1. Contractors who fulfill the following requirements shall be eligible to apply. Joint ventures are not accepted.

(a) Should have satisfactorily completed the works as mentioned below during the last Seven years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited.

(i) Three similar works each costing not less than **Rs. 18,54,115/- (40% of ECPT)**, or two similar works each costing not less than **Rs. 27,81,173/-(60% of ECPT)** or one similar work costing not less than **Rs. 37,08,230 /- (80% of ECPT)**. Similar work means **Construction works (i.e Civil works of RCC)**. The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum; calculated from the date of completion to previous day of last day of submission of tenders.

(b) Should have had Average Annual Financial Turnover of **Rs. 13,90,586 /-(30% of the work value for last 03 years)** on construction works during the immediate last three years ending

31st March 2026. (Scanned copy of Certificate from CA with Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) to be uploaded). The value of annual turnover figures shall be brought to the current value by enhancing the actual turnover figures at simple rate of 7% per annum.

(c) Should not have incurred any loss (profit after tax should be positive) in more than two years during the last five years ending **31st March 2026.**

(d) Should have a Banker's Certificate from a commercial Bank for **Rs. 18,54,115/- (40% of ECPT)** or Net Worth certificate from CA with Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) of minimum **10 %** amount of ECPT (Scanned copy of original to be uploaded).

2. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.

3. This information and instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.

4. The bid document consisting of Plans, Specifications, Schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from www.eprocure.gov.in free of cost.

5. But the bid can only be submitted after deposition of original EMD in the office of **Dy. Inspector General, Sector Headquarters, SSB, Purnea** within the period of bid submission and uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as TDR or Fixed Deposit Receipts from any of the Commercial Bank towards EMD in favour of as mentioned in NIT, deposition of original EMD and Banker's Certificate to office of **Dy. Inspector General, Sector Headquarters, SSB, Purnea** and certified copies of other documents as specified should be deposited before last date and time of bid submission.

6. The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature certificate with encryption key (combo type) to perform any operations/transactions on the website.

7. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of bids, he will receive the competitor bid sheets.

8. Contractor can upload documents in the form of **PDF format.**

9. **Certificate of Financial Turn Over:** At the time of submission of bid contractor may upload Affidavit/Certificate from CA mentioning Financial Turnover of last 7 years or for the period as specified in the bid document and further details if required may be asked from the contractor after opening of technical bids. **There is no need to upload entire voluminous balance sheet.**

10. Contractor must ensure to quote rate of each item. The column meant for quoting rate in figures appears in yellow colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue.

In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0"(ZERO). Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO).

However, If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

11. The Technical Bid shall be opened first on given date and time as mentioned above. The time and date of opening of financial bid of contractors qualifying the technical bid shall be communicated to them at a later date.

12. Pre-Bid conference shall be held in the chamber of **Deputy Commandant (Engineer), Sector Headquarters, SSB at O/o the Dy. Inspector General, SHQ, SSB, Muzffarpur on 14/05/2026 at 1200 Hrs** to clear the doubt of intending bidders, if any.

13. **The department reserves the right to reject any prospective application without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many bids are received satisfying the laid down criterion.**

14. The contractor submitting the bid should read the schedule of quantities, Special conditions, additional conditions, particular specifications and other terms and conditions given in the NIT and drawings. The bidder should also read the **General Conditions of Contract for CPWD Works 2023(Construction work) with all correction slips** issued up to the last date for submission of bid, which is available **at CPWD website**. However, provisions included in the bid document shall prevail over the provisions contained in the standard form. The set of drawings and NIT shall be available with the **Deputy Commandant (Engineer), Sector Headquarters, SSB, Purnea**. The contractor may visit the site of work and acquaint himself with the site conditions before tendering. The following conditions, which already form part of the tender conditions, are specially brought to his notice for compliance while filling the tender. They are requested to comply with the following instructions.

15. Tenders with any condition including that of conditional rebates shall be rejected. Such tenders shall not be entered in the tender opening register at the time of opening of tender.

16. The successful tenderer shall be required to submit a **Performance Guarantee of 5% (Five Percent)** of the tendered amount within **7 days** of issue of letter of intent. This period can be further extended by Engineer-in-Charge upto a maximum period of 7 days on the written request of the contractor subject to payment of late fee @0.1% per day of Performance Guarantee amount.

