[2] Terms and Conditions for Participation in Tender:

(i) It is mandatory for prospective bidders to get registration on website www.mptenders.gov.in for e-tendering module of MPPGCL. Therefore, it is advised to all prospective bidders to get registration by making on line registration fees payment at the earliest.

(ii) The tender documents can be purchased online only and downloaded from web site www.mptenders.gov.in by online payment of cost of tender document.

(iii) Service and gateway charges shall be borne by the bidders.

(iv) Since the bidders are required to sign their bids online using class-III Digital Certificates, they are requested to obtain the same at the earliest. Please note that it may take up to 7 working days for issue of Digital Certificate. MPPGCL will not be responsible for delay in issue of Digital Certificate.

(v) If bidder is participating first time for e-tendering in MPPGCL, then it is obligatory on the part of bidder to fulfill all formalities such as registration, obtaining Digital Certificate etc. well in advance.

(vi) MPPGCL shall not be responsible in any way for delay/difficulties/ inaccessibility of the downloading facility from the website for any reason whatsoever.

(vii) Bidders are requested to visit MPPGCL, e-tendering web site (www.mptenders.gov.in) For any clarification and /or due date extension or corrigendum. Any clarification and /or due date extension or corrigendum shall be issued on website www.mptenders.gov.in only.

[3] Exemption for MSEs, START UP and SSI of MP from payment of Tender Fees:- The bidders "Situating/Based" in the state of Madhya Pradesh as Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs)/ START UP/S.S.I. units with D.I.C. (District Industries Center)/Khadi & Village Industries Commission (KVIC) / Khadi & Village Industries Board (KVIB/ Coir Board/Directorate of Handicrafts and Handloom/ Udyog Aadhar Memorandum (UAM) or any other body specified by Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MOMSME) for the tendered works/services are exempted from paying the tender fees, however such firms shall have to upload the requisite documents on e-procurement website.

NOTE: - (i) the bidders situated/based in the state of Madhya Pradesh and registered as medium enterprises are not allowed for exemption of tender fee. Hence should not opt tender fee exemption on the basis of above criteria.

(ii) The bidders of other state (not situated/based in state of Madhya Pradesh) and registered as micro & small enterprises not allowed for exemption in tender fee. Hence such bidder should not opt tender fee exemption on the basis of above criteria.

(iii) The firm registered with NSIC are not exempted from submission of tender fee.

[4] Earnest money deposition: - (i) the earnest money as indicated above against each tender is to be submitted by bidder through net-banking /RTGS/NEFT.

(ii) The bidders can submit EMD in the form of bank Guarantee also. In case if bidder is submitting bank Guarantee towards EMD, then the same shall be issued from scheduled bank and in the prescribed format for BG(available in tender document) with validity of 9 (Nine) months from the date of opening of tender. However the bidder is required to upload the scanned copy of BG on e-Portal & submit original BG in physical form but only after opening of Bid(s) within seven days thereafter. The Bid of such bidders shall be considered for evaluation only after receipt of original BG in Physical form and its verification .

(iii) If the EMD is submitted in the form of BG, it is the responsibility of bidder to submit the same strictly in the prescribed format only, failing which the offer may be rejected.

(iv) In no case, physical contact should happen between bidder & MPPGCL Officials before opening of T&C bid. No correspondence with regard to EMD shall be done through short fall window.

(v) No offer will be accepted without valid EMD deposit unless exempted (after submission of supporting documents for exemption).

The following bidders are exempted from submission of EMD subject to uploading of relevant document on e- procurement website:-

(a) The bidders situated/based in the state of Madhya Pradesh as Micro & Small Enterprises / START UP / S.S.I. units with D.I.C. (District Industries Center) of Madhya Pradesh , Khadi & Village Industries Commission (KVIC) / Khadi & Village Industries Board (KVIB) / Coir Board / Directorate of Handicrafts and Handloom / Udyog Aadhar Memorandum (UAM) or any other body specified by Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MoMSME) **for the tendered works/services** are exempted from paying the earnest money.

