The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways through Public Works Department (NH) Government of Rajasthan is engaged in the development of National Highways and as part of this endeavour, it has been decided to undertake Widening of existing two lane to four lane of Suratgarh-Sri Ganganagar section from Km. 175+000 to Km. 250+900 of NH-62 in the State of Rajasthan through an Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) Contract.

However, Bid Security, POA for signing the Bid, POA for lead member of JV, if any, JBA for JV, if any, Integrity Pact, and experience certificates apostile at foreign origin, if any and other documents specified in clause 2.11.2 of RFP shall be submitted physically in original by the Lowest Bidder before issuance of Letter of Acceptance (LOA) by the Authority. However, while submitting Bid Security via Account Payee demand draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque, it is to be ensured by the

Bidder that Account Payee demand draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque are submitted physically latest within 5 working days of the Bid Due Date (upto 11:00 hours).
