

1. Contractors who fulfill the following requirements shall be eligible to apply. Joint ventures are not accepted.

(a) Should have satisfactorily completed the works as mentioned below during the last Seven years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited.

(i) Three similar works each costing not less than **Rs. 1,10,587/- (40% of ECPT)**, or two similar works each costing not less than **Rs. 1,65,881/-(60% of ECPT)** or one similar work costing not less than **Rs.2,21,174/- (80% of ECPT)**. (**Similar work shall means works for construction of Civil works**). The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum; calculated from the date of completion to previous day of last day of submission of tenders.

(b) Should have had Average Annual Financial Turnover of **Rs.82,940/-(30% of the work value for last 03 years)** on construction works during the immediate last three years ending **31stMarch 2025**.

(Scanned copy of Certificate from CA with Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) to be uploaded). The value of annual turnover figures shall be brought to the current value by enhancing the actual turnover figures at simple rate of 7% per annum.

(c) Should not have incurred any loss (profit after tax should be positive) in more than two years during the last five years ending **31st March 2025**.

(d) Should have a Banker's Certificate from a commercial Bank for **Rs. 110587/- (40% of ECPT)** or Net Worth certificate from CA with Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) of minimum 10% amount of ECPT (Scanned copy of original to be uploaded).

2. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of CPWD-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.

3. This information and instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.

4. The bid document consisting of Plans, Specifications, Schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from www.eprocure.gov.in free of cost.

5. But the bid can only be submitted after deposition of original EMD in the office of the **Dy. Inspector General, SHQ SSB Muzaffarpur, Uma Nagar, Near SKMCH Muzaffarpur, 842004** by **25-05-2026** within the period of bid submission and uploading the mandatory scanned documents such as Account Payee Demand draft or Banker's Cheque or Fixed Deposit Receipts from any of the Commercial Bank towards EMD in favour of as mentioned in NIT, deposition of original EMD to office of Dy. Inspector General, SHQ, SSB, Muzaffarpur and certified copies of other documents as specified.

6. The intending bidder must have valid class-III digital signature certificate with encryption key (combo type) to perform any operations/transactions on the website.

7. On opening date, the contractor can login and see the bid opening process. After opening of BID he/she will receive the competitor bid sheets.

8. Contractor can upload documents in the form of **PDF format**.

9. **Certificate of Financial Turn Over:** At the time of submission of bid contractor may upload Affidavit/Certificate from CA mentioning Financial Turnover of last 3 years or for the period as specified in the bid document and further details if required may be asked from the contractor after opening of technical bids. **There is no need to upload entire voluminous balance sheet.**

10. Contractor must ensure to quote rate of each item. The column meant for quoting rate in figures appears in yellow colour and the moment rate is entered, it turns sky blue.

In addition to this, while selecting any of the cells a warning appears that if any cell is left blank the same shall be treated as "0" (ZERO). Therefore, if any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, rate of such item shall be treated as "0" (ZERO).

However, If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

11. The Technical Bid shall be opened first on due date and time as mentioned above. The time and date of opening of financial bid of contractors qualifying the technical bid shall be communicated to them at a later date.

12. Pre-Bid conference shall be held in the chamber of **Dy. Commandant (Er.), O/o the Dy. Inspector General, SHQ SSB Muzaffarpur, Uma Nagar, Near SKMCH Muzaffarpur, 842004** on **21/05/2026 at 1600Hrs** to clear the doubt of intending bidders, if any.

13. **The department reserves the right to reject any prospective application without assigning any reason and to restrict the list of qualified contractors to any number deemed suitable by it, if too many bids are received satisfying the laid down criterion.**

Additional instructions:-

14. The contractor submitting the bid should read the schedule of quantities, Special conditions, additional conditions, particular specifications and other terms and conditions given in the NIT and drawings. The bidder should also read the **General Conditions of Contract for CPWD Works 2023(Construction work) with all correction slips** issued up to the last date for submission of bid, which is available at **CPWD website**. However, provisions included in the bid document shall prevail over the provisions contained in the standard form. The set of drawings and NIT shall be available with the Dy. Commandant (Er.), SHQ SSB Muzaffarpur. The contractor may visit the site of work and acquaint himself with the site conditions before tendering. The following conditions, which already form part of the tender conditions, are specially brought to his notice for compliance while filling the tender. They are requested to comply with the following instructions.

