1. Terms and Conditions for Participation in Tender:

- (i) It is mandatory for prospective bidders to get registration on website www.mptenders.gov.in for e-tendering module of MPPGCL. Therefore, it is advised to all prospective bidders to get registration by making on line registration fees payment at the earliest.
- (ii) The tender documents can be purchased online only and downloaded from web site www.mptenders.gov.in by online payment of cost of tender document.
- (iii) Service and gateway charges shall be borne by the bidders.
- (iv) Since the bidders are required to sign their bids online using class-III Digital Certificates, they are requested to obtain the same at the earliest. Please note that it may take up to 7 working days for issue of Digital Certificate. MPPGCL will not be responsible for delay in issue of Digital Certificate.

- (v) If bidder is participating first time for e-tendering in MPPGCL, then it is obligatory on the part of bidder to fulfill all formalities such as registration, obtaining Digital Certificate etc. well in advance.
- (vi) MPPGCL shall not be responsible in any way for delay/difficulties/ inaccessibility of the downloading facility from the website for any reason whatsoever.
- (vii) Bidders are requested to visit MPPGCL, e-tendering web site (www.mptenders.gov.in) regularly for any clarification and /or due date extension or corrigendum. Any clarification and /or due date extension or corrigendum shall be issued on website www.mptenders.gov.in only.
- (viii) Bidders must positively visit online tendering process at www.mptenders.gov.in.
- (ix) For any type of clarifications regarding e-tendering process bidders can visit www.mptenders.gov.in and contact help desk contact number Nos 0120-4200462, 0120-4001002, 0120- 4001005 and 0120-6277787 and e- mail: support-eproc@nic.in. For any clarification regarding e- submission of offers, the bidders can contact the tender inviting authority on the phone nos. given in the NIT.
- (x) The bidder whosoever is submitting the tender by his Digital Signature Certificate, shall invariably upload the scanned copy of the authority letter to submit offers on behalf of the firm.

2. **TENDER FEE:**

- I. The cost of tender document as indicated above against each tender is required to be paid online by all the participating bidders. The tender document fee shall not be refundable.
- II. Exemption for MSME, Start ups and SSI of MP from payment of tender fees. The bidder(s) situated /based in state of Madhya Pradesh and registered as:-
 - i. Micro small enterprises /START UP
 - ii. S.S.I. units with DIC (District Industries centre) of Madhya Pradesh.
 - iii. Khadi village industries commission (KVIC) / Khadi Village Industries Board (KVIB)/Coir Board/Directorate of Handicraft and Handloom.
 - iv. UdhogAdharMemorandum (UAM) or any other body specified by ministry of Micro small and Medium Enterprises (MOMSME).

For the tendered item(s) are exempted from paying the tender fees : however such firms shall have to upload the requisite documents on e procurement website.

3. **Submission of Earnest Money Deposit:-**

- I. The earnest money as indicated above against each tender is to be submitted by bidder through e-payment mode via Netbanking/ Real Time Gross Settlement (RTGS)/National Electronic Fund Transfer (NEFT) OR in the form of Bank Guarantee from Nationalized/Scheduled Bank strictly as per the format enclosed as per Annexure-II.

No offer will be accepted without deposit of Earnest Money, unless exempted (after submission of supporting documents for exemption).

- I. The bidder shall have to deposit the earnest money as indicated in NIT.
- II. The bidders have to quote for complete package of works / services covered in the tender and pay earnest money as indicated in NIT.

III. Bid/Offer will not be accepted without deposit of Earnest money in proper form unless exemption is granted by MPPGCL as below-

IV. The exemption from submission of EMD shall be provided to the following bidders subject to uploading of relevant documents on e procurement website.

a. **The bidders situated / based in the state of Madhya Pradesh and registered as-**

- i. Micro small enterprises /START UP
- ii. S.S.I. units with DIC (District Industries centre) of Madhya Pradesh.
- iii. Khadi village industries commission (KVIC) / Khadi Village Industries Board (KVIB)/Coir Board/Directorate of Handicraft and Handloom.
- iv. UdhogAdharMemorandum (UAM) or any other body specified by ministry of Micro small and Medium Enterprises (MOMSME).

For the tendered item(s) are exempted from paying the earnest money: however, such firms shall have to upload the requisite documents on e procurement website.

b. Small scale Units permanently registered with NSIC are exempted from submission of earnest money deposit. Their registration certificate should be valid for the work s/services quoted against the tender, on original due date of opening of tender. Copy of application or acknowledgement of application submitted by bidder to NSIC regarding registration/renewal of registration shall not be considered.

c. PSU/Government sector companies (State or central) like BHEL, NTPC, RAILWAY/TITES/IOCL/HPCL/BPCL/CIL etc and reputed institutes like GEC/IIT/NIT/NPTI/CPRI/other state Government power institutions etc. will also be exempted from submission of EMD. They have to upload a declaration in this regard.

d. M.P. Laghu Udhog Nigam Ltd / MP Agro Industries Development Ltd. They have to upload a declaration in this regard.

V. The Earnest Money shall be refunded to un-successful bidders (except L1 & L2 bidder) within 30 days from the date of issuance of supply order to the successful bidder(s). The earnest money deposited by the successful bidder(s) and L2 bidder shall be returned within 30 days from the date of acceptance of security deposit submitted by the successful bidder against the awarded contract. No interest shall be paid in case of delay in release of EMD.

