

SHORT - NOTICE INVITING TENDER

1. Percentages rate tenders are invited by Jt. General Manager (C&T), MIHAN India Limited, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar International Airport, Nagpur on behalf of Sr. Airport Director, MIL, Nagpur for the work of Pre- Monsoon Civil Works at City Side Area (Non -Operational Area) at Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar International Airport, Nagpur Year 2026-2027.

Total Estimated cost = Rs. 9,48,647/- (Excl. of GST)

Time Period:- 15 Days (Fifteen Days)

2. **Eligibility Criteria:** Tender Forms will be issued to contractors who qualify in the following criteria:
 - a. Contractor shall be enlisted contractor of CPWD /P&T /State PWD/Rly/MES /PSUs/specialized firms in such works. Copies of valid License of Contractor Registration shall be submitted, as applicable.
 - b. Contractor shall have satisfactorily completed (Phase / Part completion of the scope of the work in a contract shall not be considered.) at least three works each of **Rs. 3.79 Lakh** or two works each of **Rs. 4.74 Lakh** or one work of **Rs. 7.58 Lakh** of such civil Maintenance work during the last seven years ending on 31st March 2026. As a proof of above, Contractor shall submit Work completion certificate/experience certificate mentioning the date of completion of work. Contractors producing certificate from Non-Govt./Non PSU organizations should also submit "Tax deduction at source certificate" in support of their claim of having experience of stipulated value of works.
 - c. Contractors shall have annualized average financial turnover of at least **Rs. 2.84 Lakh** against works executed by it during last three financial years ending on 31/03/26. CA Certificate shall be submitted as a proof.
 - d. Contractor shall submit copy of its PAN & GST Registration.
 - e. Consortiums/Joint venture companies shall not be permitted.
 - f. Any party either firm or an individual which is De-barred/black listed in past by CBI /MADC/MIL/AAI or Undertakings/Departments like Railway, Defense, or any other Department of Govt. of India / State Govt is not eligible for participation, undertaking regarding this shall be submitted as per Annexure "A".

- g. Original Power of Attorney authorizing Authorized Representative & Signatory to act on behalf of the Bidding Company as per the specified format at Annexure "B" representative.

Tender fee of Rs. 1180/- (Including 18% GST) (Non-refundable) and EMD (Rs. 18973/-) shall be submitted online during submission of e-tender using Internet Banking (Payment Gateway) process available on portal <https://mahatenders.gov.in>

3. Checklist as per the format at Annexure "C" shall be submitted with relevant and clear information, failing to which tender will be liable for rejection.
4. If at any stage, MIL finds that the party had submitted any false/wrong/concealment of information/document affecting eligibility criteria; in such case, EMD shall be forfeited and party is liable to be debarred for three years for participation in MIL tenders, apart from any other appropriate/legal action. Also the awarded work will be terminated with immediate effect and MIL will not be liable to make any payments due for the work done by it.
5. MIL reserves the right to verify, refer any document to the concerned authority for confirmation from case to case basis. Mere submission will not bind MIL to accept the documents.
6. A Sole proprietor having concerns under different names will be considered as a single legal entity. PAN card will determine the single entity criteria hence will be the basis for decision.
7. In case of partnership firms, as it does not have any legal entity on its own, hence if two or more firms are having common partners then all these

firms will be considered as single entity. The principle of implied agency of partner as per the Partnership Act of India has been taken as the guiding principle. Since the provisions are different in Tax laws hence different PAN card will not entitle the firms having common partners to be treated as separate entity for the purpose of contracts in MIL.

8. In case of Companies, if the holding company and its subsidiary are participating in the same tender then a disclosure to this effect to be made at the time of application for tender form. Also it will be mandatory for them to submit the basis and proof of the relationship during the technical tender stage.
9. In case a Foreign Company and its wholly-owned Indian subsidiary (WOS) Company are participating in the same tender then disclosure to be submitted in an envelope. Also it will be mandatory for them to submit the basis and proof of the relationship during the technical tender stage.
10. If directed by MIL, Original documents shall be produced for verification.
11. The rectifiable discrepancies / clarification in the applications, if any would have to be corrected / submitted by the Tenderer within a period of 03 days of the intimation failing which its proposal will be rejected. In order to enable MIL to meet the target dates, the Tenderers are expected to respond expeditiously to clarifications, if any, requested during the evaluation process.
12. Only one tender document shall be submitted by a single party either a firm or an individual. The proprietor of more than one company or firm will be considered as single party and one legal entity. The parties fulfilling the criteria mentioned in the tender are eligible to participate in the tender.
13. Purchase preference to Central Public Sector undertaking shall be applicable as per the directives of Govt. of India prevalent on the date of acceptance.
14. The agency will need to get PF & ESI registration, if applicable. Necessary registrations in support thereof shall be submitted within 15 days of issue of work order.
15. Any tax on work or on materials and labour in respect of this contract shall be payable by the contractor and MIL will not entertain any claim whatsoever in this respect. GST will be reimbursed at applicable rates. Work contract tax and Income Tax will be deductible from the bills at the rates prevailing during payment.
16. The tender shall be valid for 03 months from the date of publishing the Tender.

17. MIL reserves the right to reject tender document of working agencies whose performance at ongoing work(s) / project(s) is below par or unusually poor.
18. MIL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications or annul tender process without any liability. MIL reserves to itself the right to extend the date of receiving/opening of the bids as well as to extend the validity of the tender.