15. Tenders with any condition including that of conditional rebates shall be rejected. Such tenders shall not be entered in the tender opening register at the time of opening of tender.

16. The successful tenderer shall be required to submit a **Performance Guarantee of 5% (Five Percent)** of the tendered amount within 7 days of issue of letter of intent. This period can be further extended by Engineer-in-Charge upto a maximum period of 7 days on the written request of the contractor subject to payment of late fee @0.1% per day of Performance Guarantee amount.

17. GST on all materials as well as GST on Work Contract etc., or any other taxes applicable in respect of this contract shall be payable by the Contractor. Percentage rate quoted by him shall be inclusive of all such taxes, levies etc. and Government will not entertain any claim for reimbursement whatsoever in respect of the same. The percentage rates of the contract shall be inclusive of all taxes and levies and nothing extra shall be paid. Further the percentage rate quoted by the contractor shall be inclusive of labour welfare cess and the same shall be recovered from the contractors' bills and will be remitted by the department.

18. Applicants are advised to keep visiting the <https://ssb.gov.in> or eprocure.gov.in websites as applicable from time to time (till the deadline for bid submission) for any updates in respect of the tender documents, if any. Failure to do so shall not absolve the applicant of his liabilities to submit the application complete in all respects including updates thereof, if any. An incomplete application may be liable for rejection.

19. This work requires engaging more than 20 nos. of labours/workers and therefore all necessary licenses such as Labour license, EPFO and ESI, BOCW welfare registration etc., shall be taken by contractor within the time limits as prescribed under Clause-1 of Schedule- 'F'.

20. Contractor shall not divert any advance payments or part thereof for any other purpose other than needed for completion of the contracted work. All advance payments received as per terms of the contract (i.e. for work done during interim stages, etc.) are required to be re-invested in the contracted

work to ensure advance availability of resources in terms of materials, labour, plant & machinery needed for required pace of progress for timely completion of work.

21. If any information furnished by the applicant is found incorrect at a later stage, he shall be liable to be debarred from tendering/taking up of works in SSB. The department reserves the right to verify the particulars furnished by the applicant independently.

22. The safety and security of the completed buildings/infrastructure is the responsibility of the contractor till they are handed over to SSB. After completion of the work, taking over process may take time and the responsibility of the buildings including all fixtures and fittings/constructed infrastructure is the complete responsibility of the contractor and nothing extra shall be payable on this account.

23. GST applicable as per Government norms up to date. Contractor should quote the rate including GST as per Govt. norms, nothing to be reimbursed against GST directly.

24. The Earnest money will not be considered as a part of Performance Guarantee. Performance Guarantee should be submitted separately by the successful bidder.

25. Any dispute arising out of this tender including dispute related to encashment of any Bank Guarantee/ FDR etc., shall be subject to the jurisdiction of courts at **Patna** only.

CPWD-6 FOR E-TENDERING

1. Online Percentage rate bid is invited on behalf of President of India from approved and eligible contractors of CPWD and those of appropriate list of M.E.S., BSNL, Railway and State P.W.D. (B&R)/Building Construction Department dealing with similar nature of works for the work of **C/o 06 Nos. Border Pillar of 48th Bn. under SHQ Muzaffarpur.**

The enlistment of the contractors should be valid on the last date of submission of bid. In case the last date of submission of bid is extended, the enlistment of contractor should be valid on the original date of submission of bid.

1.1 The work is estimated to cost **Rs.2,76,468/-**. This estimate, however, is given merely as a rough guide.

1.2 Intending bidders is eligible to submit the bid provided he has definite proof from the appropriate authority, which shall be to the satisfaction of the competent authority, of having satisfactorily completed similar works of magnitude specified below: - Criteria of eligibility for submission of bid documents.

