(A-2) Technical BEC for 'WHRU Replacement Project'

1.0 Only the bidders who quote for the complete Scope of Work including optional items (if any) as described in the Bidding Documents, addendum (if any) and any subsequent information given to the bidder shall be considered.

3.0 Health, Safety and Environment:

Bidder must confirm compliance to all HSE criteria specified in bidding documents in general and to clauses 10.0 to 10.11 of Part-II of Volume-I of bidding documents in particular.

5.0 Experience/ capability of the bidder:

Experience/ capability of the bidder shall be as under-

a) The Bidder shall submit the documentary evidence in support of his experience and capability, as required, along with Techno-Contractual unpriced bid as per Appendix A-9.

b) Single bidder: Single bidder shall meet the experience criteria himself.

c) Incorporated Joint Venture Company:

In case the bidder is an Incorporated Indian Joint Venture Company, registered in India and incorporated under the Companies Act and any amendments thereunder, then the technical experience criteria laid down in the Technical BEC should be met as under:

(i) The Joint Venture Company by itself should meet the experience criteria.

OR

(ii) Any Partner in the Joint Venture Company having a stake of at least 26% in the Joint Venture Company should meet the technical experience criteria stipulated in the tender on its own and cannot rely on any other arrangement such as Consortium or Supporting Company of the JV Partner for meeting the technical experience criteria. Documentary evidence in support of the above should be submitted along with the techno-commercial bid.

(iii) In case of (ii) above, an undertaking from the Joint Venture Partner, based on whose experience the JV seek qualification, shall be submitted with the techno commercial bid stating they shall maintain minimum 26% shareholding in the JV till the execution of the contract.

d) Consortium Bids

(i) In case of consortium bids, leader and members of consortium should themselves meet the experience criteria covering the respective activities of work to be performed by them on their own and not through any other arrangement like through Supporting Company, Parent / Subsidiary / Sister Subsidiary / Co- Subsidiary / Technical Collaboration /Sub-contracting. Necessary documentary evidence to this effect should be submitted with techno- commercial bid.

The members of consortium shall decide the Leader of consortium. The leader of consortium shall have minimum 51% stake in terms of bid value, as reflected in the MOU executed by the consortium members. Each member of consortium shall remain jointly and severally liable to ONGC.

For this purpose the role and scope of work to be performed by the respective consortium members expressed as a percentage of bid value should be indicated in the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) submitted along with techno-commercial bid as per format provided in the tender.

- (ii) Notwithstanding the provisions that the members of consortium shall be jointly and severally liable to ONGC, the leader of consortium should undertake unconditional acceptance of primary responsibility of executing the entire 'Scope of work' of this tender. The confirmation should be submitted along with the techno-commercial bid.
- (iii) A constituent of the Consortium shall not be permitted to participate either in an individual capacity as a bidder or as a member of another Consortium in the same tender.
- (iv) Only that consortium member who has undertaken a particular activity in execution of a contract shall be considered as having technical experience of that particular activity
- (v) The overall responsibility of project management of entire project shall be that of the leader of the consortium.

Subsequent to completion of above project, Consortium leader shall be considered as having experience of all the activities by himself and he shall be qualified in future tenders of Western Offshore as having the experience of executing such Engineering, Procurement, Construction & Installation (EPCI) projects.

Common Note for sub-clauses (a) to (d)

- a) Successful bidder/ Contractor shall be required to perform by themselves (and not through other arrangement like through Supporting Company, Parent/ Subsidiary/ Sister Subsidiary/ Co-Subsidiary/ Technical Collaboration/ Sub-contracting) Project Management and at least one of main activities based on which they are seeking their qualification.
- b) In case of Consortium bids, all Consortium partner(s), other than the Leader of Consortium, shall also be required to perform by themselves (and not through arrangement like through Supporting Company, Parent/ Subsidiary/ Sister Subsidiary/ Co-Subsidiary/ Technical Collaboration/ Sub-contracting) one of the project activities (other than the activity(ies) indicated by the Leader of Consortium to be performed by Leader)
- c) Indian companies/ Joint Venture companies (Incorporated JV): - Indian bidders whose proposal for Joint Venture involves foreign equity participation or payment of royalty and / or lump sum for technical know-how and wherever Govt. approval is necessary, are required to submit copy of Govt. approval, on their application submitted to SIA, prior to the date price bid opening

Accordingly, Bidder shall submit the "Proforma for Work Experience" (Appendix B-5) and proposed "Division of Project Activities and Location of Work Centre" (Appendix B-6) of Volume –I along with the bid.

In case the bidder is proposing sub-contracting for any activity, sub-contractors' name shall be intimated in Proforma "Division of Project Activities and Location of Work Centre" (Appendix B-6) of Volume –I.

5.1 The Bidder must possess, prior to the deadline of submission of bids, experience of having executed as EPCI contractor at least

A. One (01) contract involving Design, Engineering, Procurement, Installation & Commissioning of

minimum one (01) number of Waste Heat Recovery Unit (WHRU)

OR

Revamping / Replacement / Modification at Offshore Platforms

OR

Revamping / Replacement / Modification of Surface Facilities at Onshore Installations

for Oil & Gas Installations / Petroleum Refineries / Petrochemical Industries / Any other Hydrocarbon Processing Industries during last 15 (fifteen) years.

