RFP for Upgradation of existing 4-lane Corridor from Km 71+000 (From Purvanchal Expressway) to Km 102+000 (Start of Ghazipur-Zamania-Saiyad Raja section) of NH-24 (Total length 30 km) in the State of Uttar Pradesh on HAM mode (Package-I).

The Government of India had entrusted to the Authority for Upgradation of existing 4-lane Corridor from Km 71+000 (From Purvanchal Expressway) to Km 102+000 (Start of Ghazipur-Zamania-Saiyad Raja section) of NH-24 (Total length 30 km) in the State of Uttar Pradesh on HAM mode (Package-I) (the "Project") on design, build, operate and transfer (the "DBOT Annuity" or "Hybrid Annuity") basis, and has decided to carry out the bidding process for selection of a private entity as the Bidder to whom the Project may be awarded. Bid submitted through any other mode shall not be entertained. However, Appendix-IA (Letter comprising the Technical Bid); Appendix-IB (Letter comprising the Financial BID), Annex-V Statement of Legal Capacity, Bid Security, Power of Attorney for signing of Bid, Power of Attorney for lead member of Consortium, if any, Joint Bidding Agreement for Consortium, if any, Integrity Pact, and experience certificates apostile at foreign origin, if any, and other documents required as per clause 2.11.2 of RFP shall be submitted physically in original by the Lowest Bidder before issuance of Letter of Award (LOA) by the Authority. However, while submitting Bid Security via Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's cheque, it is to be ensured by the Bidder that Account Payee demand draft or Banker's cheque are submitted physically latest within 5-working

days of the Bid Due Date (upto 11:00 hours) Please note that the Authority reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the BIDs without assigning any reason whatsoever.
