13. Scope of Work:

- c) Replacement of existing PAC systems with the new one will need to be done in such a manner that 24x7x365 days operation of the Data centre will not be disturbed. In case of any manual operation, the agency needs to deploy manpower until completion of Installation.
- d) Before supply, planning of installation of new PAC systems needs to be submitted and endorsed by the IT head of the Institute.
- e) Provide adequate hands-on training to the staff of the Institute.
- f) A complete user manual, service manual and training material (files, videos, etc.) must be created and handed over by the prospective bidder/service provider.
- g) Handover software and licenses after successful implementation.
- h) All the units must be capable of working as a single unit and in N+1 mode. At any point in time, failure of one unit should be taken care of by the standby unit automatically.

a) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) commit himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the tender process and during the contract execution.