17. GST on all materials as well as GST on Work Contract etc., or any other taxes applicable in respect of this contract shall be payable by the Contractor. Percentage rate quoted by him shall be inclusive of all such taxes, levies etc. and Government will not entertain any claim for reimbursement whatsoever in respect of the same. The percentage rates of the contract shall be inclusive of all taxes and levies and nothing extra shall be paid. Further the percentage rate quoted

by the contractor shall be inclusive of labour welfare cess and the same shall be recovered from the contractors' bills and will be remitted by the department.

18. Applicants are advised to keep visiting the <https://ssb.gov.in> or eprocure.gov.in websites as applicable from time to time (till the deadline for bid submission) for any updates in respect of the tender documents, if any. Failure to do so shall not absolve the applicant of his liabilities to submit the application complete in all respects including updates thereof, if any. An incomplete application may be liable for rejection.

19. This work requires engaging more than 20 nos. of labours/workers and therefore all necessary licenses such as Labour license, EPFO and ESI, BOCW welfare registration etc., shall be taken by contractor within the time limits as prescribed under Clause-1 of Schedule- 'F'.

20. Contractor shall not divert any advance payments or part thereof for any other purpose other than needed for completion of the contracted work. All advance payments received as per terms of the contract (i.e. ~~mobilization, secured against materials brought at site, secured against plant & machinery~~ and or for work done during interim stages, etc.) are required to be re-invested in the contracted work to ensure advance availability of resources in terms of materials, labour, plant & machinery needed for required pace of progress for timely completion of work.

21. If any information furnished by the applicant is found incorrect at a later stage, he shall be liable to be debarred from tendering/taking up of works in SSB. The department reserves the right to verify the particulars furnished by the applicant independently.

22. The safety and security of the completed Border pillar is the responsibility of the contractor till they are handed over to SSB. After completion of the work, taking over process may take time and the responsibility of the Border pillar including all fixtures and fittings/constructed infrastructure is the complete responsibility of the contractor and nothing extra shall be payable on this account.

23. GST applicable as per Government norms up to date. Contractor should quote the rate including GST as per Govt. norms, nothing to be reimbursed against GST directly.

24. The Earnest money will not be considered as a part of Performance Guarantee. Performance Guarantee should be submitted separately by the successful bidder.

25. Supplementary agreement will be applicable on guaranteed items such as water proofing treatment etc.

26. Any dispute arising out of this tender including dispute related to encashment of any Bank Guarantee/ FDR etc., shall be subject to the jurisdiction of courts at **Patna** only.

27. Contractor may visit the site to assess the condition of site. A certificate in this regard may be obtained from the concerned unit In charge for proof of visiting the site accordingly.

- (XIII) **The bid will not be considered / rejected if,**

(XIV) The department will not be responsible for delay in online submission of tender due to any reason whatsoever.

(XV) All the bidders are instructed to upload documents as per NIT. Uploading of irrelevant/un-necessary documents at the time of submission of bid may be avoided strictly.

CPWD-6 FOR E-TENDERING

1. Online Percentage rate bid is invited on behalf of President of India from approved and eligible contractors of CPWD and those of appropriate list of M.E.S., BSNL, Railway and Bihar State Building Construction Department for the work of **Construction of Indo-Nepal Border pillars of 18 Bn Rajnagar, 45 Bn Birpur, 56 Bathnaha & 52 Bn Araria under SHQ SSB Purnea.**

The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of bid. In case the last date of submission of bid is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of bid.

1.1 The work is estimated to cost **Rs.46,35,288/- (Civil)** This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.

1.2 Intending bidders is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below: - Criteria of eligibility for submission of bid documents.

To become eligible for issue of bid, the bidders shall have to furnish an affidavit as under:

I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for bidding in SSB in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer-in-Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee. **(Scanned copy to be uploaded at the time of submission of bid).**

1.2.1 When bids are invited from contractors as per provisions of clause 1.2.1 above, it will be mandatory for contractors to upload the work experience certificate(s) and the affidavit as per the provisions of clause 1.2.2. Uploading of these two letters is mandatory otherwise system will not clear mandatory fields.

2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form No. CPWD-7 which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website www.eprocure.gov.in Bidders shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.

3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **180 days** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.

4. (i) The site for the work is available.

