percentage below/above shall be summarily rejected, however when a tenderer voluntarily offers a rebate for award of work within validity period, this may be considered by the authority competent to accept the tender.
10. Tender containing doubtful figures shall be rejected.
11. The contractor should read the specifications carefully before submitting the tender.
12. If it is found that the tender is not submitted in proper manner or contains too many corrections or absurd rates or amounts it would be open for Govt. to take suitable action against tenderer.
13. The acceptance of a tender after opening will rest with the Executive Engineer, who does not bind himself to accept the lowest tender and reserves to himself the right to reject any or all of the tenders received without assigning any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or are incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected.
14. The contractor should also see all drawing and specifications and in case of doubt, should obtain required clarifications from Executive Engineer, which may in any way influence his tender as no claim whatsoever shall be entertained for any alleged ignorance therefore, once tender has been opened.
15. If on check there are differences between the rate quoted by the contractor in words and in figures or in the amount worked out by him, the following procedure shall be followed.

- a. Where there is a difference between the rates in figures and in words, the rates, which correspond to the amount of an item worked out by the contractor, shall be taken as correct.
  - b. When the amount of an item is not worked out by the contractor or it does not correspond with the rates written either in figures or in words, then the rate quoted by the contractor in words shall be taken as correct.
  - c. When the rate quoted by the contractor in figures and in words tally but the amount is not worked out correctly the rate quoted by the contractor shall be taken as correct and not the amount.
16. It is in the interest of the contractor that he visits the site of work and acquaints himself with conditions prevalent there before submitting his tender, as no claim whatsoever shall be entertained once tender has been submitted.
17. Ambiguous/telegraphic/conditional tenders or tender by Fax/E-mail shall not be entertained/considered in any case.
18. In case, opening day is a holiday, the tenders shall be opened on next working day at the same time

**EARNEST MONEY:-**

19. The earnest money shall be through online mode (**e- payment**).
20. The tenders of those contractors who do not deposit the Earnest Money in the prescribed manner will not be opened and will be summarily rejected.
21. In cases where a tenderer was lowest or other than the lowest & whose offer has been accepted, either withdraws the offer or fails to commence the work on written order of the Executive Engineer, the earnest money so deposited by the tenderer shall stand forfeited.
22. Earnest Money of L1, contractor/firm shall be retained for a period of 120 days or signing of contract agreement by L1, whichever is earlier.

**SECURITY DEPOSIT:-**

- 23 The contractor whose tender is accepted, will be required to furnish by way of security deposit for the due fulfillment of his contract, such sum as under:-
- (i) For work costing up to 2, 00,000/- @ 10% of the tendered amount of the work.
  - (ii) For works costing above Rs. 2,00,000 and up to Rs. 5,00,000 @ (i) +7.5% of remaining amount.

- (iii) For work costing above 5 lacs and upto 50 Lacs @ (ii) + 5 % of remaining amount.
- (iv) For work costing above 50 lacs @ (iii) +2.5% of remaining amount (without any limit).

#### **GENERAL CONDITIONS:-**

##### **24. Instructions for e-tendering:-**

- > The contractor should register himself on website <https://hptenders.gov.in> and obtain user ID, Pass Word, before bidding.
- > Entire tender process will be carried out on line through above mentioned website.
- > Contractor/ firms are advised to procure e-token/Digital Signature Certificate from suitable vendors or from any authorized agency.
- > The tenderer should quote their firm price subject to no escalation what so ever till successful fulfillment of contract. The financial bid should be inclusive of all Taxes and no extra claim will be entrained. Central/State/Local taxes Vat and any levy charges should be included in the financial bid by the contractor/ firm, nothing extra will be claimed.
- > Certificate of registration with Jal Shakti Vibhag Hp or any other Govt. /Semi-Govt. Departments/Autonomous bodies as per his/ her appropriate class. In case successful bidder is not registered with Jal Shakti Vibhag than successful bidder shall get himself registered in appropriate class with JSV before award of work.
- > The Financial bid of the firms shall not be considered for opening if the required documents as per Cover-1 are not uploaded or not to the satisfaction of tender opening committee. The tender/Financial Bid shall be opened only of those contractors who qualify the eligibility criteria as per Cover-1 "eligibility information". The documentary proof in lieu of eligibility should be uploaded on line.

##### **25. TERMS AND CONDITION**

##### **1. The e-tender documents shall be uploaded online in 2 (two ) covers:-**

**Cover-1** shall contain scanned copies of "eligibility information"

**Cover-2** shall contain "Financial Bid" **on the prescribed form.**

##### **2. Cover-1 shall contain scanned copies of following "Eligibility Information" (Scanned copies to be uploaded in pdf. File).**

- a. The earnest money shall be through online mode (**e- payment**) in favour of Executive Engineer, Jal Shakti Division Reckong Peo and certificate of exemption of earnest money shall not be allowed.
- b. The cost of tender form shall be through online mode (e- payment) only.
- c. Certificate of registration with Jal Shakti Vibhag Hp or any other Govt. /Semi-Govt. Departments/Autonomous bodies as per his/her in appropriate class. In case successful bidder is not registered with Jal Shakti Vibhag than successful bidder shall get himself registered in appropriate class with JSV before award of work.
- d. certificate of average annual financial turn over for last three years.

