RFP for Four-laning of Jhunjhunu – Chirawa –Pacheri Section from design km 0+000 to km 66+700 of NH-11 including Chirawa Northern Bypass from design km 0+000 (Junction with NH-11 at km 33+900) to km 10+260 (junction with SH-13) in the State of Rajasthan on HAM Mode

The Government of India had entrusted to the Authority the development, maintenance and management of National Highway No. 11 including the section from km 0.000 to km 66.700 (including Chirawa Northern Bypass from design km 0+000 to km 10+260) (Total length 76.96 km) and as part of this endeavor, it has been decided to undertake Four-laning of Jhunjhunu – Chirawa –Pacheri Section from design km 0+000 to km 66+700 of NH-11 including Chirawa Northern Bypass from design km 0+000 (Junction with NH-11 at km 33+900) to km 10+260 (junction with SH-13) in the State of Rajasthan on HAM Mode (the “Project”) on design, build, operate and transfer (the “DBOT Annuity” or “Hybrid Annuity”) basis, and has decided to carry out the bidding process for selection of a private entity as the Bidder to whom the Project may be awarded. However, Bid Security, Power of Attorney for signing of Bid, Power of Attorney for lead member of Consortium, if any, Joint Bidding Agreement for Consortium, if any, Integrity Pact, and experience certificates apostile at foreign origin, if any, and other documents required as per clause 2.11.2 of RFP shall be submitted

physically in original by the Lowest Bidder before issuance of Letter of Award (LOA) by the Authority. However, while submitting Bid Security via Account Payee demand draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's cheque, it is to be ensured by the Bidder that Account Payee demand draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's cheque are submitted physically latest within 5-working days of the Bid Due Date (upto 11:00 hours). Please note that the Authority reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the BIDs without assigning any reason whatsoever.
