1. Eligibility Criteria

- a) Contractor shall have valid certificate of registration of appropriate class of work from CPWD/ PWD/ P&T/ PSU's/ MES / Railway/ Jeevan Pradhikaran / MAHAGENCO/ MAHATRANSCO/ MAHADISCOM etc., or from any Government / Semi Government / Central Government / Registration under Bombay Shop act. Copies of valid License of Contractor Registration shall be submitted, as applicable.
- b) Contractor shall have satisfactorily completed (Phase / Part completion of the scope of the work in a contract shall not be considered.) at least three works each of 40% of Estimate Value or two works each of 50% of Estimate Value or one work of 80% of Estimate Value of similar works during the last five years ending on 31st March' 2026. As a proof of above, Contractor shall submit Work completion certificate/experience certificate mentioning the date of completion of work. Contractors producing certificate from Non-Govt. /Non-PSU organizations should also submit "Tax deduction at source certificate" in support of their claim of having experience of stipulated value of works.
- c) Contractors shall have annualized average financial turnover of atleast 30% of Estimate Value against works executed by it during last three financial years ending on 31/03/25. CA Certificate shall be submitted as a proof.
- d) Contractor shall submit copy of its PAN GST, EPFO & ESIC Registration certificate.
- e) Consortiums/Joint venture companies shall not be permitted.
- f) Any party either firm or an individual which is De-barred/black listed in past by CBI /MADC/MIL/AAI or Undertakings/Departments like Railway, Defense, or any other Department of Govt. of India / State Govt. is not eligible for participation, undertaking regarding this shall be submitted as per "Annexure A"
- g) Original Power of Attorney authorizing Authorized Representative & Signatory to act on behalf of the Bidding Company as per the specified format at "Annexure B" representative. PAN card of Nominee and Nominating Officer of Power of Attorney.

2. Checklist as per the format at Annexure "C" shall be submitted with relevant and clear

- information, failing to which tender will be liable for rejection.
3. If at any stage, MADC finds that the party had submitted any false/wrong/concealment of information/document affecting eligibility criteria; in such case, EMD shall be forfeited and party is liable to be debarred for three years for participation in MADC tenders, apart from any other appropriate / legal action. Also, the awarded work will be terminated with immediate effect and MADC will not be liable to make any payments due for the work done by it.
 4. MADC reserves the right to verify, refer any document to the concerned authority for confirmation from case-to-case basis. Mere submission will not bind MADC to accept the documents.
 5. A Sole proprietor having concerns under different names will be considered as a single legal entity. PAN card will determine the single entity criteria hence will be the basis for decision.
 6. In case of partnership firms, as it does not have any legal entity on its own, hence if two or more firms are having common partners then all these firms will be considered as single entity. The principle of implied agency of partner as per the Partnership Act of India has been taken as the guiding principle. Since the provisions are different in Tax laws hence different PAN card will not entitle the firms having common partners to be treated as separate entity for the purpose of contracts in MADC.
 7. In case of Companies, if the holding company and its subsidiary are participating in the same tender then a disclosure to this effect to be made at the time of application for tender form. Also, it will be mandatory for them to submit the basis and proof of the relationship during the technical tender stage.
 8. If directed by MADC, Original documents shall be produced for verification.
 9. The rectifiable discrepancies / clarification in the applications, if any would have to be corrected / submitted by the Tenderer within a period of 03 days of the intimation failing which its proposal will be rejected. In order to enable MADC to meet the target dates, the Tenderers are expected to respond expeditiously to clarifications, if any, requested during the evaluation process.
 10. Only one tender document shall be submitted by a single party either a firm or an individual. The proprietor of more than one company or firm will be considered as single party and one legal entity. The parties fulfilling the criteria mentioned in the tender are eligible to participate in the tender.
 11. MADC reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications or annul tender process without any liability. MADC reserves to itself the right of extend the date of receiving/opening of the bids as well as to extend the validity of the tender.
 12. MADC will have no obligation to explain its interpretation of this tender document, or their supporting documentation and information or to explain the evaluation process, ranking process, or the selection of the successful bidder. Or to interpret any bid is responsive or not.
