The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways through National Highways Authority of India is engaged in the development of National Highways and as part of this endeavour, it has been decided to undertake “Up-gradation of existing Highway to 4-laning Standard from Pachpadara Bypass (Ch. 95+780) to Patau Interchange (Ch. 115+003) Section of NH-25 in the State of Rajasthan on EPC mode.” through an Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) Contract.

Bid through any other mode shall not be entertained. However, Bid Security, Appendix IA, Appendix-IB, Annexure-V Statement of Legal Capacity, POA for signing the Bid, POA for lead member of JV, if any, JBA for JV, if any, Integrity Pact, and experience certificates apostille at foreign origin, if any and other documents specified in clause 2.11.2 of RFP shall be submitted physically in original by the Lowest Bidder before issuance of Letter of Acceptance (LOA) by the Authority. However, while submitting Bid Security via Account Payee demand draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker’s Cheque, it is to be ensured by the

Bidder that Account Payee demand draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque are submitted physically latest within 5 working days of the Bid Due Date (upto 11:00 hours). Please note that the National Highways Authority of India reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the BIDs without assigning any reason whatsoever.
