RFP for Construction & Upgradation of existing 2L+PS to 4-Lane with Paved Shoulder configuration from Km 0+000 (Tansen Chowk, Purani Chhawani, Gwalior) to Km 77+000 (Near Village - Prithvipur) of NH-719 in the State of Madhya Pradesh on Hybrid Annuity Mode (Package-1).

The Government of India had entrusted to the Authority the Construction & Upgradation of existing 2L+PS to 4-Lane with Paved Shoulder configuration from Km 0+000 (Tansen Chowk, Purani Chhawani, Gwalior) to Km 77+000 (Near Village - Prithvipur) of NH-719 in the State of Madhya Pradesh (Package-1) (the "Project") on design, build, operate and transfer (the "DBOT Annuity" or "Hybrid Annuity") basis, and has decided to carry out the bidding process for selection of a private entity as the Bidder to whom the Project may be awarded. However, Bid Security, Power of Attorney for signing of Bid, Power of Attorney for lead member of Consortium, if any, Joint Bidding Agreement for Consortium, if any, Integrity Pact, and experience certificates apostile at foreign origin, if any, and other documents required as per clause 2.11.2 of RFP shall be submitted physically in original by the Lowest Bidder before issuance of Letter of Award (LOA) by the Authority. However, while submitting Bid Security via Account Payee demand draft or Banker's cheque or Fixed Deposit Receipt, it is to be ensured by the Bidder that Account Payee demand draft or Banker's cheque or Fixed Deposit Receipt are submitted physically

latest within 5-working days of the Bid Due Date (upto 11:00 hours). Please note that the Authority reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the BIDs without assigning any reason whatsoever.