(ii) The architectural and structural drawing for the work is available.

5. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except **General Conditions of Contract for CPWD Works 2023(Construction work) with all correction slips** issued up to the last date for submission of bid, can be seen on website <https://eprocure.gov.in> and on www.ssb.nic.in free of cost.

6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.

7. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.

8. Earnest Money in the form of Bank Guarantee or Fixed Deposit Receipt from any of the Commercial Banks (drawn in favour of **Dy. Inspector General, Sector Headquarters, SSB, Purnea**) shall be scanned and uploaded on the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. The original EMD should be deposited in the office of **Dy. Inspector General, Sector Headquarters, SSB, Purnea** by due date & time as per NIT.

The earnest money given by all the tenderers except the lowest tenderer shall be refunded immediately after the expiry of stipulated bid validity period or immediately after acceptance of the successful bidder, whichever is earlier. However, in case of two/ three bid system, earnest money deposit of bidders unsuccessful during technical bid evaluation etc. should be returned within 30 days of declaration of result of technical bid evaluation.

Legible copy of Enlistment Order and certificate of work experience and other documents as specified in the notice inviting e-tender shall be scanned and uploaded on the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, whose original EMD, original Bank Solvency Certificate and certified copy of all the scanned and uploaded documents as specified in e-tender notice deposited with **Deputy Commandant (Engineer), Sector Headquarters, SSB, Purnea** or any other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.

The bid submitted shall be opened after **1600 Hrs on 21/05/2026**.

9. The bid submitted shall become invalid and e-Tender processing fee (if applicable) shall not be refunded if:

(i) The bidder is found ineligible.

(ii) The bidder does not upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the bid document.

(iii) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest bidder in the office of bid opening authority.

(iv) If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

10. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee at specified percentage of the tendered amount as mentioned in Schedule 'E' and within the period specified in Schedule 'F'. This guarantee shall be in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt

from any of the Commercial Banks in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F', including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The earnest money deposited along with bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance guarantee. The contractor whose bid is accepted will also be required to furnish either copy of applicable licenses/ registrations or proof of applying for obtaining labour licenses, registration with EPFO, ESIC and BOCW Welfare Board including Provident Fund Code No. If applicable, and also ensure the compliance of aforesaid provisions by the subcontractors, if any engaged by the contractor for the said work within the period specified in Schedule 'F'.

11. The description of the work is as follows:- **Construction of Indo-Nepal Border pillars of 18 Bn Rajnagar, 45 Bn Birpur, 56 Bathnaha & 52 Bn Araria under SHQ SSB Purnea.**

Intending Bidders are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their bids as to the nature of the ground and sub-soil (so far as is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site, the accommodation they may require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their bid. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. The bidder shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools & plants, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Submission of a bid by a bidder implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, etc. will be issued to him by the Government and local conditions and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work.

12. The competent authority on behalf of the President of India does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any other bid and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all the bids received without the assignment of any reason. All bids in which any of the prescribed condition is not fulfilled or any condition including that of conditional rebate is put forth by the bidder shall be summarily rejected.

13. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with bidders is strictly prohibited and the bids submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.

14. The competent authority on behalf of President of India reserves to himself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the bid and the bidder shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.

15. The contractor shall not be permitted to bid for works in SSB responsible for award and execution of contracts, in which his near relative is posted as an Accountant or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (both

inclusive). He shall also intimate the names of persons who are working with him in any capacity or are subsequently employed by him and who are near relatives to any Gazetted Officer in SSB or in the Ministry of Home Affairs. Any breach of this condition by the contractor would render him liable to be debarred for further tendering in SSB department.

16. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department of the Government of India is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of one year after his retirement from Government service, without the prior permission of the Government of India in writing. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the Government of India as aforesaid before submission of the bid or engagement in the contractor's service.

17. The bids for the work shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **75 (Seventy Five)** days from the date of opening of technical bids. Further,

(i) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department within 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 50% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.

(ii) If any tenderer withdraws his tender or makes any modification in the terms & conditions of the tender which is not acceptable to the department after expiry of 7 days after last date of submission of bids, then the Government shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit 100% of the earnest money absolutely irrespective of letter of acceptance for the work is issued or not.

(iii) In case of forfeiture of earnest money as prescribed in para (i) and (ii) above, the bidders shall not be allowed to participate in the rebidding process of the same work.