(b) Small Scale Units permanently registered with NSIC are exempted from submission of EMD. Their registration certificate should be valid for the works/services quoted against the tender, on original due date of opening of tender. Copy of application or acknowledgement of application submitted by bidder to NSIC regarding registration / renewal of registration shall not be considered.

(c) PSU/Govt. Sector Companies (State & Central) like BHEL, NTPC, Railways/RITES/IOCL/HPCL/BPCL/CIL etc and reputed institutes like GEC/IIT/NPTI/CPRI/Other State Govt. Power Institutions etc. will also be exempted from submission of EMD. They have to upload a declaration in this regard.

(d) M.P. Laghu Udyog Nigam Ltd./M.P. Agro Industries Development Ltd. Are also exempted from submission of EMD. They have to upload a declaration in this regard.

Bidder must specify to provide notarized valid competency certificate issued to these industries for the respective work/item (and not the acknowledgement given by the department for the application submitted) for claiming such exemption.

In case the bidder fail to provide (online) such certificates mentioned above, it shall not be entitled to avail the benefit of the exemption from EMD and in such case their tender shall be treated as submitted without EMD deposition, hence liable for rejection.

NOTE: - (i) the bidders situated/based in the state of Madhya Pradesh and registered as medium enterprises are not allowed for exemption of EMD. Hence should not opt EMD exemption on the basis of above criteria.

(ii) The bidders of other state (not situated/based in state of Madhya Pradesh) and registered as micro & small enterprises not allowed for exemption in EMD. Hence such bidder should not opt EMD exemption on the basis of above criteria.

(vi) The prospective bidders will upload the scanned and self certified copies of EMD documents or documents for exemption of EMD on the web site along with the tender document. The bidder has to opt for “exemption “option on the web site and to upload the scanned copy of BG /documents for exemption of EMD.

[5] Submission of Documents for Eligibility:

The prospective bidders, who have adequate supporting documents to fulfill eligibility criteria as detailed above will upload scanned self-certified copies of requisite documents (in the manner prescribed in tender document) as required in e-tendering process. The bidder who so ever is submitting the tender by his digital signature certificate shall invariably upload the scanned copy of authority letter to submit the offer on behalf of the firm.

[7] Submission of Price bid:-

For price bid submission bidder shall have to download the price bid format and after filling the requisite fields of the same and submit the Price bid document by uploading the same online only as per instruction therein. Physical submission of price bid is prohibited and therefore shall not be entertained. The price bid of eligible bidders only shall be opened online on a later date, which shall be notified online www.mptenders.gov.in . The bidders can view the information of date of price bid opening on web site.

[8] In case, due date for submission & opening of tender happens to be a holiday, the due date shall be shifted to the next working day for which no prior intimation will be given. MPPGCL reserve the right for extension of due date of opening of bid considering participation of qualified bidders in the tender.

[9] Any change/modifications/alteration in the tender documents is not allowed and such tender shall be liable for rejection.

[10] In case of any discrepancies found between the downloaded tender documents from website and the master copy available in the office of the tender inviting officer, the later shall prevail. No claim / appeal on this account will be entertained or given cognizance. The bidder shall be solely responsible for the correctness/genuineness of the downloaded tender document from the web site. If the offer submitted through the downloaded tender document which are incomplete or with change contents, the offer will summarily be rejected.

2.86 LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Except in cases of criminal negligence or willful misconduct or except otherwise provided for specifically elsewhere in tender document:-

- a) The contractor shall not be liable to the owner, whether in contract, tort or otherwise for any indirect or consequential loss or damage, loss of use, loss of production, or loss of profits, provided that this exclusion shall not apply to any obligation of the contractor to pay liquidated damages / penalty to the owner and
- b) The aggregate liability of the contractor to the owner, whether under the contract in tort or otherwise, shall not exceed the total contract price, provided that this limitation shall not apply to the cost of repairing or replacing defective equipment, or to any obligation of the contractor to indemnify the owner respect to patent infringement.