To become eligible for issue of bid, the bidders shall have to furnish an affidavit as under: -

I/We undertake and confirm that eligible similar works(s) has/have not been got executed through another contractor on back to back basis. Further that, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department, then I/we shall be debarred for bidding in SSB in future forever. Also, if such a violation comes to the notice of Department before date of start of work, the Engineer-in-Charge shall be free to forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit/Performance Guarantee. **(Scanned copy to be uploaded at the time of submission of bid).**

1.2.1 When bids are invited from contractors as per provisions of clause 1.2.1 above, it will be mandatory for contractors to upload the work experience certificate(s) and the affidavit as per the provisions of clause 1.2.2. Uploading of these two letters is mandatory otherwise system will not clear mandatory fields.

2. Agreement shall be drawn with the successful bidders on prescribed Form No. CPWD-7 which is available as a Govt. of India Publication and also available on website www.eprocure.gov.in. Bidders shall quote his rates as per various terms and conditions of the said form which will form part of the agreement.

3. The time allowed for carrying out the work will be **60 days** from the date of start as defined in schedule 'F' or from the first date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any, indicated in the bid documents.

4. The site for the work is available.

5. The bid document consisting of plans, specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents except **General Conditions of Contract for CPWD Works 2023 (Construction work) with all correction slips** issued up to the last date for submission of bid, can be seen on website <https://eprocure.gov.in> and on www.ssb.nic.in free of cost.

6. After submission of the bid the contractor can re-submit revised bid any number of times but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.

7. While submitting the revised bid, contractor can revise the rate of one or more item(s) any number of times (he need not re-enter rate of all the items) but before last time and date of submission of bid as notified.

8. Earnest Money in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque from any of the Commercial Banks (drawn in favour of the **Dy. Inspector General, SHQ SSB Muzaffarpur**) shall be scanned and uploaded on the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. The original EMD should be deposited in the office of the **Dy. Inspector General, SHQ SSB Muzaffarpur** within the time period of bid submission.

The earnest money given by all the tenderers except the lowest tenderer shall be refunded immediately after the expiry of stipulated bid validity period or immediately after acceptance of the successful bidder, whichever is earlier. However, in case of two/ three bid system, earnest money deposit of bidders unsuccessful during technical bid evaluation etc. should be returned within 30 days of declaration of result of technical bid evaluation.

Legible copy of Enlistment Order and certificate of work experience and other documents as specified in the notice inviting e-tender shall be scanned and uploaded on the e-Tendering website within the period of bid submission. Online bid documents submitted by intending bidders shall be opened only of those bidders, whose original EMD, uploaded documents as specified in e-tender notice deposited with the **Dy. Inspector General, SHQ SSB Muzaffarpur** any other documents scanned and uploaded are found in order.

The bid submitted shall be opened after **1600 Hrson 29/05/2026**

9. The bid submitted shall become invalid and e-Tender processing fee (if applicable) shall not be refunded if:

(i) The bidder is found ineligible.

(ii) The bidder does not upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the bid document.

(iii) If any discrepancy is noticed between the documents as uploaded at the time of submission of bid and hard copies as submitted physically by the lowest bidder in the office of bid opening authority.

(iv) If a tenderer quotes nil rates against each item in item rate tender or does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender or any section / sub head in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.

10. The contractor whose bid is accepted will be required to furnish performance guarantee at specified percentage of the tendered amount as mentioned in Schedule 'E' and within the period specified in Schedule 'F'. This guarantee shall be in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee from any of the Commercial Banks in accordance with the prescribed form. In case the contractor fails to deposit the said performance guarantee within the period as indicated in Schedule 'F', including the extended period if any, the Earnest Money deposited by the contractor shall be forfeited automatically without any notice to the contractor. The earnest money deposited along with bid shall be returned after receiving the aforesaid performance

guarantee.