18. This notice inviting Bid shall form a part of the contract document. The successful bidder/ contractor, on acceptance of his bid by the Accepting Authority shall within 15 days from the stipulated date of start of the work, sign the contract consisting of:-

(a) The Notice Inviting Bid, all the documents including additional conditions, specifications and drawings, if any, forming part of the bid as uploaded at the time of invitation of bid and the rates quoted online at the time of submission of bid and acceptance thereof together with any correspondence leading thereto.

(b) Standard C.P.W.D. Form-7 or other Standard C.P.W.D. Form as applicable.

19. For Composite Bids

19.1 The Engineer in charge of the major component will call bids for the composite work. The cost of bid document and Earnest Money will be fixed with respect to the combined estimated cost put to tender for the composite bid.

19.2 After acceptance of the bid by competent authority, the **Engineer-in-charge** of the work shall issue letter of award on behalf of the President of India. After the work is awarded, the contractor will have to enter into agreement with Engineer-in-charge of the work.

19.3 Entire work under the scope of composite bid including major and all minor components shall be executed under one agreement.

19.4 Running payment for the work shall be made by Engineer-in-charge to the contractor as per agreement/condition of contract.

19.5 The composite work shall be treated as complete when all the components of the work are complete. The completion certificate of the composite work shall be recorded by Engineer-in-Charge.