AND

B. Bidder shall have experience of Management and Operation in offshore Oil / Gas fields as Marine Spread Provider during the last 15 (fifteen) years. Marine spread provider is an agency that has managed and operated at least one of the following:

(a) Accommodation barge

(b) Work boat

(c) OSV (Offshore Supply Vessel)

(d) MSV (Multipurpose Support Vessel)

(e) PSV (Platform Supply Vessel)

(f) FFSV (Fire Fighting Supply Vessel)

in offshore oil / gas fields.

In case, the bidder himself doesn't meet the experience criteria covering the respective activities of work of (A) and (b), bidder shall be allowed to meet the criteria through sub-contracting arrangement for activity (B).

The experience for (A) needs to be on EPCI basis by bidder or Leader of Consortium himself and the experience for (B), can be considered based on either by bidder himself or by its sub-contractor experience.

Note1:

- (i) In support of the clause 5.1 above, bidder shall submit along with the Techno-commercial bid copies of respective contracts, Purchase Orders or Work Orders along with documentary evidence in respect of satisfactory execution of each of those contracts/Purchase Orders/Work Orders, in the form of copies of any of the documents (indicating respective contract number & brief scope of work), such as – (i) Satisfactory Completion / Performance report (OR) (ii) Proof of release of performance security after completion of contract (OR) (iii) Proof of settlement / release of final payment against the contract (OR) (iv) any other documentary evidence that can substantiate the satisfactory execution of each of those contracts cited above.
- (ii) (A) and (B) together can either be single or maximum of two projects and successfully accomplishing activities, i.e., Project Management, Design, Engineering, Procurement, Installation, Commissioning in EPCI project listed at (A) above.

Note 2:

No part completion certificate shall be considered to meet above criteria, unless it can be clearly established based on submitted documents that bidder has already successfully completed part facility scope of work in a broader scope project on a EPCI basis, where the completed part scope of work is as envisaged in this main BEC clause 5.1 and handed over to the contractee for use. For evaluation, such jobs accompanied by Part Completion Certificate will be considered as completed.

Note 3:

For meeting the requirement above, the period reckoned shall be the period prior to the originally scheduled date of opening of the techno-commercial bid.

5.2 The Bidder (Either a single entity which includes Incorporated Indian Joint Venture OR a Consortium comprising of two or more partners being jointly and severally liable to the Company) must himself have the relevant experience in Project Management for completed project(s) (based on which bidder is seeking experience in clause 5.1 above) and for at least one of the following main activities:

- a) Design and Engineering for,

- d) Procurement for,
Waste Heat Recovery Units (WHRUs) **OR** Revamping / Replacement / Modification at Offshore Platforms **OR** Revamping / Replacement / Modification of Surface Facilities at Onshore Installations

In case of Consortium bid, other Consortium partner(s) should also have the experience of performing at least one distinct project activity as indicated in 5.1, other than Project Management (which shall be done by the Leader) based on his own experience.

However, Leader of Consortium bidder should have experience of Project Management and at least one activity as listed at either (a) or (b) or (c) above. Experience of Procurement activity (d) shall not be considered for qualification of Leader of Consortium.

5.3 The overall responsibility of project management of entire project shall be that of Successful bidder/ Contractor/ Leader of Consortium (in case of Consortium). Successful bidder/ Contractor/ Leader of Consortium (in case of Consortium) shall also be required to perform by themselves (and not through other arrangement like through supporting company, Parent/ Subsidiary/ Sister Subsidiary/ Co-subsidiary/ Technical collaboration/ Sub-contracting), Project Management and at least one of following main activities based on which they are seeking their qualification in Clause No. 5.2:

- a. Design and Engineering of Waste Heat Recovery Units (WHRUs)
- b. Installation and Commissioning of Waste Heat Recovery Units (WHRUs)
- c. Management and Operation of Marine Spread
- d. Procurement of Waste Heat Recovery Units (WHRUs)

In case of contractor being a Consortium, all Consortium partner(s), other than the Leader of Consortium, shall also be required to perform by themselves (and not through other arrangement like through supporting company, Parent/ Subsidiary/ Sister Subsidiary/ Co-subsidiary/ Technical Collaboration/ Sub-contracting) one of the project activities on which they are seeking their qualification under clause 5.2 above [other than the activity(ies) indicated by the Leader of Consortium to be performed by Leader].

Note:

This clause shall be evaluated to assess the bidder's commitment and responsibility to be taken by him in the instant project on the basis of experience qualified in Clause 5.2 above, that is Project Management

and at least one of the activity (ies) as mentioned in (a) to (d) and intimated in “Division of Project Activities and Location of Work Centre” (Appendix B-6).

b) In case of any difficulty in submitting above commitments from any OEMs at the bidding stage, the bidder shall submit his own undertaking to the effect that the undertaking required in sub-Para (a) above from those OEM(s) will be furnished at the detailed engineering stage. However, in case successful bidder fails to submit the same at the detailed engineering stage, ONGC reserves the rights to cancel the contract, forfeit the Performance Security and take suitable action for banning such bidders from future business dealings with ONGC as deemed fit.

13.0 An undertaking shall be submitted by the bidder along with the bid that they have carefully gone through the guidelines/notifications issued by Govt. of India which are also available at Meity's official website i.e. URL www.meity.gov.in/www.makeinindia.com for providing preference to Domestically Manufactured Electronics products (DMEP) in Government procurement and in case contract is awarded to them, until & unless there are compelling technical reasons for not doing so, which shall also be specified by them in their bid, they will give preference to specified domestically manufactured electronic items for execution of the contract.
