INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

A. GENERAL

1. Definitions:

- (a) "Employer" means the **Bhadrak Municipality** represented by the **Executive Officer, Bhadrak Municipality, Bhadrak**.
- (b) "Contract" means the contract/ agreement signed by the parties along with all attached documents listed in the RFP document (RFP Document Part -I & II).
- (c) "Day" means a calendar day.
- (d) "Government" means the Government of Odisha.
- (e) "Instructions to Bidders (Section-2(B) of the Part-I of RFP document) means the document which provides all information needed to prepare their proposals.
- (f) "Proposal" means the Technical Proposal (RFP Document Part I – Technical Bid) and the Financial Proposal (RFP Document Part II – Price Bid).
- (g) "Bidders" means the contractor/supplier/Authorized dealer / Manufacturers etc.

2. Eligibility:

Refer Section-I, Clause 6.0 of RFP.

3. Original Certificates:

Original documents/certificates shall be produced as and when required to verify the copies of statements and other information furnished along with RFP if required.

4. RFP Documents:

- 4.2. The Bidder is expected to examine carefully all instructions, terms of reference, conditions, forms, appendices to RFP, addenda in the RFP documents. Failure to comply with the requirements, RFP submission will be at the Bidder's own risk.

5. Clarification of RFP Documents:

The Bidder shall carefully examine the RFP documents and be fully informed of all the conditions and matters, which may in any way affect the work or the cost thereof. Should a Bidder find any discrepancy in or omission from the specification or any other of the RFP documents or should he be in doubt as to their meaning, he should immediately address a clarification online.

6. Amendment of RFP Documents:

1. At any time prior to the dead line for submission of RFPs, Executive Officer, Bhadrak Municipality, Bhadrak may for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to the clarifications requested by the prospective Bidder, modify the RFP documents by issuing an Addendum.
2. Such addenda will be notified in the website and will be binding upon them.
3. In order to afford prospective Bidder reasonable time to take such addenda into account in preparing their RFPs, Executive Officer, Bhadrak Municipality, Bhadrak at his discretion, may extend the dead line for the submission of RFPs, if necessary.

C. PREPARATION OF RFP DOCUMENT

7. Language of the Documents:

All documents relating to the RFP shall be in the English language.

8. **Documents Comprising the RFP:**
 - (a) Technical Bid (Part-I of RFP Document)
 - (b) Price Bid (Part-II of RFP Document)
 - (c) All documents stipulated elsewhere in the RFP.
9. **Sufficiency of RFP:**

The Bidder shall be deemed to have satisfied himself before Quoting as to the correctness and sufficiency of his RFP for the services to be provided and of the prices quoted in the financial bid, which shall cover all his obligations under the contract and all matters and things necessary for the successful accomplishment of the work.
10. **Preparation of Proposal:**
 1. The Proposal (see Section-2(B) Clause 1(g)) as well as all related correspondence exchanged by the employer & the Bidder shall be written in the language specified in the Data Sheet.
 2. In preparing the proposal, the Bidder is expected to examine in detail the documents comprising the RFP. Material deficiencies in providing the information requested may result in rejection of a proposal.
11. **The Financial Proposal:**
 - 11.1. The Bidder shall quote his rates on prescribed form of the Bill of Quantity (BOQ) on-line only.
 - 11.2. The rate quoted by the firm shall be firm.
 - 11.3. The Bidder shall also upload the Price Break-up per unit quantity in the prescribed format at Annexure-I duly signed and upload in .pdf format along with Price Bid.
 - 11.4. The total rate as derived in the Price Breakup including all taxes and transportation, loading & unloading etc. should be quoted in the Column-6 of BOQ (excel format) of Price Bid to be uploaded by the Bidder.
12. **Offer Validity:**
 - 12.1. The proposal must remain valid for **One Year** from the date of opening of price bid.
 - 12.2. The contractor/ Bidder/Manufacturer agreeing to the request of extending the validity period of the proposal will not be required or permitted to modify his RFP.
13. **Authorization, Corrections, etc. in RFP document:**
 - 13.1. The RFP document shall be digitally signed by a person duly authorized to do so. Proof of authorization shall be furnished in the form of a certified copy of Power of Attorney, which shall accompany the RFP.
 - 13.2. Only one RFP shall be submitted by a Bidder. Submission of bids through e-Procurement portal, the system shall consider only the last bids submitted through portal.
14. **Earnest Money Deposit and Bid Document cost**
 - 14.1. The bidder shall transfer the EMD/Bid security amounting Rs. 20,000 /- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) in online mode in <https://tendersodisha.gov.in> portal. Any bid not accompanied by EMD/Bid security, shall be rejected as non-responsive. The EMD for unsuccessful bidder shall be returned as promptly following OPWD Code. No interest would be payable for any period on EMD or any other amount lying with the Employer. The Security (EMD /ISD) shall be forfeited in the following cases:
 - a) If the bidder withdraws/modifies its Bid/Proposal after due date & during the

Proposal Validity Period.