19.6 Final bill of whole work shall be finalized and paid by the Engineer-in-charge of the work.

19.7 The intending bidders are required to upload their bids well in advance of last date of submission of tender.

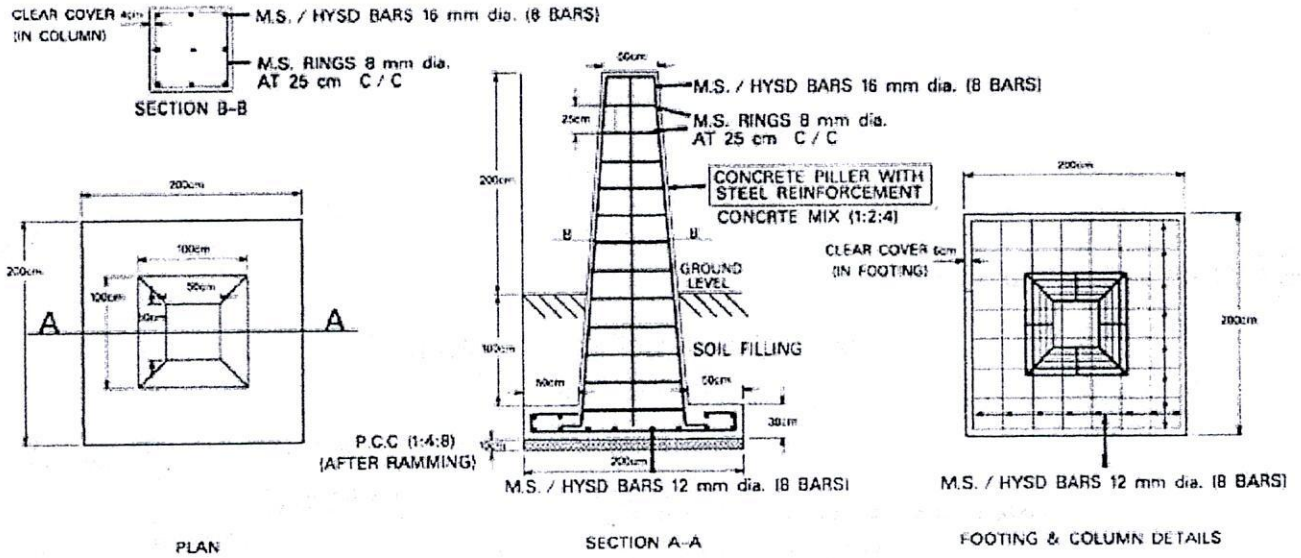