VI. Request for adjustment/appropriation of earnest money/other deposits, if any, already lying with MPPGCL in connection with other tenders/orders shall not be entertained. VII. In case, the tenderer withdraws offer during validity period or after placement of order, then EMD amount shall be forfeited.

VII The EMD shall be forfeited if MPPGCL finds that the bidder has been engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing of contract, or has concealed any material information or submitted misleading facts or statements in their bid/offer

VIII. EMD will be refunded/ returned to all the bidders if the tender is dropped by MPPGCL.

IX. EMD will be refunded/ returned to all those bidders who do not fulfill the Credential/Pre Qualifying Requirement as per the NIT.

X. Verification of Earnest Money Deposit:-

- a. The EMD as per NIT is to be submitted online through e-payment mode via Net banking/Real Time Gross Settlement (RTGS)/National Electronic Fund Transfer (NEFT). The online submission shall be considered for opening of bid Offer. EMD submitted online will be verified by MPPGCL.

OR

EMD is to be prepared in the form of Bank Guarantee from Nationalized/Scheduled bank Strictly as per the format enclosed as Annexure-II with validity of 9 months from the due date of opening of the tender and scanned self-certified copy of the same is to be uploaded on e-procurement website. The BG submitted online towards EMD will be verified by MPPGCL.

OR

The bidders exempted from submission of EMD shall have to upload the scanned self-certified copy of documentary evidence on e-procurement web site. Same documents shall be verified by MPPGCL.

- b. The envelope containing Bank Guarantee towards EMD in physical form of participating bidder shall be opened on due date & time. MPPGCL reserves the right to seek confirmation of bank guarantee from the issuing bank.
- c. The offers received without pre-requisite EMD shall be summarily rejected.

4. Submission of Documents for Eligibility:

- (i) The prospective bidders, who have adequate supporting documents to fulfill eligibility criteria as detailed above will upload scanned self-certified copies of requisite documents (in the manner prescribed in tender document) as required in e-tendering process.
- (ii) A scanned copy of authority letter issued by the bidder in favour of his representative under whose digital signature online tender has been submitted on behalf of the bidder is to be uploaded along with online tender submission on or before last date of submission of bid.
- (iii) The tenders submitted without requisite documents in desired manner shall not be opened. However, the cost of tender document shall not be refunded in any condition.

5. Submission of Techno-commercial bid:-

Bidders must positively complete online e-tendering procedure at www.mptenders.gov.in.

6. Submission of Price bid:-

For price bid submission bidder shall have to download the price bid format and after filling the requisite fields of the same and thereafter submit the Price bid document by uploading the same online only as per instruction therein. **Physical submission of price bid is prohibited and therefore shall not be entertained.** The price bid of eligible bidders only shall be opened online on a later date, which shall be notified online at www.mptenders.gov.in. The Bidders can view the information of date of price bid opening on web site.

7. In case, due date for submission & opening of tender happens to be a holiday, the due date shall be shifted to the next working day for which no prior intimation will be given.
8. MPPGCL reserves the right for extension of due date of opening of bid considering participation of qualified bidders in the tender.
9. Any change/modifications/alteration in the tender documents is not allowed and such tender shall be liable for rejection.

10. In case of any discrepancies found between the downloaded tender documents from website and the master copy available in the office of the tender inviting office, the later shall prevail. No claim / appeal on this account will be entertained or given cognizance.

The bidder shall be solely responsible for the correctness/ genuineness of the downloaded tender documents from the website. If the offer submitted through the downloaded tender document which are incomplete or with change in contents, the offer will summarily be rejected.

11. For amendment and further information regarding due date of extension / clarifications/ corrigendum/ updates, if any, the bidder should visit the website www.mptenders.gov.in regularly. In case of amendments/ due date of extension/ clarification/ corrigendum/ updates, the responsibility lies with the bidders to collect the same from the web site of MPPGCL or office of the undersigned before the last date of submission of tender document. MPPGCL shall have no responsibility for any delay/omission on part of the bidder.
12. MPPGCL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever.

13. Abnormally high/low rates quoted by Bidders- MPPGCL

(a) shall have right to obtain justification from bidder(s) for their quoted prices or rates. MPPGCL may ask for detailed price/rate analysis for such quotes and demonstration of justification from such bidder(s). In case the bid value quoted by the bidder is less than 80% of estimated value put to the tender then the quoted rates by bidder shall be considered abnormally low rates.

(b) The rates less by 20% (or more) than the estimated rates shall be considered abnormally low/high rates.

(c) In case of abnormally low rates for works/services the bidder(s) shall have furnish an additional security in the form of Bank Guarantee for the value in Rs obtained from the difference between the 80% of estimated value of works/services put to the tender and bid value on bidders quoted rates. The proforma of BG towards additional security is enclosed as Annex – XIV


14. Requirement to Read the Tender Documents by Bidder

15. The Bidders are requested to go through all the contents of Tender documents thoroughly before submission of their bids/offers.

16. Language of Bids / Offers - The Bids / Offers should be prepared in Hindi or English only.

NOTE:- The bidders not submitting all the desired documents as per NIT/Tender document at the time of Bid submission shall not be allowed to submit documents subsequently and their bids shall be liable for rejection on account of incomplete documents. There is no provision of shortfall documents and hence no communication in this regard shall be cetertained. Only technocommercial clarification (if required) can be obtained though e- mail/physical from, from the bidders and such clarification will he displayed in public Domain.
