1. Introduction:-

2. Scope of work:-

The High Court of Madhya Pradesh is interested in implementing emerging technologies like blockchain to enhance government service delivery and build trust in digital credentials.

Through this EOI, seeks to engage qualified technology partner to develop and implement blockchain-based certification and solutions for the High Court of Madhya Pradesh. The partner will collaborate with the High Court of Madhya Pradesh to create a secure, tamper-proof and verifiable digital credentialing system using blockchain technology.

3. Objectives:-

The main objectives of this EOI is as follows:

- Launch a blockchain-based credentialing service to verify and authenticate digital credentials like digital records that may qualify for such service.
- To establish a secure and tamper-proof blockchain based solutions for creating digital credentials, ensuring data integrity and privacy.
- Provide a user-friendly interface for individuals and organizations to manage and showcase their digital verifiable credentials, including the ability to issue, view, and share credentials.
- Enable seamless integration with existing technology platforms and systems, such as ERP system, OTT Platform, DMS etc.
- Ensure compliance with relevant regulations and data privacy requirements in India, including the Personal Data Protection Bill and other applicable laws.

- To deploy public blockchain project, based on the requirement of High Court of Madhya Pradesh.

4. Work Assignment:-

- Any inquiry received directly / indirectly to High Court of Madhya Pradesh shall be governed by the High Court as front face to end user / client.
- If required, the High Court of Madhya Pradesh on its own discretion shall ask bidder /agency to attend initial meetings along with the High Court official in order to understand the scope of work & freeze the requirement.
- Explore other blockchain verticals including permissioned and permission less blockchain applications.

5. Production Environment Setup:-

Successful bidder /agency will setup the production environment of the project awarded based on project requirements. The blockchain system setup can be a private blockchain or public blockchain based system based on the use case and client requirements. After launching of the production environment, the successful bidder /agency will take up the minimal indicative activities as mentioned below:

- i. Tasks related to bug fixing (if any) in customization made in the system.
- ii. Maintaining back-ups of the implemented system.
- iii. Developments, Improvements in the output and input formats.
- iv. Hand holding the users.

Some of the other activities in this period will include but not limited to:

- i. Formulation of Post “Complete deployment” Support Strategy.
- ii. Formulating the mechanisms for Post “Complete deployment” Monitoring.
- iii. Carrying out the Review of issues and activities carried out during user adoption and system stabilization period.
- iv. Monitoring and fine-tuning system response.

6. Continuous Development:-

- Successful bidder /agency will be responsible for successfully executing the various software level change / updation required during the contract tenure /agreement.

7. Broad Scope of Work:-

Successful bidder /agency will be responsible for the following:

- Providing its proven technology platform and solutions and setting up scalable and secure blockchain-based credentialing platform.
- Setting up of custom private and public blockchain systems based on requirements of the High Court of Madhya Pradesh.
- Collaborating with the High Court of Madhya Pradesh to establish partnerships with Government agencies and other institutions in order to promote the adoption of the platform and facilitating the verification of credentials.
- Maintaining the blockchain platform, providing technical support and maintenance services, including bug fixes, updates, and enhancements.
- Delivering training sessions for users and administrators to ensure effective utilization of the platform.
- Ensuring compliance with applicable laws, regulations, and data protection requirements, including providing necessary features for user consent, data deletion, and data portability.
- The proposed system should have sufficient security and safety measures, such as encryption, access controls, and auditing, to ensure data integrity and privacy in compliance with applicable regulations.
- Should be able to integrate with existing systems and databases, ensuring interoperability and seamless data exchange between various pillars.
- Should deliver a user-friendly interface for individuals and organizations to interact with the platform, including features for issuing, viewing, and

sharing blockchain records/credentials.

8. Proposed Services:-

- Design, Development & Maintenance of public blockchain based credentialing/non credentialing applications.
- Design, Development & Maintenance of private blockchain based applications including blockchain infrastructure setup and managed service.
- Consultancy work on blockchain project.

9. Implementation Plan:-

- Through this EoI the High Court of Madhya Pradesh will engage blockchain technology bidder /agency.
- The bidder /agency who will qualify for the conditions of EoI, we will issue the LoI (Letter of Intent) and asking them to submit the financial proposal.
- The High Court of Madhya Pradesh and the engaged firm will decide the Business model.

10. Eligibility Criteria:-

The prospective applicant should fulfill the following eligibility criteria: -

- a. The bidder /agency should be registered and incorporated under the Indian Companies Act, 1956/2013. Additionally, the company must be in existence for a minimum of 05 years.
- b. The bidder /agency should submit an undertaking that they are not blacklisted by any Central or State Government or Public sector undertaking in India.
- c. The Bidder /agency shall submit copies of PAN Card, GST Registration & Latest GST Return.
- d. The bidder /agency shall have a minimum average financial turnover of **Rs. 05 Crore** during last 03 financial years **i.e. 2022-23, 2023-24 & 2024-25**.
- e. The bidder /agency should be revenue positive in the last financial year

(FY 2024-2025).

- f. The bidder /agency must possess the following valid Certifications at the time of EoI submission:

Project related work orders shall not be accepted as a proof for blockchain.
- h. The bidder /agency should have successfully executed:

Both the above projects should be with any Indian State or Central Government Depts/agencies/PSUs or government Urban Local Bodies. Corresponding work orders and completion certificate to be furnished along with the EoI.