- b) Bidder engages in corrupt, fraudulent, coercive, or undesirable practice or restrictive practice as specified in the tender document.
- c) Bidder failed to Sign the Contract within reasonable time.

14.2 Bid document cost of Rs.6, 000.00 is to be transferred in online mode in [https:// tendersodisha.gov.in](https://tendersodisha.gov.in) portal.

14.3 GST Registration Certificate / GSTIN:

Bidders are required to submit copies of valid GST Registration Certificate / GSTIN.

15. Signing of RFPs / Bid

All RFP documents will be signed digitally with Digital Signature Certificate (DSC). The Bidder shall digitally sign on all statements, documents, certificates, uploaded by him, owing responsibility for their correctness / authenticity as per IT Act 2000. If any of the information furnished by the Bidder is found to be false / fabricated / bogus, his RFP shall not be considered during evaluation.

15.1. If the RFP is submitted by an individual, it shall be signed with his own Digital Signature Certificate (DSC).

15.2. If the RFP is made by a Manufacturer/corporation / company, it shall be signed by a duly authorized officer who shall produce with his RFP satisfactory evidence of his authorization. Such a Manufacturer/ corporation / company may be required before the contract is executed, to furnish evidence of its corporate existence. The RFP shall contain no alterations or additions, except those to comply with instructions issued by the RFP Inviting Officer, or as necessary to correct errors made by the Bidder, in which case all such corrections shall be digitally signed.

16. Clarification and Amendment to RFP Document:

16.1. Bidder may request a clarification to any clause of the RFP documents up to the number of days indicated in the RFP document at Section-I before the proposal submission date. Any request for clarification must be sent online in the portal. The Employer will respond to this online through the same portal. Should the Employer deem it necessary to amend the RFP document as a result of a clarification, it shall do so following the procedure under para 2(B) 16.2.

16.2. At any time prior to the submission of proposals, the Employer may modify the RFP document by issuing an addendum or corrigendum, which will be published on the designated portal. Such addendum/corrigendum shall be binding on all Bidders. If the amendment is significant, the Employer may extend the proposal submission deadline to allow Bidders adequate time to incorporate the changes into their proposals. The primary purpose of such amendments is to clarify any issues or address queries raised by Bidders regarding the tendering of the works.

D. SUBMISSION OF RFPs

17. In view of adoption of e-procurement process the Bidders are required to follow the guide lines issued by Government of Odisha in Works Department Office Memorandum No.7885/W Dt.23.07.2013 (Appendix-I)

17.1. Bid Documents:

Bid documents consisting of technical bid & price bid shall be provided in the portal. Submission of bids will be through the e-Procurement portal. The Bidders shall prepare the documents & up load the scanned document to the portal in appropriate place in PDF format.

17.2. Clarification of Bidding Documents:

The Bidder can seek clarification within the period of seeking clarification as mentioned in RFP call notice. The Employers response for the queries raised by the Bidder will be posted in the portal.

17.3. Documents Comprising the Bids:

The Bidder shall submit the scanned copies of all the documents in the designated locations of Technical Bid. Submission of document shall be effected by using Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) of appropriate class and thus shall be in encrypted form.

17.4. Bid Price:

An intelligent Bill of Quantity in Microsoft Excel format shall be made available to the Bidder. The Bidder shall download that particular Excel sheet and fill in rates in figures at the appropriate location. The line-item total in words and the total amount in case of item rate RFPs shall be calculated automatically and shall be visible to the Bidder. In case of percentage RFP, the Bidder will only fill in the designated cell and activate "less" or "excess" to indicate whether his price offer is how much excess or less than the estimate amount. The Bidder will write percentage excess or less up to two decimal points only. The Bidder is not supposed to change or modify the format of the excel sheet in any form.

17.5. Submission of Bid:

The Bidder shall upload the scanned copy/copies of documents as required as per the RFP document. The Bidder shall have to produce the original documents in support of scanned copies & statements up-loaded in the portal on demand by the employer prior to award of contract-failing which action as per prevailing law/rules will be initiated.

The Bidder shall only submit single copy of the document. He is required to check the documents uploaded with the requirement asked for in the bid. Only after satisfying that all the documents have been uploaded, he should activate submit button. His bids shall not be considered responsive and action as per relevant clause shall be taken if he does not provide the required documents or provided illegible document. Clarity of the document may be ensured by taking out a sample printing.

17.6. Late Bids:

The e-Procurement Portal shall reject submission of any bid after closure of the receipt time. For all purpose the portal time displayed in the system shall be the time to be followed by the Bidder.

18. Modification & Withdrawal of Bid:

The e-Procurement Portal, allows modification of the bid before the last date & time of submission. The Bidder shall have to log on to the system and resubmit

the documents as asked for by the system including the price bid. In doing so, the bids already submitted by the Bidder will be removed automatically from the system and the latest bid only will be admitted. But the Bidder should avoid modification of bid at the last moment to avoid system failure or malfunction of internet or traffic jam. If the Bidder fails to submit his modified bids within the designated time of receipt, the bids already in the system shall be taken for evaluation.