- e. Average Annual financial turn over during the last three years ending 31 march of the previous financial year should be at least 30% of the estimated cost. The previous years shall be given weightage of 7% per year to bring them to current price level, which should be accessed on the bases of copy of audit report/ balance sheet certified by chartered accountant.
- f. Experience of having successfully completed similar works during the last 7 years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited should be either of the following

Three similar completed works each costing not less than amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost.

Or

Two similar completed works each costing not less than amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost.

Or

One similar completed works costing not less than amount equal to 80% of estimated cost.

Completed work means either completed to the extent of minimum 90% of the awarded amount (including unpaid amount on account paucity of funds ) and for the purpose cost of the work shall mean gross value of completed work including the cost of material supplied by the Govt/Deptt, but excluding those supplied free of cost by the Govt./ Deptt.

**Definition of similar work shall be as under:**

Definition of Similar Work shall be as under:-

1. The bidder must have experience of construction of Water Supply Scheme with gravity main /rising main pipe line and Water retaining structure or Flow Irrigation scheme with gravity main/rising main pipe line of Galvanized Steel pipe or MSERW pipe, Trench Weir/ Head weir.

A certificate to this effect from the Engineer-in Charge not below the rank of Executive Engineer of a state/semi Govt. Deptt/central Govt. Dept. or state/central govt. undertaking of india is mandatorily required. The bidder shall upload the award letter of related agreement to collahborate the experience certificate submitted,

The value of executed work shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of interest 7% per annum, Calculated from the date of completion to previous day of the last date of submission of tender.

For computing the cost of the completed work in the base year, the following multiplying factor will be used for the completed works so as to bring the financial figures to common base:-

**Beside above the bidder should possess and upload bidding capacity calculated by the specific formula as under:-**

Available Bid capacity=(A×N×M)-B

Where “A”= Maximum value to Engineering (Civil/Electrical/Mechanical as relevant to the work executed in any one year during the last 5 years( updated at the current price level) taking into the account the completed as well as works in progress.

“M”= Multiplier factor is 1.5

“N”=numbers of years prescribed for completion of work in question.

“B”= Value (updated at current price level) of the existing commitments and ongoing works to be completed in next “N” years.

Note:- Bidder should submit bidding capacity as per form C-3 with supporting documents duly issued by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer.

- (h) Copy of PAN,EPF and GST Registration in case contractor has no EPF registration he shall get himself registered and copy of EPF registration be submitted before award of work.
- (i) Scanned copies of latest Income Tax return filled by the contractor.
- (j) The authorization letter regarding digital signature certificate (DSC) of the person authorized by the registered tenderer to upload the bid, be uploaded along with the other documents online.
- (k) The contractor/Firm shall submit/upload the scanned copies of the documents as required in NIT through online mode only. No physical submission of documents will be allowed.
- (l) The scanned copy of undertaking that I have carefully studied all the terms and condition stipulated in form PWA 6 & 8 as well as special terms & condition appended along with schedule of quantity before quoting the rates in the BOQ chart and that I have visited the site of work before quoting the rates.
- (m) The contractor shall approve drawings and design ( structural design, Hydraulic design) form competent authority before starting the work and submit the 3 sets of the same to engineer in charge.
- (n) Affidavit that contractor/Bidder is not black listed contractor of any Govt / semi Govt Deptt.

**3. Cover-2 Shall contain” Financial Bid” which will be opened at a later date to be notified separately and opened only of those contractors/Firms whose documents will be found in order as per Eligibility information & mentioned in “Cover-I”. Cover -2 shall contain only Financial Bid/offers on Departmental schedule of quantity/BOQ where contractor/Firm will quote his/their offer for each item.**

- 4. Earnest money of L1, shall be retained for a period of 120 days or signing of contract agreement by L1, whichever is earlier.
- 5. No subletting of work should be permissible.However bidder shall be free to engage agency of specialist firm (for execution of specified component of project)
- 6. In case, opening day is a holiday, the tenders shall be opened on next working day at the same time.
- 7. The contractor shall get the drawings and design ( structural design, Hydraulic design) form competent authority before starting the work and submit the 3 sets of approved design and drawing to engineer in charge before execution.
- 8. The offer of the tender shall be kept open for **120 days**, however every efforts shall be made to award the work within 27 days time period prescribed by Govt.
- 9. Conditional bids/tenders are liable to be rejected without assigning any reason. The Executive Engineer reserves the right to reject/cancel any or all the tenders\ bids without assigning any reason.