DETAILS OF REINFORCEMENT OF MAIN PILLAR

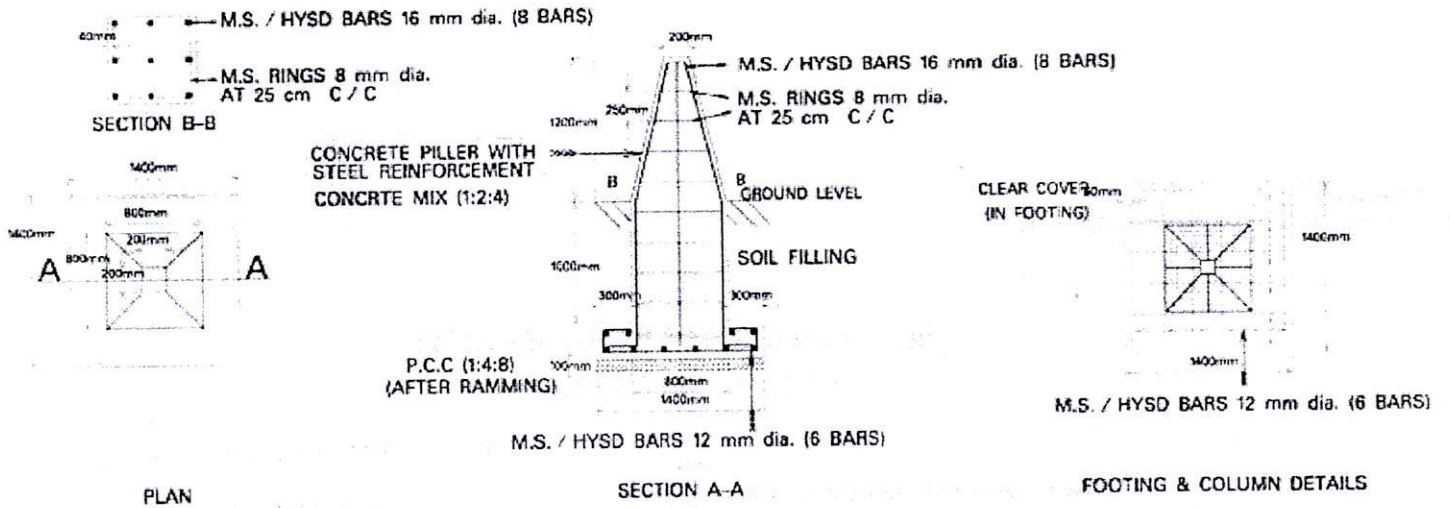

SECTION A-A

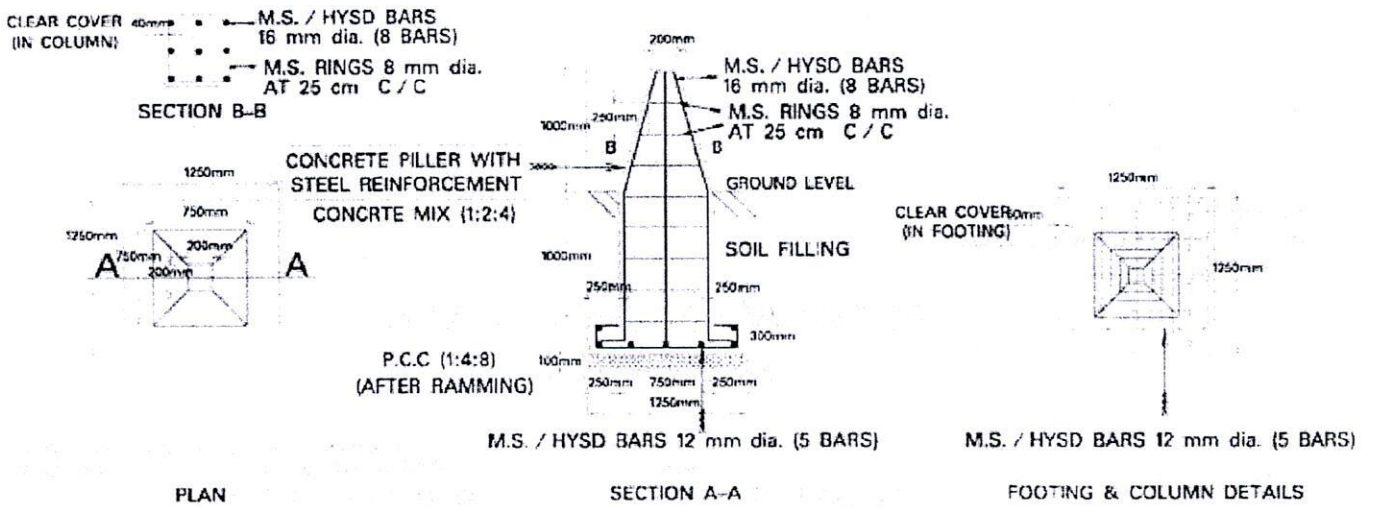

DETAILS OF REINFORCEMENT OF MINOR PILLAR

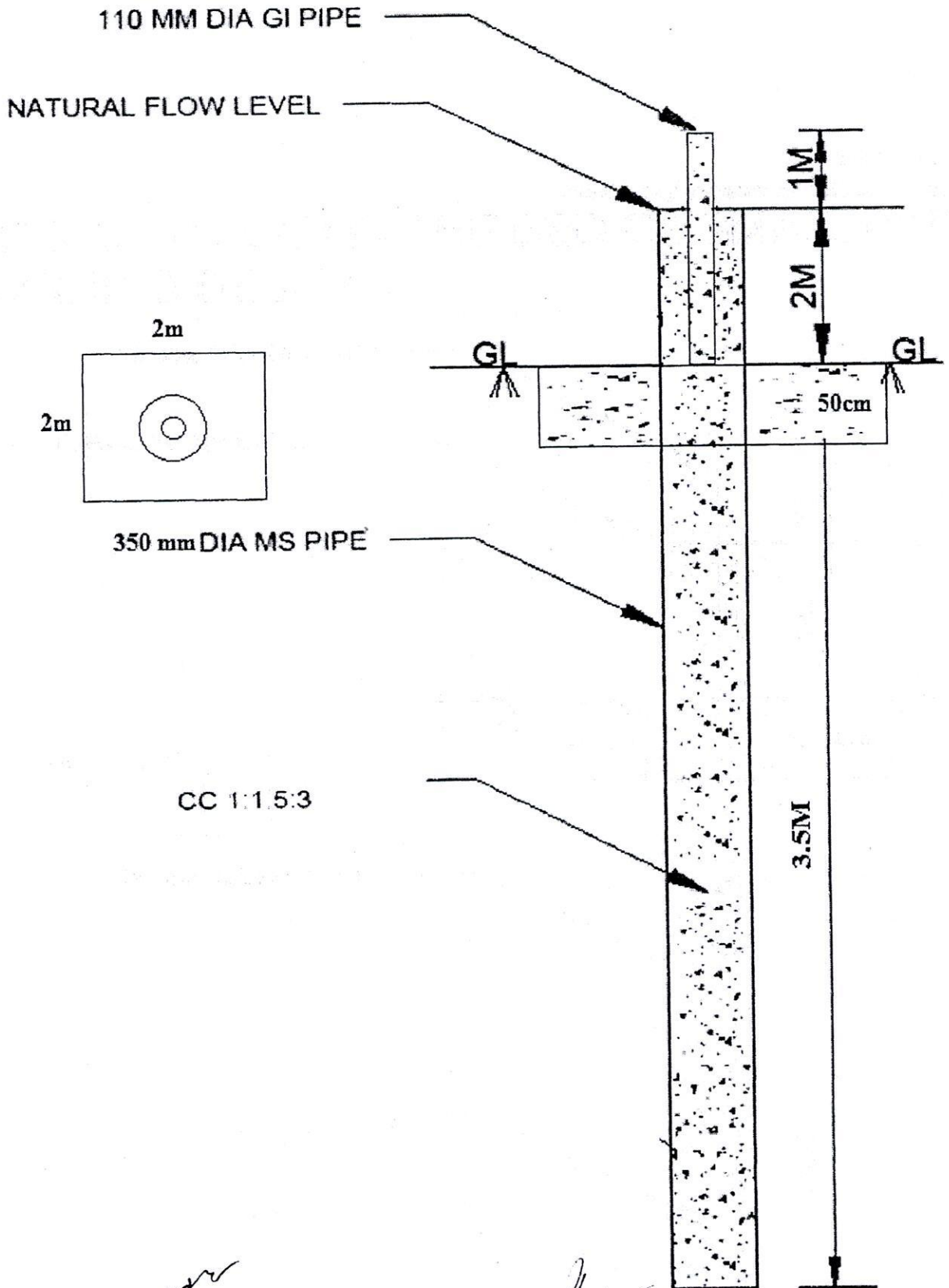
