**NOTICE INVITING TENDER**

The Superintending Engineer Public Works Department, (PWD) O/o Office of the Superintending Engineer ,NH Center Circle for and on behalf of the Governor of Kerala invites online bids for the work detailed below from the Registered Bidders of Kerala PWD/Central PWD/Other Central or State Government Departments/State or Central Public Sector Undertakings etc. who have successfully completed at least one similar work costing more than 40% (Forty percentage) of the estimated cost of the work within the last five years. A certificate to this effect from the agreement executing authority of the completed similar work shall invariably be submitted along with the tender documents failing which the tenders will not be accepted. The certificate should contain the details such as name of work, agreement number, date of start and completion as per agreement, completed amount of work etc.

4	Brief Description of Work	<p>Stretch of old NH 66 is now maintained by NHAI as part of ongoing to laying of NH 66. Due to very high traffic intensity and passing of heavy machineries, pot holes were formed in the existing NH66 and pot hole filling were done by NHAI. Due to pathetic condition of road, member of LA constituencies were requested to hand over the bypassed sections of old NH to roads wing for maintaining the road periodically. As per letter No. 11137/RO-Kerala/State Govt. correspondance /2352 dated 22/11/24 of Project director , NHAI has requested to prepare cost estimate for one time improvement of stretches being bypassed during development of NH66 and to degrading and transferred to PWD for further maintenance and development. Hence this estimate.</p> <p>As listed in the letter of NHAI, 6 Laning of Kodungallur to Edappilly section of NH 66 (Design ch 400/410 to 407/930), renovation of road bypassed from Moothakunnam labour junction to Vazhikkulangara (old ch 413/800 to 422/850), Cheriappilly to Valluvally Athani ( old ch 423/800 to 425/950 ), Kavil nada to Koonammavu ( old ch 427/100 to 427/970 ) is included in the estimate. The existing road from 413/800 to 427/970 is totally damaged due to high traffic intensity. Existing handrails in Vadakkekara &amp; Cheriappilly bridge are totally damaged and nee to be replaced for safe traffic. Due to the narrow width in culvert portion near Andippillikkavu crash barrier is proposed. Accidents were reported in the Bridges as there is no protection works hence crash barrier is provided in approaches of bridges. Being the road is narrow one and the soil condition is very poor, strengthening subbase layer required. Hence provision of 200 mm thick WMM, proposed in this estimate. 50 mm DBM and 40mm BC over lay is proposed in this estimate. Provision for construction of earthen shoulders, thermoplastic painting, road stud etc are included. Some areas damaged due to heavy rain and water logging. Hence these areas added in the items scarifying and WMM.</p> <p>In addition, provisions for RCC drain are included as requested from respected MLA. Estimate is prepared based on DSR 2021 with cost index 44.45% of Ernakulam District. Total amount of estimate works to Rs.1256 Lakhs including 18% Gst.</p>

The hard copies of certificates and documents, as detailed in clause 4.4 of Part-I Instructions to the Bidders, shall be submitted subsequently after online submission of bids in a separate cover by registered post/speed post before the date and time of opening of technical bid. Price Bid shall only be submitted through online. Details regarding remittance of Bid Submission Fee and Bid Security, Bid preparation and submission are mentioned in the bid document.

The bids shall be opened online on 15-06-2026 at 11:30 at the office of the O/o Office of the Superintending Engineer, NH Center Circle in the presence of the Bidders /their authorized representatives who wish to attend at the above address. If the tender opening date happens to be on a holiday or non-working day due to any other valid reason, the tender opening process will be done on the next working day at same time and place.

More details can be had from the Office of the Superintending Engineer, Public Works Department (Public Works Department) O/o Office of the Superintending Engineer, NH Center Circle during working hours.

All other existing conditions related to bidding in force in the Kerala Public Works Department will be applicable in this tender also unless expressly defined in the bidding document. The Tender Inviting Authority/Employer shall not be responsible for any failure, malfunction or breakdown of the electronic system while downloading or uploading the documents by the Bidder during the e-procurement process. Details required for e-payment (Details of bank account having core banking facility and email address of the bidder) shall be furnished along with the tender. Tenders not accompanied by these details will be rejected. All subsequent Government orders connected to tenders and any revision in the rates of taxes would also be applicable to this tender.

Bonus will be paid to the bidder at the rate of 1% of the estimated PAC, subjected to a maximum of Rs.5 lakhs (Five lakhs) in case of works which exceed TS power of Superintending Engineer and also if and only if the work is completed within 85% of the original time of completion (TOC) specified in the TS estimate which is calculated as per the guidelines issued by the Chief Engineer of each wing.