The e-Procurement Portal, allows withdrawal of the bid before the last date & time of submission. The Bidder has to click on the “withdraw” button and record the necessary justification for the same in the space provided. In addition to this, he has to write a letter addressed to the Officer inviting the bid and up load the scanned document to portal in respective bid. The system shall not allow any withdrawal after expiry of the closure time of the bid.

19. **Bid Opening:**

The Bidders who participated in the online bidding can witness opening of the bid from any system logging on to the portal away from opening place. The bids can only be opened by the pre-designated officials only after the opening time mentioned in the bid.

E. OPENING OF RFP AND EVALUATION

20. **RFP Opening:**

20.1 The **Executive Officer, Bhadrak Municipality, Bhadrak** will open the RFPs electronically on the date & time mentioned in the **Notice Inviting RFP**.

- 20.2 (i) A RFP shall be rejected if;
- a) BoQ is not uploaded.
 - b) **Annexure-I (Price Break-up)** is not uploaded.
- (ii) In case if the Bidder has not submitted following document with the bid due to any reason, clarification may be sought and queries may be issued to the Bidders for submission of the same within a stipulated period, failing which their offer shall be liable for rejection.
- a) Proof of eligibility is not enclosed.(such as registration certificate etc)
 - b) PAN is not enclosed.
 - c) GST Registration Certificate/ GSTIN are not enclosed.
 - d) Required affidavit to the effect that the information/ documents furnished by the bidder are correct.
 - e) Complete audited annual financial year statement for last one year (2023-24/2024-25) including audit report, balance sheets, profit & loss accounts statement all other schedules etc.
 - f) An affidavit declaring that the bidder has not been debarred or blacklisted by any State or Central Government organization within the last five years.

20.3. Any such conditions shall be minuted.

20.4. The **Executive Officer, Bhadrak Municipality, Bhadrak** may prepare, for his own record, minutes of the RFP opening, including the RFP opening summary /Technical evaluation which shall be posted in the portal.

21. **Clarification on RFPs from Bidders:**
To assist in the scrutiny, evaluation and comparison of the RFPs, the **Executive Officer, Bhadrak Municipality** may ask the Bidders individually for clarification on their RFPs. The request for clarification and response shall be in writing or by mail. However, no change in the RFP amount/ rate shall be sought, offered or permitted by the **Executive Officer, Bhadrak Municipality** during the evaluation of the RFPs.

22. **Selection of Rate on the basis of Lowest Quoted Price:**
Other condition being equal, the Bidder bidding the lowest price will be considered for acceptance by the competent authority.

SECTION - 3


GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS



1. Rates:



Contractors, suppliers, authorized dealers, manufacturers, or bidders shall upload, in the price bid section, a detailed break-up of the quoted price indicating the basic rate, transportation, loading and unloading charges (excluding GST), installation charges, and one-year AMC, as applicable. The break-up shall be duly signed and submitted in PDF format as per Annexure-I.



2. The successful bidder shall ensure execution of the assignment within a period of 90 days from the date of issue of LOA/work Order.
3. The quantity mentioned in the RFP is estimated only. Final quantity shall be intimated by the Municipality, while ordering. Quantity may increase/ decrease as per requirement of the Municipality and bidder shall supply & install the same as per agreed rate for 1 year in same terms & conditions.
4. The Supplier shall submit manufacturer's warranty certificate for benches during the delivery of Goods. After delivery & before installation, inspection shall be carried out to check whether the materials delivered are in conformity with the technical specifications attached to the purchase order. In the event of the materials failing to pass the acceptance test, the purchaser shall get the materials replaced by the supplier at no extra cost to client.
5. The Employer and bidder shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informal negotiation on any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with the contract.
6. That for the purpose of jurisdiction in the event of disputes if any of the contracts would be deemed to have been entered in to within the State of Orissa and it is agreed that neither party to the contract will be competent to bring a suit in regard to the matter by this contract at any place outside Bhadrak.
7. Bhadrak Municipality reserves the right to reject any/all Proposals including the lowest Proposal, or withdraw the invitation of the Proposal at any stage without citing any reason. Nothing contained herein shall confer any right upon a bidder, or create any obligation/liability upon the Bhadrak Municipality of any type whatsoever.
8. In case of breach of any terms and conditions and failure to supply the required materials by the successful bidder, Bhadrak Municipality will have the right to cancel the order/contract without assigning any reason thereof and nothing will be paid by the Municipality to the supplier and in that event the Security fee will also be forfeited.
9. The decision of the Tender committee of the Bhadrak Municipality on selection/rejection of bidders would be final basing on the proposal submitted by the bidders.
10. The purchase order/LoA shall be placed to the selected bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive and who has offered the lowest evaluated bid price. The committee shall also not be bound to accept the lowest rate.
11. Statutory Taxes such as GST, IT etc shall be deducted from the bill of the bidder at the prevailing rates of Govt. Security deposit @ 5% of the Gross Value of the bill shall be deducted which will be released after conduct of Audit.

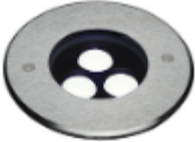
