The Government of India had entrusted to the Authority the development, maintenance and management for Four laning of Kolhapur - Sangli section of NH-166 [from Sangli Phata (km 0.00) to Chokak (km 7.738) & Chokak (km 145.300) to Ankali (km 171.171) (Design Length - 33.609 km in the State of Maharashtra to be executed on Hybrid Annuity Mode under NH (O). ("Hybrid Annuity Mode") basis, and has decided to carry out the bidding process for selection of a private entity as the Bidder to whom the Project may be awarded. However, Bid Security, Power of Attorney for signing of Bid, Power of Attorney for lead member of Consortium, if any, Joint Bidding Agreement for Consortium, if any, Integrity Pact, and experience certificates apostile at foreign origin, if any, and other documents required as per clause 2.11.2 of RFP shall be submitted physically in original by the Lowest Bidder before issuance of Letter of Award (LOA) by the Authority. However, while submitting Bid Security via Account Payee demand draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque, it is to be ensured by the bidder that Account Payee demand draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque are submitted physically latest within 5 working days of the Bid Due Date.
