The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Government of India represented by Chief Engineer (West), Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Transport Bhawan, New Delhi-110001 is engaged in the development of National Highways and as part of this endeavour, it has been decided to undertake Upgradation of Chitrod-Rapar-Balasar section of NH-927C to two-lane with paved shoulders from design km 0.00 to km 57.848 in the State of Gujarat on EPC mode through an Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) Contract.

However, Bid Security, POA for signing the Bid, POA for lead member of JV, if any, JBA for JV, if any, Integrity Pact, and experience certificates apostile at foreign origin, if any and other documents specified in clause 2.11.2 of RFP shall be submitted physically in original by the Lowest Bidder before issuance of Letter of Acceptance (LOA) by the Authority. However, while submitting Bid Security via Account Payee demand draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque, it is to be ensured by the Bidder that Account Payee demand draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque are

submitted physically latest within 5 working days of the Bid Due Date (upto 11:00 hours). Please note that the Authority reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the BIDs without assigning any reason whatsoever.

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
